#### **BACKGROUND:**

Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

- 1. Murrieta Partnership, Inc. DBA Impact Riverside County \$1,200- The funding will be used to support the Murrieta Student of the Month Program, a program that recognizes local high school seniors for their academic achievements, character, and community service.
- 2. **Rock Your Red** -\$2,000- This allocation will support the Annual Rock Your Red for Heart and Stroke Awareness event, an event that educates attendees on the warning signs of heart disease and provides free hands-only CPR training.

- 3. **Menifee VFW Post 1956**-\$5,000- The funding will be used to support the Unmet Needs Program of VFW Post 1956, a program that provides direct financial assistance to veterans experiencing financial hardships by covering the cost of minor home repairs, utilities, medical co-payments, and groceries.
- 4. **Assistance League of Temecula Valley** \$5,000- The funding will be used to support the 5 Points program, a program that partners with school districts to provide families facing financial hardships with clothing, food-only gift cards, and school supplies.
- 5. **MilVet-**\$2,500- The funds will be used to support the Holidays for Heroes Toy Drive, an event that provides children of veterans with Christmas toys.
- 6. Charity for Charity-\$3,500- The allocation will be used to support the Annual Stars of the Valley Gold and Gala event, an event that raises funds to provide holiday meals and toys to adults and children living with life-threatening illnesses or traumatic injuries.
- 7. **The Dresses and Dreams Project**-\$3,000-Funds will be used to support the Operation Prom Girl 2025 Program. This program provides low-income teens with free prom and military ball attire.
- 8. **St. Martha's Community Food Pantry**-\$10,000-The funding will be used to purchase food for low-income residents living in Murrieta, Winchester, and French Valley.
- 9. **Menifee Santa's Workshop**-\$5,000-The funds will be used to purchase learning products, school supplies, hygiene products, and warm infant sleepwear for low-income families living in Quail Valley, Menifee, Romoland, and Homeland.
- 10. NAMI Mt. San Jacinto-\$2,500- Funds will be used to support the 19th Annual NAMI Walks IE at Diamond Valley Lake, this event raises funds for the "Family to Family" and the "Peer to Peer" Program. These programs support and educate individuals and their families on mental health diagnoses.
- 11. **Murrieta Chamber of Commerce-**\$1,500- The funds will be used to support the chamber's annual Mega Mixer, an event that brings all surrounding chambers together to connect and support local businesses.
- 12. God's Fan Club-\$1,450- The funds will be used to support the Shelter from the Storm event, an event that raises funds to provide emergency shelter to individuals facing homelessness.
