

**BACKGROUND:** Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

1. The donation to the Family Service Association (\$4,000.00) will support their annual event, HOPE For the Holidays, which provides foster youth with a toy, blanket, essential toiletries, and a duffle bag to hold their belongings.
2. The donation to Patriot High School Girls Soccer (\$2,000.00) will provide a full Spirit Pack Kit for each player to use for the season. Their current Junior Varsity team requires funding for appropriate gear and to attend tournaments.
3. The donation to Nami Mt. San Jacinto Inc. (\$1,500.00) will be used to support access to services, treatment, research, raise awareness, honor those who have lost their lives to mental illness, and advocate for others.
4. The donation to ABC Hopes, Inc. (\$5,000.00) will support the special needs community throughout the Second District by helping single parents, and low-income families, who have experienced medical bills throughout the year.
