**BACKGROUND:**

Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

1. **MALHY Community Outreach Protective Services, Inc.** - \$2,000- The funding will be used to support the MALHY Awareness and Support Program, this program provides temporary housing, food, clothing, transportation, and therapy sessions to youth suffering from addiction and mental health problems.
2. **Community Outreach Ministry** -\$2,000- This allocation will support the 24<sup>th</sup> Annual Angel Tree Christmas Party, an event that provides Christmas dinner to children impacted by parental incarceration.
3. **Inland Empire Men’s Club (IEMC)**-\$1,000- The funding will be used to support the Third Annual Reverend Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Scholarship Breakfast, an event that provides high school seniors with academic scholarships.
4. **Inland Valley Symphony DBA Temecula Valley Symphony**- \$5,000- The funding will be used to support the 2024-2025 Concert Season –“Where Music Transcends”, a series of concerts designed to provide civic engagement and education about the arts.
5. **Temecula Sunrise Rotary Foundation**-\$2,500- The funds will be used to support the Temecula Community Christmas Dinner, an event that provides a sit-down dinner to low-income, homeless, and homebound seniors.
