BACKGROUND:

Summary

On March 28, 1989, the Riverside County Board of Supervisors (Board) adopted the initial Land Use Fee Ordinance 671 on BOS 3.11. Since then, 22 minor amendments have occurred over the years.

The cost of providing services has increased over time but TLMA has not adjusted the initial deposits on their Deposit-Based Fee (DBF) cases in 30 years. To increase cost certainty on less complex process, TLMA is also proposing to convert seven (7) Deposit-Based Fee cases; two of Planning and five of Survey cases into Flat fee categories. These apply to cases that are usually not complex and can be delivered within a more predictable time frame (Attachment D). The Auditor-Controller has approved the Flat fee methodology. TLMA has compared the proposed Flat Fees with neighboring local jurisdictions (Attachment E).

A companion item to Ordinance No. 671.23 updates the productive hourly rates for Deposit Based Fees (DBF) and Code Enforcement Cost Recovery rates for the Transportation and Land Management Agency (TLMA) Departments of Counter Services, Planning, Transportation, and Code Enforcement.

County Counsel has reviewed the Ordinance.

Environmental Analysis

The proposed changes to Ordinance No. 671.23 – as well as the separate companion item for productive hourly rates - are exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) based on the following:

Ordinance No. 671.23 is exempt according to State CEQA Guidelines section 15061(b)(3) because it can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the amendment to Ordinance No. 671.23 may have a significant effect on the environment. In accordance with CEQA, the use of the Common Sense Exemption is based on the "general rule that CEQA applies only to projects which have the potential for causing a significant effect on the environment." State CEQA Guidelines section 15061(b)(3). The use of this exemption is appropriate if it can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the activity in question

may have a significant effect on the environment. The changes proposed to Ordinance No. 671 merely update the required fees to better represent the operating cost to process various planning permits and activities. As such, no impacts tied to the changes to the ordinance would apply.

The Board has also determined that Ordinance No. 671.23 is statutorily exempt pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines section 15273, which exempts the establishment, modification, restructuring, or approval of rates or charges by a public agency to obtain funds for meeting operating expenses. As stated, the cost of providing services has increased over time, and yet TLMA has not adjusted the initial deposits for DBF cases for 30 years. These fees are set to provide a more accurate cost to process various planning projects and better represent the operating cost of the department to process such projects. As such, the update to the ordinance fits within this statutory exemption.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

Development applicants will see increased deposits for DBF cases. This is a comprehensive overhaul of Ordinance 671. The new deposits are based on the historic average time it takes to complete the project using the Board-approved DBF hourly rate (Attachment C). This will enable TLMA to collect appropriate initial deposits, alleviating the collection of multiple supplemental deposits from the applicant. This will ensure timely and seamless service on projects without any interruption.

Additional Fiscal Information

The proposed deposits are reasonable, given that they have not been adjusted in 30+ years. For Deposit-Based Fee functions only, fees collected in excess of the actual cost of providing the specific service will be refunded when the project is completed.

ORDINANCE NO. 671.23

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 671 ESTABLISHING

CONSOLIDATED FEES FOR LAND USE AND RELATED FUNCTIONS

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside ordains as follows:

Section 1. Ordinance 671 is amended in its entirety to read as follows:

"ORDINANCE NO. 671

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE

ESTABLISHING CONSOLIDATED FEES FOR LAND USE AND RELATED FUNCTIONS

Section 1. The purpose of this ordinance is to provide for the consolidation of certain schedules of fees related to the land use matters as provided for in the separate ordinances, resolutions and rules of the County of Riverside mentioned herein. The meaning of any word or phrase appearing herein shall be determined by reference to the ordinance, resolution, or rule to which it relates. Should any fee provided herein be ruled invalid or unenforceable, such determination shall not affect the validity of all remaining fee provisions.

Section 1.2. FEES

A. DEPOSIT-BASED, ACTUAL COST FEES

- Certain application functions within this ordinance are designated as requiring deposit- based fees and are identified as such with the legend "Deposit-based Fee:" following the function title.
- 2. For deposit-based fee functions only, fees collected in excess of the actual cost of providing the specific service shall be refunded. Applications whose work require a cost beyond the initial deposit shall require a supplemental deposit. Work on any application will cease when the deposit is depleted and will resume when supplemental deposits are received, and the account is in good standing.

- 3. The County will draw against deposited funds on regular payroll accounting cycles and at the fully burdened hourly rates for each job classification required to provide a specified service. Hourly rates for services shall be established through the yearly budget process and adopted by the Board of Supervisors as part of the County Budget public hearings. Subject to all County procedures and all legal requirements applicable to such contracts, the County may contract with consultants to provide any specified service whenever it is determined necessary to provide such service, and the County may thereafter draw against deposited funds in the amount of the actual costs of such contract services.
- 4. Deposits for applications will be collected upon submittal of the application. Deposits will be monitored and, when 80% depleted, an analysis of the project will be done to determine if the remaining portion of the deposit will cover expected project completion costs. If costs are expected to exceed the remaining deposit in an amount of \$100.00 or more, supplemental deposits will be required to be submitted to recover the estimated full cost for completion. Supplemental deposits will be determined on a case-by-case basis based on the estimated cost to complete the application.
- 5. A full accounting of each application will be made within 90 days of application's decision and provided to the applicant. Remaining deposits of \$100.00 or more will be refunded to the applicant.
- 6. The Property Owner acknowledges that the Applicant is authorized to submit this agreement and related application(s) for land use review or permit on this property. The Property Owner also acknowledges that should the Applicant not reimburse the County of Riverside for all costs related to this application or permit; the Property Owner shall become

immediately liable for these costs which shall be paid within 15 days of the service by mail of notice to said property Owner by the County.

7. When it is mutually agreed to by the applicant and the department or agency to which a fee applies, any fee not designated as a "Deposit-based Fee:" may be treated and accounted for as a deposit-based fee in the manner established in paragraphs 1 through 6 of these subsections.

B. APPEAL PROCEDURE

- 1. Within 10 calendar days of receipt of the full accounting of the application costs or request for supplemental deposits, the applicant may request a review of the matter by the appropriate department head, or his/her designee, who shall along with the responsible staff representative, review the cost of processing the application. The department head may, in his or her sole discretion, determine that the costs were or were not appropriate and may then reduce the costs charged. The department head shall, in writing, notify the appealing person of his or her decision within five working days from the date of when the appeal was submitted or from the conclusion of his or her review.
- Any responsible party aggrieved by the decision of the department head
 may, within ten (10) calendar days after the date of mailing of the
 department head's decision, file a written appeal of the decision with
 TLMA Administration.
- 3. The TLMA Director/Assistant County Executive Officer (Asst. CEO) will review the cost of processing the application and shall consider all information relevant to the issue of costs that is provided, either orally or in written form, by the applicant and staff. The TLMA Director/Asst. CEO may determine that the costs were or were not appropriate and may then reduce the costs charged. The TLMA Director/ Asst. CEO

shall, in writing, notify the appealing person of its decision within five working days from the conclusion of his or her review.

- 4. Any responsible party aggrieved by the decision of the TLMA Director/Asst. CEO may, within ten (10) calendar days after the date of mailing of the TLMA Director/Asst. CEO's decision, file a written appeal of the decision with the Board of Supervisors. The appeal shall be on the form(s) provided by the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors and shall be accompanied by a filing fee of \$50. Upon receipt of the completed appeal, with filing fees, the Clerk of the Board shall set the matter for hearing before the Board of Supervisors not less than ten (10) nor more than thirty (30) calendar days thereafter and shall give written notice of the hearing to the applicant and the TLMA Director/Asst CEO or other department head. The Board of Supervisors shall render its decision within thirty (30) calendar days following the close of the hearing of the appeal.
- 5. Unless appealed, the decision of the department head or TLMA Director/Asst. CEO is final. If the decision of the department head is appealed, then the decision of the TLMA Director/Asst. CEO is final unless appealed. If the decision of the TLMA Director/Asst. CEO is appealed, then the decision of the Board of Supervisors is final.
- 6. Unless appealed, the decision of the department head or TLMA Director/Asst. CEO is final. If the decision of the department head is appealed, then the decision of the TLMA Director/Asst. CEO is final unless appealed. If the decision of the TLMA Director/Asst. CEO is appealed, then the decision of the Board of Supervisors is final.

Section 1.3 PROCEDURES

Except as otherwise expressly provided below, the provisions of this Section shall apply to fees or charges subject to either Government Code Sections 66016 and 66017 (as now adopted or

hereafter amended), or to Government Code Section 54985 et seq. (as now adopted or hereafter amended).

- NOTICE AND PUBLIC MEETINGS. Prior to either adopting a new fee or A. charge or approving an increase in an existing fee or charge, the Board of Supervisors shall hold at least one public meeting, at which oral or written presentations may be made, as part of a regularly scheduled meeting. Notice of the time and place of the meeting, including a general explanation of the matter to be considered, and a statement that the data required by this section is available, shall be mailed at least 14 calendar days prior to the meeting to any interested party who files a written request with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors for mailed notice of meetings on new or increased fees or charges. Any written request for such mailed notices shall be valid for one year from the date on which it is filed unless a renewal request is filed. Renewal requests for such mailed notices shall be filed on or before April 1st of each year. The annual fee for sending such notices shall be determined by and shall be paid to the Clerk of the Board. At least 10 calendar days prior to the meeting, the Clerk of the Board shall post and make available to the public data indicating the amount of cost, or estimated cost, required to provide the service for which the fee or charge is levied, and the revenue sources anticipated to provide the service, including general fund revenues. Any costs incurred by the County in conducting the meeting or meetings required pursuant to this subsection may be recovered from the fees charged for the services which were the subject of the meeting.
- B. ACTION BY ORDINANCE OR RESOLUTION. Any action to adopt a new fee or charge or to approve an increase in an existing fee or charge shall be taken only by ordinance or resolution; provided, however, that any such action shall be taken only by ordinance for any fees subject to Government Code Section 54985 et seq. (as now adopted or hereafter

amended.) The Board of Supervisors shall not delegate the authority to adopt a new fee or charge or to increase a fee or service charge.

- C. EFFECTIVE DATE. Any action adopting a new fee or charge, or increasing a fee or charge adopted, upon a development project, as defined in Government Code Section 66000, which applies to the filing, accepting, approving, or issuing of an application, permit, or entitlement to use shall be enacted in accordance with Government Code Section 54986 (as now adopted or hereafter amended) or Section 66016 (as now adopted or hereafter amended) and shall be effective 60 days following the final action on the adoption of the fee or charge or the increase in the fee or charge.
- D. URGENCY MEASURES. Notwithstanding any provision of this ordinance, the Board of Supervisors may adopt an interim authorization for a new fee or charge, or increase in a fee or charge, as an urgency measure in accordance with the procedures set forth in subdivision (b) of Government Code Section 66017, as now adopted or hereafter amended.
- E. FLAT FEES: Flat fees are subject to change based on Board Approved Hourly Rate (see Fee Schedule A).
- F. REFUND OF FEES OF ORDINANCE NO. 671 FOR NON-DEPOSIT-BASED FEES.
 - 1. Whenever any application, fee or permit is voided or withdrawn for any reason, the Planning Department or other applicable Department may, in accordance with the Refund Policy Statement adopted by the Board of Supervisors, refund fees paid, upon the written request of the applicant. If any portion of the application fees has been paid by the Department to another jurisdiction, agency, or department for the performance of services related to the application, the Department will not refund any such portion of fees until the other jurisdiction, agency, or department authorizes the Department to do so. In the absence of such

authorization, it will be the applicant's responsibility to contact the other jurisdiction, agency, or department for a refund of the fees paid to it, in accordance with the Refund Policy Statement.

G. ONE-TIME FEES AND SURCHARGES

- At the time of an initial deposit on any application, certain cases may require a one-time fee that shall be deducted from the initial deposit and shall be dedicated to the funds as indicated.
- 2. The following surcharges will be placed on all initial deposits on a project, as well as any supplemental deposits that may be made on a project:
 - a. Administration Fee (BOS 12.1 dated 9/4/1998)
 - b. Land Management System (LMS) (now PLUS) Fee (BOS 9.4 dated 4/26/20042.0%

Ordinance 671 Nexus Synopsis

Ordinance No. 671 (Fees/deposits) is being amended to reflect a more appropriate initial Deposit Based Fee (DBF), pursuant to the average processing cost of an entitlement. The costs of providing services have increased over time but the initial deposits on Deposit-Based Fee (DBF) cases have not been adjusted in 30+ years. A comparative analysis was conducted on all DBF cases including Planning Department entitlement application costs over the past five (5) years. County staff reviewed costs for processing applications from start to finish, which has resulted in amending the initial application fees to become closer to the overall cost of processing. Increased initial deposits, will result in fewer requests for funding the entitlement account during the review process and will help reduce the sometimes quick account draw down time to a negative balance.

However, the revised initial fees are not intended to cover the entire cost of an entitlement process as due to the scope and complexity of any given project, the cost could exceed the five (5) year average or be below it, in which case a refund would be issued after project completion. Every project is unique and could incur additional fees, due to complications resulting from, but not limited to, the project site being located in a potential habitat conservation area, high flood or fire areas, access challenges, or have a potential for public opposition. Also, the increased entitlement processing fees are separate from any post-entitlement approval fees, such as Development Impact Fees ("DIF"), Transportation Uniform Mitigation Fees ("TUMF"), or other construction permit related fees. Everyone is encouraged to consult with the Building and Safety Department and other appropriate agencies to determine these post-approval fees.

As part of this amendment, the project close-out time frame is being extended. Currently, after project approval, staff would typically start the close-out process and set the project as "approved" in the County's permit tracking system. An approved status means that staff now has only 45-days to complete a sometimes complex close-out process, before the project can no longer be billed. In some cases, complex projects having multiple entitlement types, take longer to receive all the final executed documentation, resulting in staff not being able to fully close out the project within the 45-day time frame. The proposed Ordinance change is to extend the close-out timeframe to 90-day.

ORDINANCE NO. 671 (AS AMENDED THROUGH 671.2223)

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 671 ESTABLISHING CONSOLIDATED FEES FOR LAND USE AND RELATED FUNCTIONS

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside Ordains as follows:

SECTION 1.1. PURPOSE AND SCOPE.

The purpose of this ordinance is to provide for the consolidation of certain schedules of fees related to the land use matters as provided for in the separate ordinances, resolutions and rules of the County of Riverside mentioned herein. SECTION 1.2. FEES.

A. DEPOSIT-BASED, ACTUAL COST FEES

- 1. Certain project_application functions within this ordinance are designated as requiring deposit-based fees and are identified as such with the legend "Deposit-based Fee:" following the function title. When multiple fee charges are listed for a deposit-based fee function, the initial deposit shall equal the sum of the component charges. Whenever the initial deposit includes a Comprehensive Transportation Plan (CTP) fee, that fee shall not be placed in the deposit trust fund but shall be deposited immediately into the road deposits trust account.
- 2. For deposit-based fee functions only, fees collected in excess of the actual cost of providing the specific service shall be refunded. Applications whose work require a cost to the designated department beyond the estimated fee collected as a deposit initial deposit shall require an additional supplemental deposit. Work on any application will cease when the deposit is depleted and will resume when additional supplemental deposits are received, and the account is in good standing.
- 3. The County will make draws against deposited funds on biweekly intervals based on regular payroll accounting cycles and at the fully burdened hourly rates for each job classification required to provide a specified service. Hourly rates for services shall be established through the yearly budget process and adopted by the Board of Supervisors as part of the County Budget public hearings. Subject to all County procedures and all legal requirements applicable to such contracts, the County may contract with outside consultants to provide any specified service whenever it is determined necessary to provide such service, and the County may thereafter draw against deposited funds in the amount of the actual costs of such contract services.
- 4. Deposits for applications will be collected upon submittal of the application. Deposits will be monitored and, when 80% depleted, an analysis of the project will be done to determine if the remaining portion of the deposit will cover expected project completion costs. If costs are expected to exceed the remaining deposit in an amount of \$5.00100.00 or more, additional supplemental deposits will be required to be submitted to recover the estimated full cost for completion. Additional Supplemental deposits will be determined on a case-by-case basis based on the estimated cost to complete the application.
- A full accounting of each application will be made within 45-90 days of application's decision of the application -* and provided to the applicant. Remaining deposits of \$5.00100.00 or more will be refunded to the applicant.

- 6. The Property Owner acknowledges that the Applicant is authorized to submit this agreement and related application(s) for land use review or permit on this property. The Property Owner also acknowledges that should the Applicant not reimburse the County of Riverside for all costs related to this application or permit; the Property Owner shall become immediately liable for these costs which shall be paid within 15 days of the service by mail of notice to said property Owner by the County.
- 6.7. When it is mutually agreed to by the applicant and the department or agency to which a fee applies, any fee not designated <u>as a</u> "**Deposit-based Fee:**" may be treated and accounted for as a deposit-based fee in the manner established in paragraphs 1 through <u>5–6</u> of <u>this-these subdivisionsubsections</u>.

B. APPEAL PROCEDURE.

- 1. Within 10 calendar days of receipt of the full accounting of the application costs or request for additional supplemental deposits, the applicant may request a review of the matter by the Transportation and Land Management Agency (TLMA) Director or the appropriate department head, or his/her designee, who shall along with the responsible staff representative, review the cost of processing the application. The TLMA Director or other department head may, in his or her sole discretion, determine that the costs were or were not appropriate and may then reduce the costs charged. The TLMA Director or department head shall, in writing, notify the appealing person of his or her decision within three-five working days from the date of when the appeal was submitted or from the conclusion of his or her review.
- 2. Any responsible party aggrieved by the decision of the TLMA Director, or other-department head may, within ten (10) calendar days after the date of mailing of the TLMA Director's or department head's decision, file a written appeal of the decision with the Administrative Review Board. This appeal shall be filed with the TLMA Administration. The Administrative Review Board shall be composed of representatives of the TLMA, EDA, and two building industry representatives, one each from the western and eastern parts of the county. In addition, a fifth member of the board shall be selected by the previously mentioned representatives, based on the expertise needed on the board. The Administrative Review Board will convene within 10 working days of the filing of the appeal.
- 3. The Administrative Review Board TLMA Director/Assistant County Executive Officer (Asst. CEO) will review the cost of processing the application and shall consider all information relevant to the issue of costs that is provided, either orally or in written form, by the applicant and staff. The Administrative Review Board The TLMA Director/Assistant County Executive Officer (Asst. CEO) may determine that the costs were or were not appropriate and may then reduce the costs charged. The Administrative Review Board The TLMA Director/ Assistant County Executive Officer (Asst. CEO) shall, in writing, notify the appealing person of its decision within three-five working days from the conclusion of its-his or her review.
- 4. Any responsible party aggrieved by the decision of the Administrative Review Board TLMA Director/Asst. CEO may, within ten (10) calendar days after the date of mailing of the Administrative Review Board's TLMA Director/Asst. CEO's decision, file a written appeal of the decision with the Board of Supervisors. The appeal shall be on the form(s) provided by the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors and shall be accompanied by a filing fee of \$50. Upon receipt of the completed appeal, with filing fees, the Clerk of the Board shall set the matter for hearing before the Board of Supervisors not less than ten (10) nor more than thirty (30) calendar days thereafter

and shall give written notice of the hearing to the applicant and the TLMA Director/Asst CEO or other department head. The Board of Supervisors shall render its decision within thirty (30) calendar days following the close of the hearing of the appeal.

- 5. Unless appealed, the decision of the <u>department head or TLMA Director/Asst. CEO</u> or other department head is final. If the decision of the <u>TLMA Director or department head</u> is appealed, then the decision of the <u>Administrative Review Board TLMA Director/Asst. CEO</u> is final unless appealed. If the decision of the <u>Administrative Review Board TLMA Director/Asst. CEO</u> is appealed, then the decision of the Board of Supervisors is final.
- 6. Work on any application may continue during any appeal process provided there are sufficient funds on deposit.

SECTION 1.3. PROCEDURES.

Except as otherwise expressly provided below, the provisions of this Section shall apply to fees or charges subject to either Government Code Sections 66016 and 66017 (as now adopted or hereafter amended), or to Government Code Section 54985 et seq. (as now adopted or hereafter amended).

- Α. NOTICE AND PUBLIC MEETINGS. Prior to either adopting a new fee or charge or approving an increase in an existing fee or charge, the Board of Supervisors shall hold at least one public meeting, at which oral or written presentations may be made, as part of a regularly scheduled meeting. Notice of the time and place of the meeting, including a general explanation of the matter to be considered, and a statement that the data required by this section is available, shall be mailed at least 14 calendar days prior to the meeting to any interested party who files a written request with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors for mailed notice of meetings on new or increased fees or charges. Any written request for such mailed notices shall be valid for one year from the date on which it is filed unless a renewal request is filed. Renewal requests for such mailed notices shall be filed on or before April 1st of each year. The annual fee for sending such notices shall be \$20 and determined by and shall be paid to the Clerk of the Board. At least 10 calendar days prior to the meeting, the Clerk of the Board shall post and make available to the public data indicating the amount of cost, or estimated cost, required to provide the service for which the fee or charge is levied, and the revenue sources anticipated to provide the service, including general fund revenues. Any costs incurred by the County in conducting the meeting or meetings required pursuant to this subsection may be recovered from the fees charged for the services which were the subject of the meeting.
- B. ACTION BY ORDINANCE OR RESOLUTION. Any action to adopt a new fee or charge or to approve an increase in an existing fee or charge shall be taken only by ordinance or resolution; provided, however, that any such action shall be taken only by ordinance for any fees subject to Government Code Section 54985 et seq. (as now adopted or hereafter amended.) The Board of Supervisors shall not delegate the authority to adopt a new fee or charge or to increase a fee or service charge.
- C. EFFECTIVE DATE. Any action adopting a new fee or charge, or increasing a fee or charge adopted, upon a development project, as defined in Government Code Section 66000, which applies to the filing, accepting, approving, or issuing of an application, permit, or entitlement to use shall be enacted in accordance with Government Code Section 54986 (as now adopted or hereafter amended) or Section 66016 (as now adopted or hereafter amended) and shall be effective 60 days following the final action on the adoption of the fee or charge or the increase in the fee or charge.
- D. URGENCY MEASURES. Notwithstanding any provision of this ordinance, the Board of Supervisors may adopt an interim authorization for a new fee or charge, or increase in a fee or charge, as an

urgency measure in accordance with the procedures set forth in subdivision (b) of Government Code Section 66017, as now adopted or hereafter amended.

E. FLAT FEES: Flat fees are subject to change based on Board Approved Hourly Rate (see Fee Schedule A).

F. REFUND OF FEES OF ORDINANCE NO. 671 FOR NON-DEPOSIT-BASED FEES.

1. Whenever any application, fee or permit is voided or withdrawn for any reason, the Planning Department or other applicable Department may, in accordance with the Refund Policy Statement adopted by the Board of Supervisors, refund fees paid, upon the written request of the applicant. If any portion of the application fees has been paid by the Department to another jurisdiction, agency, or department for the performance of services related to the application, the Department will not refund any such portion of fees until the other jurisdiction, agency, or department authorizes the Department to do so. In the absence of such authorization, it will be the applicant's responsibility to contact the other jurisdiction, agency, or department for a refund of the fees paid to it, in accordance with the Refund Policy Statement.

G. ONE-TIME FEES and SURCHARGES

- 1. At the time of an initial deposit on any application, certain cases may require a one-time fee that shall be deducted from the initial deposit and shall be dedicated to the funds as indicated.
- 2. The following surcharges will be placed on all initial deposits on a project, as well as any supplemental deposits that may be made on a project:
