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FIRST AMENDMENT TO COLLEGE/PREHOSPITAL PROVIDER AGREEMENT TO PROVIDE SUPERVISED FIELD SERVICE EXPERIENCE FOR EMS PROGRAM **STUDENTS**

THIS FIRST AMENDMENT ("Amendment") TO THE COLLEGE/PRE-HOSPITAL/ PROVIDER AGREEMENT (hereinafter referred to as "Agreement") is entered into by and between College of the Desert (hereinafter referred to as "COLLEGE") and the County of Riverside (hereinafter referred to as "PROVIDER"), a political subdivision of the State of California, on behalf of the Fire Department. COLLEGE and PROVIDER shall collectively be referred to herein as "the Parties."

RECITALS

- The Parties entered into the Agreement, that certain College/Prehospital Provider Agreement executed as of April 12, 2022 (the "Cooperative Agreement") and with a term of July 1, 2022, to June 30, 2027, in order to provide supervised field service experience for EMS Program Students, as more particularly described in the Agreement. a copy of which is in the possession of the COUNTY and COLLEGE.
- The COUNTY and COLLEGE desire to amend the Agreement in accordance with and subject to the terms and conditions set forth in this Amendment.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing recitals and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is acknowledged, the COUNTY and COLLEGE agree as follows:

SECTION 1. The Cooperative Agreement is amended to reflect that that the signer of the COLLEGE has been changed from Chantae M. Wilson, EMS Program Director, to Laura Hope, President / Superintendent.

SECTION 2: All other terms and conditions of the Cooperative Agreement remain in full force and effect.
