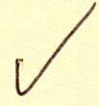



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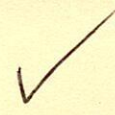

Notwithstanding any other provisions of these rules, member of the public shall have the right to address the Board during the mid-morning "Oral Communications" segment of the published agenda. Said purpose for address must pertain to issues which are under the direct jurisdiction of the Board of Supervisors. YOUR TIME WILL BE LIMITED TO THREE (3) MINUTES. The Board may limit the public input on any item, based on the number of people requesting to speak and the business of the Board.

Power Point Presentations/Printed Material:

Speakers who intend to conduct a formalized Power Point presentation or provide printed material must notify the Clerk of the Board's Office by 12 noon on the Monday preceding the Tuesday Board meeting, ensuring that the Clerk's Office has sufficient copies of all printed materials and at least one (1) copy of the Power Point CD. Copies of printed material given to the Clerk (by Monday noon deadline) will be provided to each Supervisor. If you have the need to use the overhead "Elmo" projector at the Board meeting, please ensure your material is clear and with proper contrast, notifying the Clerk well ahead of the meeting, of your intent to use the Elmo. **Speakers are prohibited from bringing signs, placards, or posters into the hearing room.**

Individual Speaker Limits:

Individual speakers are limited to a maximum of three (3) minutes. The Board may limit the public input on any item, based on the number of people requesting to speak and the business of the Board. Please step up to the podium when the Chair calls your name and begin speaking immediately. Pull the microphone to your mouth so that the Board, audience, and audio recording system hear you clearly. Once you start speaking, the "green" podium light will light. The "yellow" light will come on when you have one (1) minute remaining. When you have 30 seconds remaining, the "yellow" light will begin flash, indicating you must quickly wrap up your comments. Your time is up when the "red" light flashes. The Chair adheres to a strict three (3) minutes per speaker. ***Note: If you intend to give your time to a "Group/Organized Presentation", please state so clearly at the very bottom of the reverse side of this form.***

Group/Organized Presentations:

Group/organized presentations with more than one (1) speaker will be limited to nine (9) minutes at the Chair's discretion. The organizer of the presentation will automatically receive the first three (3) minutes, with the remaining six (6) minutes relinquished by other speakers, as requested by them on a completed "Request to Speak" form, and clearly indicated at the front bottom of the form.

Addressing the Board & Acknowledgement by Chair:

The Chair will determine what order the speakers will address the Board and will call on all speakers in pairs. The first speaker should immediately step to the podium and begin addressing the Board. The second speaker should take up a position in one of the chamber aisles to quickly step up to the podium after the preceding speaker. This is to afford an efficient and timely Board meeting, giving all attendees the opportunity to make their case. Speakers are prohibited from making personal attacks, and/or using coarse, crude, profane or vulgar language while speaking to the Board members, staff, the public and/or meeting participants. Such behavior, at the discretion of the Board Chair may result in removal from the Board Chambers by Sheriff Deputies.

Good evening,

I am here again to remind the CAC board and Supervisor Spiegel and Supervisor Jeffries that I am requesting that the future Lakeland Village library, which is to be built in 2025, be named after Deputy Sheriff Darnell Calhoun. Deputy Calhoun was killed in Lakeland Village a year ago. I know that the other side of the lake is Lake Elsinore. I have observed that the library on Graham is named Altha Merrifield Memorial Library, after a former librarian. This shows that it is not unusual to name a library after a deserving person. I want to remind everyone here that another Deputy Sheriff named Brett Harris died on May 12, 2023 and he already has a park named after him. The county park is at 25175 Fairview Ave. in the unincorporated Valle Vista area of east of Hemet. According to the Press Enterprise, "The proposal, brought by board Chairman Chuck Washington and Supervisor Yxstian Gutierrez was unanimously approved." I strongly believe that it is only fitting to have something in Lakeland Village named after Deputy Darnell Calhoun. Deputy Calhoun is a hero, and he sacrificed his precious life, while he was protecting the citizens of Lakeland Village.

Additional facts that are being added on November 4, 2024

The above meeting speech was shared with all five of the county supervisors. I gave Supervisor Spiegel's assistant copies of my speech on 2/28/24, in individual envelopes addressed to each supervisor, and she said that these envelopes would be given to each supervisor. To date, only Supervisor Jeffries has contacted me to state his support for the naming of the library after Deputy Calhoun. Dear Supervisors Washington, Perez, Spiegel, Gutierrez and Jeffries,

At the Election Committee Meeting on September 11, 2024, Assistant County Counsel Ross Trindel stated that the Board of Supervisors' duty regarding the certification of election results is "ministerial." He seemed to imply that the board has no responsibility to ensure the accuracy of the Registrar's certification as "full, true, and correct." However, the definition of ministerial is "...an act done after ascertaining the existence of a specified state of facts in obedience to a legal order without exercise of personal judgment or discretion." Canvass means "to examine carefully or discuss thoroughly; scrutinize." The board's ministerial responsibility, we believe, is to "ascertain" the facts about the Registrar's election results and relate those facts to applicable law.

Please direct County Counsel Minh Tran to submit a legal brief explaining the ministerial responsibilities of the Board regarding Election Certification of the Canvass of the Vote in order to give the public confidence that requisite scrutiny has been conducted before certification. This would be very helpful to the Supervisors and the public. This legal brief would be consistent with the county's responsibility to "disseminate information to the public."

Government Code Title 3. Government of Counties. Division 2. Officers. Part 2. Board of Supervisors.
Chapter 2. General Powers.

§25201: Subject to the provisions of the Elections Code, the board may establish, abolish, and change election precincts, appoint inspectors, clerks, and judges of election, canvass all election returns, declare the result, and order the county elections official to issue certificates of election.

§25207: The board may do and perform all other acts and things required by law, not enumerated in this part, or which are necessary to the full discharge of the duties of the legislative authority of the county government.

§25207.5: A county may disseminate information to the public concerning the rights, duties, properties, and activities of the county.

Greetings County Board Members and Audience Members,

My name is Joyce Lei and I am a 19 ½ year resident of Lakeland Village. I am speaking as a common citizen with no political clout and no friends or family members in public office. I have spoken many times at the Lakeland Village CAC quarterly meetings requesting that the new library being built in Lakeland Village be named after Deputy Sheriff Darnell Calhoun.

I want to remind everyone here that in December of 2022, Deputy Sheriff Isaiah Codero was shot to death while on duty in Jurupa Valley. A month later, In January of 2023, Deputy Sheriff Darnell Calhoun was shot to death while on duty in Lakeland Village. In May of 2023, Deputy Sheriff Brett Harris died in a traffic accident while on duty. To date, only Deputy Sheriff Harris has been honored in a fashion that all Police Officers who die on duty should be honored. According to the Press Enterprise on Jan 23, 2024, Deputy Sheriff Harris was to honored by having a park named after him and that all 5 supervisors supported this.

According to the Press Enterprise, Deputy Codero will be honored by having a sign on the 60 freeway and Deputy Calhoun will be honored by having a sign on the 15 freeway. I can't fathom how having a park named after one Deputy killed while on duty bears more weight than the other two Deputies who were also killed while on duty.

Picture the afternoon of January 13, 2023 and Vanessa Calhoun gets a call from the sheriff department telling her that her husband has been injured. She is six months pregnant with their 3rd son. At that time, Vanessa had a son age two and another son age four. Can you imagine Vanessa trying to explain to her two sons that daddy is never coming home again? Picture years from now when her youngest son asks his mother Vanessa why there are no pictures of him with his daddy.

Put yourself in the shoes of the Calhoun family. Your husband, son, grandson, brother, cousin is brutally murdered by a deranged individual who hid behind his truck door and began shooting at Deputy Calhoun as he got out of his patrol car. Wouldn't you want your love one to be honored by having a location named after him? Having a sign on the freeway is a nice first gesture, however it is not a place that the Calhoun family can visit. To date, almost 22 months after the murder of Deputy Calhoun, the memorial signs have not been installed. I am requesting that the new library being built in Lakeland Village be named the Darnell Calhoun Memorial Library. I attended the ground breaking ceremony for the library, and the pictures of the library showed the library as the Lakeland Village Library. I dare anyone on the board to be able to come up with a name of any individual more deserving than Darnell Calhoun to have the library named after him or her. No other individual has sacrificed their life while protecting the citizens of Lakeland Village. I gave Supervisor Spiegel's representative letters to deliver to each Supervisor on February 28, 2024. To date, only Supervisor Jeffries has contacted me, by phone, to tell me that he supports the naming of the Library after Deputy Calhoun. Supervisor Spiegel kindly spoke at the one-year memorial for Deputy Calhoun but she and the other three board members have not stated their support about naming the library after Deputy Calhoun. Please do the right and honorable thing by voting unanimously to name the future Lakeland Village Library the Darnell Calhoun Memorial Library. Thank you.

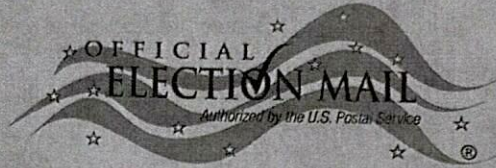

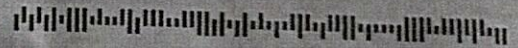
