BACKGROUND:

Summary

By Minute Order dated August 27, 2024 (Agenda Item 3.87), the County of Riverside Board of Supervisors authorized the Clerk of the Board to advertise for the De Portola Road Drainage Improvements Project in the Temecula Valley Wine Country area within the Community of Rancho California of Riverside County.

The De Portola Road drainage improvements project proposes to construct a system of sediment basins adjacent to the north side of De Portola Road between Shiraz Way and approximately 650-feet northerly that will aid in the mitigation of stormwater erosion damage to existing infrastructure during rain events.

The sediment basins system will include construction of approximately 555 linear feet of reinforced concrete retaining walls with variable height up to 12-feet high, construction of four sediment basins separated by three reinforced concrete weir structures, construction of two reinforced concrete channel transition structures, and one reinforced concrete junction structure.

Additional improvements include construction of concrete curb and gutter, cross gutter and spandrels, construction of asphalt concrete dike, minor road improvements will require removal of segments of the existing asphalt concrete pavement and underlying material and placing new hot mix asphalt pavement. Safety features include placing roadside signs, traffic stripes, thermoplastic crosswalks and pavement markings, and other associated work.

On March 11, 2021, President Biden signed the \$1.9 trillion American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) of 2021 into law. To accelerate recovery from the economic and health impacts of the COVID-19 pandemic, the County of Riverside was provided approximately \$480 million. The Executive Office in conjunction with the Board Supervisors developed a plan to disburse these funds

based on the principles of providing recovery funding to those sectors of our economy and society that are struggling most to recover from the pandemic; have a constituent and community based focus; provide a vehicle for transformational investment in our County's recovery from COVID-19; provide for countywide equity; and focus on one time investments, rather than funding ongoing operational costs. As a result of these principles, the De Portola Road Drainage Improvements Project was selected as a recipient of \$1,807,000 of ARPA funds from District 3 per Minute Order dated April 4, 2023 (Agenda Item 3.2).

On March 1, 2022, item 3.46, the Board of Supervisors approved an Agreement between the Riverside County Flood Control and Water Conservation District and Riverside County Transportation Department, for the design, bidding, administration, and construction of improvements by the Transportation Department. The Flood Control District will contribute up to six hundred thousand dollars (\$600,000) for the project funding.

During the advertisement period, two addenda were issued to all registered plan holders as a supplement to the plans and specifications. Bidders were required to acknowledge and take into account these issued addenda on their contractor's Bid in order to be considered for award.

The addenda were issued to clarify and modify the approved contract documents. Addendum No. 2 increased costs; thus a 4/5ths vote is required. The addenda are attached and designated as Addendum No. 1 and Addendum No. 2.

The Contract includes the following schedule of work:

Base Bid Schedule: De Portola Road Drainage Improvements
Alternative Bid Schedule 1: Rancho California Water District (RCWD) Work

RCWD has accepted the bid prices proposed by Riverside Construction Company, Inc. for Alternative Bid Schedule 1, which includes adjustments, relocations and abandonment of RWCD facilities that are in conflict with the improvements. A reimbursement agreement between RCWD and County of Riverside is being submitted to the Board of Supervisors for approval concurrent with the award of this project (Companion Item MT# 26403).

The contractor, Riverside Construction Company, Inc., is qualified to perform the work as outlined in the bid, has executed the contract, and has provided bonds and insurance documents which meet the requirements of the contract documents.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

The proposed drainage improvements will aid in the mitigation of stormwater erosion damage to existing infrastructure during rain events, improving the safety for vehicles traveling on De Portola Road.

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The work is scheduled to begin in early 2025. The work will be phased to keep the road open during construction as much as possible and will take approximately three months to complete.

SUPPLEMENTAL:

Additional Fiscal Information

Construction is expected to be completed in Fiscal Year 2024/2025 and will be funded with American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA), Riverside County Flood Control and Water Conservation District funds, Gas Tax/HUTA, and Rancho California Water District funds.

There are no General Funds used in this project.

Contract History and Price Reasonableness

A total of three bids were received on Wednesday September 25, 2024 ranging from \$3,054,540 to \$5,000,000. The basis for the selection of a contractor is the lowest responsive and responsible bid. The lowest responsive and responsible bid was submitted by Riverside Construction Company, Inc. in the amount of \$3,054,540 which is \$48,265 (1.6%) above the engineer's cost estimate.

The Transportation Department recommends the award of the contract to Riverside Construction Company, Inc. in the amount of \$3,054,540.

Contract

THIS CONTRACT is entered into at Riverside, California as of the date set forth below is between County of Riverside hereafter called "County" and **Riverside Construction Company, Inc.**, hereafter called "Contractor".

WITNESSETH

Recitals:

1. Contractor has submitted to County his Contractor's Proposal for the construction of County Project, **De Portola Road Drainage Improvements Project, Shiraz Way to 650-Foot Northerly, Community of Rancho California, Project No. D0-0099**, in strict accordance with the Contract Documents identified below and County has accepted said Proposal.
2. Contractor states that he has reexamined his Contractor's Proposal and found it to be correct, has ascertained that his subcontractors are properly licensed and possess the requisite skill and forces, has reexamined the site and Contract Documents and is of the opinion that he can presently do the work in accordance with the Contract Documents for the money set forth in his Proposal to be paid as provided in the Contract Documents.

Agreement:

It is agreed by the parties as follows:

1. Contract Documents

The entire Contract consists of the following: (a) The Construction Contract, (b) The Notice to Bidders, (c) The Instruction to Bidders, (d) The Bid, (e) The Bid Bond, (f) The Payment Bond, (g) The Performance Bond, (h) The General Conditions, (i) The Special Provisions, (j) The Standard Specifications of the State of California Department of Transportation edition of **2018** as modified in other portions of the Contract Documents and as amended by the State of California Department of Transportation, (k) The Standard Plans of the Department of Transportation identified on the plans or in the Special Provisions, (l) The Plans, (m) Addenda **(Two)**, (n) The Determination of Prevailing Wage Rates for Public Works, (o) Any Change Orders issued, and (p) Any additional or supplemental specifications, notice, instructions and drawings issued in accordance with the provisions of the Contract Documents. All of said Documents presently in existence are by this reference incorporated herein with like effect as if here set forth in full and upon the proper issuance of other documents they shall likewise be deemed incorporated. The Bid Bond is exonerated upon execution of this Contract and the Payment Bond and Performance Bond.

2. The Work

Contractor shall do all tasks necessary to construct the work generally described in Recital No. 1 in accordance with the Contract Documents.

3. Prosecution, Progress and Liquidated Damages

Attention is directed to the provisions in Section 8-1.04, "Start of Job Site Activities", Section 8-1.05, "Time", and in Section 8-1.10 "Liquidated Damages" of the Standard Specifications and these Special Provisions.

Standard Specification Section 8-1.04B, "Standard Start" is modified to read as follows:

The Contractor shall begin work within fifteen (15) calendar days, or as revised in the Special Provisions, of the date stated within the written "Notice to Proceed".

The Contractor shall notify the Engineer, in writing, of the Contractor's intent to begin work at least 72 hours before work is begun. If the project has more than one (1) location of work, Contractor shall submit a separate notice for each location. The notice shall be delivered to the Transportation Department's Construction Engineer and shall specify the date the Contractor intends to start at said location.

Should the Contractor begin work in advance of receiving a written "Notice to Proceed", any work performed by the Contractor in advance of the date stated in the "Notice to Proceed" shall be considered as having been done by the Contractor at his own risk and as a volunteer and subject to the following:

- A. The Contractor shall, on commencing operations, take all precautions required for public safety and shall observe all the provisions in the Specifications and the Special Provisions.
- B. All work done according to the Contract, prior to the issuance of the "Notice to Proceed", will be considered authorized work and will be paid for as provided in the contract.
- C. The Contractor shall not be entitled to any additional compensation or an extension of time for any delay, hindrance or interference caused by or attributable to commencement of work prior to the issuance of the "Notice to Proceed".

4. Compensation

Contractor shall be paid in the manner set forth in the Contract Documents the amount of his Proposal as accepted by County, the above rates, subject to additions and deductions as provided in the Contract Documents. Said Proposal is on file in the Office of the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors of County.

1. **Riverside Construction Company, Inc.** (Contractor) has entered into a Contract with COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE (County) for construction of public work known as **De Portola Road Drainage Improvements Project, Shiraz Way to 650-Foot Northerly, Community of Rancho California, Project No. D0-0099.**

2. _____, a _____ corporation (Surety), is the Surety under this Bond.

Agreement:

We, Contractor as Principal and Surety as Surety, jointly and severally agree, state, and are bound unto County, as obligee, as follows:

1. The amount of the obligation of this Bond is 100% of the estimated contract price for the Project of **\$3,054,540.00 (Three million, fifty-four thousand, five hundred forty dollars and zero cents)** and inures to the benefit of County.

2. This Bond is exonerated by Contractor doing all things to be kept and performed by it in strict conformance with the Contract Documents for this project, otherwise it remains in full force and effect for the recovery of loss, damage and expense of County resulting from failure of Contractor to so act. All of said Contract Documents are incorporated herein.

3. This obligation is binding on our successors and assigns.

4.  - (4) An executive officer, insurance manager, or authorized representative, if you are an organization other than a partnership or limited liability company.

Knowledge of an "accident", claim, "suit" or "loss" by other persons does not imply that the persons listed above have such knowledge.

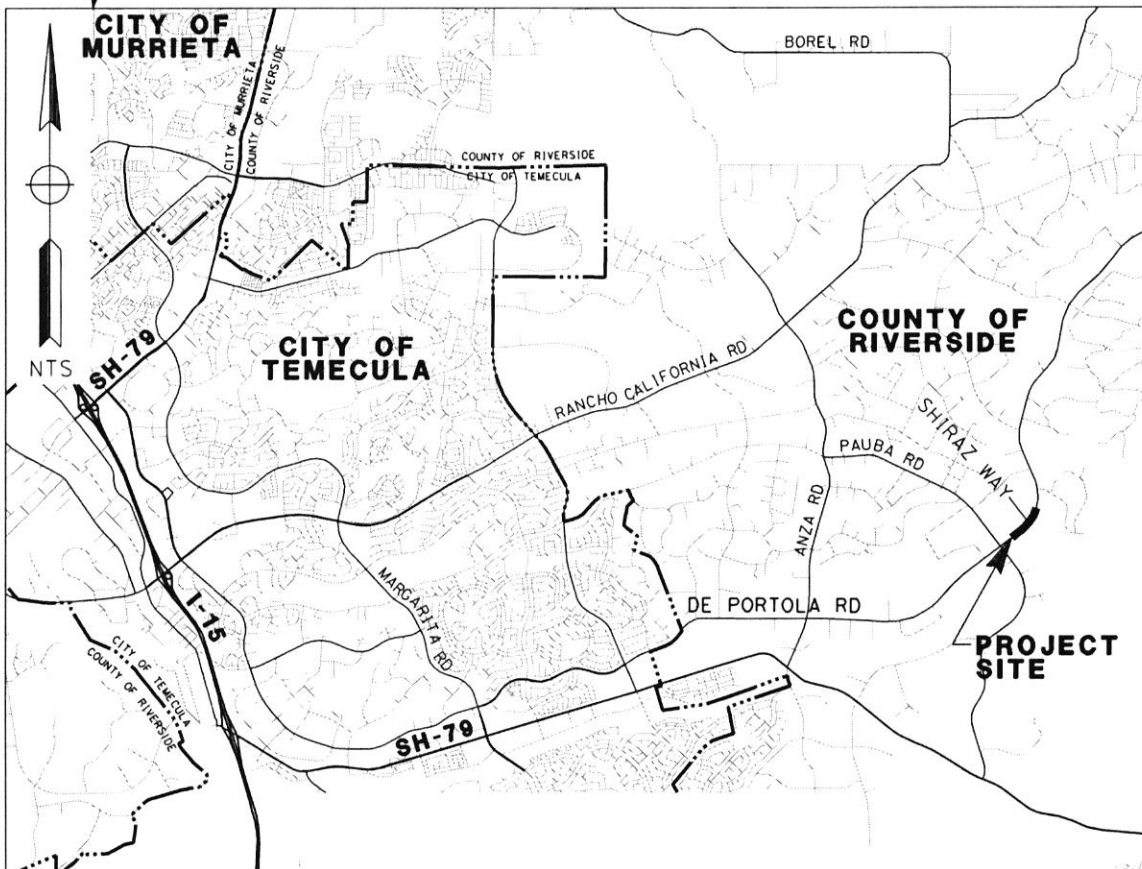
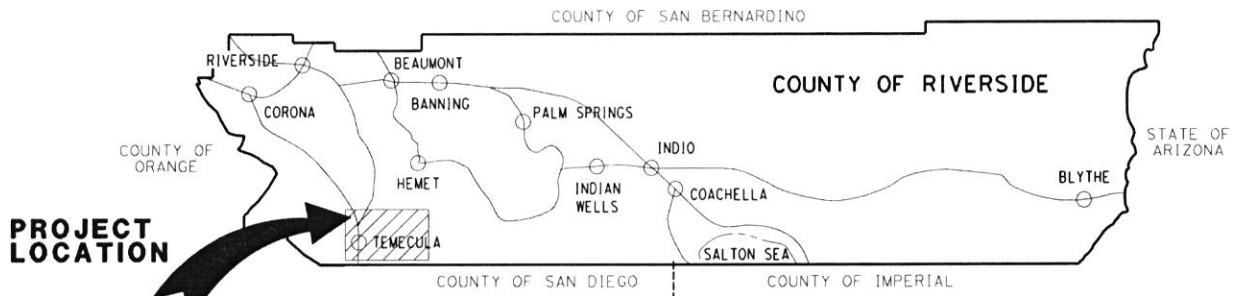

Item 12: Clarification - Removal and Salvaging of Existing Olive Trees. Refer to Section 20-10.03, Existing Planting - Salvage And Return Trees To Owner, on page 32 of the special provisions.

After olive trees are delivered to the owner, the Contractor will not be responsible for further maintenance of the salvaged olive trees.

Item 13: Colored Concrete.
