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# REVIEW OF REIT ELECTION CANVASS

(Reviewed with Supervisor Spiegel on October 23, 2024)

**PROBLEM WHICH REQUIRED IMMEDIATE ATTENTION:** Mail-in ballots were sent to 200,000+ potential illegal registrants. If ballots from illegal voters were counted, the results of this election will be invalid. *(This issue was not addressed during this election)*

## SUGGESTED ACTIONS FOR SUPERVISORS PRIOR TO ELECTION

1. Create an Election Security Task Force. Suggested by Neal Kelley in his audit report of August, 2023, the task force includes both D.A. Hestrin and Sheriff Bianco. We asked law enforcement to develop a plan to identify illegal voters before the election results are certified. *(Our team had meetings with Supervisor Spiegel and law enforcement but this Task Force, to our knowledge, has not yet been formed)*
2. Consider purchasing a signature check tool, such as ReliaVote. This would give law enforcement a tool to help identify fraudulent ballots. *(We made this suggestion to Supervisor Spiegel who helped us meet with Juan Perez to discuss the technology. He is planning a follow-up meeting with us and the ROV to further discuss the possibility of a pilot test)*
3. Authorize necessary funds for an SQL programmer. Law enforcement could use the programmer to compare the list of those who voted in this election with the Experian data and with the federal Immigration and Naturalization data base to help identify illegal voters. *(We made this suggestion to law enforcement and to our knowledge they have not requested the Experian data from the ROV in order to compare this list with those who voted in this election to identify potential illegal voters).*

## ACTIONS OUR TEAM TOOK DURING THE CANVASS PERIOD

1. Watched the signature verification process. *(A number of our team members confirmed that this is an open door for fraudulent ballots to be cast and counted. This is why we have asked for the involvement of law enforcement to assist the ROV in identifying fraudulent ballots and have pursued ReliaVote as a helpful identification tool)*
2. Tried to watch how daily post office ballot statements are completed. *(We were unable to see how this was done. The ROV explained how they were counting the number of ballots arriving from the post office each day, but we have not seen the actual post office ballot statement)*
3. Watched how daily drop box and vote center ballot statements are completed. *(We were able to watch this process during the election at different vote centers and drop boxes and noticed an improved process)*

4. Watched how provisional ballots are approved at the ROV (*We did watch this process*)
5. Began discussion about ReliaVote signature verification. (*With help from Supervisor Spiegel and COO Juan Perez, we were able to make progress in our discussions about ReliaVote*)
6. Watched the 1% manual tally beginning November 7<sup>th</sup> (*We did watch and noticed the contrast between the hand-counting of paper ballots (simple and transparent) and the machine counting of votes (not simple and not transparent).*)
7. Tried to collect all ballot statements in order to reconcile the number of ballots cast with the number of votes counted. (*On Dec. 2<sup>nd</sup> the ROV said we will not receive these ballot statements until Dec. 18<sup>th</sup>, after certification. We are doing this audit to confirm the accuracy of the machine count, and this work would be valuable to the ROV and the supervisors before certification. We do not understand why we have been refused copies of ballot statements that should be available to the public after the Official Canvass began on November 7th*)

#### **IS THIS ELECTION LEGALLY CERTIFIABLE?**

We communicated with our supervisors, ROV, county council, and law enforcement before and during the canvass period in order to answer the following questions which form the legal standard for a certifiable election.

1. Were the voter rolls accurate? (National Voter Registration Act) (*The ROV has admitted the voter rolls were not accurate which was a problem not addressed in this election.*)
2. Were the votes counted from U.S. citizens legally registered and living in Riverside County? (U.S. Constitution, 14<sup>th</sup> Amendment) (*We suspect that signatures rejected multiple times may indicate illegal ballots and illegal voters, but we do not know for sure because law enforcement so far has not investigated these particular questionable signatures.*)
3. Were the ballots cast equal to the votes counted? (Calif. Election Code 15302) (*We have not been able to answer this question because we have not been given the ballot statements we requested, and we have not yet seen the ROV's work product for their reconciliation*)
4. Did the election system meet the California Accuracy Standard 4.1.1 (1 ballot error out of every 125,000)? (*Because the ROV is using an untested signature check process for approving the validity of ballots, we believe it is impossible for them to meet this accuracy standard*)

**The Board of Supervisors** neither approves nor formally agrees with the certification language of the Registrar of Voters, indicating that the results are "full, true, and correct" as part of receiving and filing\* the certification.

**The Board of Supervisors** does declare elected those persons under its jurisdiction having the highest number of votes for that office (Elections Code §15400), pursuant to the results referenced in the accompanying certification of the Registrar of Voters, based on the Board's good faith assumption that these are the best results readily available as of the date of this motion. The Board of Supervisors recognizes that the 2024 November General Election has unresolved integrity issues that require further investigation but also recognizes the need to install elected officials for the timely and orderly continuation of government in County of Riverside, California.

*Business*

**The Board of Supervisors** approves a comprehensive and independent forensic examination of the election results of the Consolidated Presidential General Election held on November 5, 2024 to determine a full, true, and correct accounting of votes and expenses for jurisdictions to be completed prior to reimbursement by local jurisdictions for the full cost of conducting their election.

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Riverside County Board of Supervisors on October 22, 2024 approving that local jurisdictions that have added a measure or special election to the November ballot will reimburse the Registrar of Voters for the full cost of conducting their election.

**Government Code Title 3. Government of Counties. Division 2. Officers. Part 2. Board of Supervisors. Chapter 2. General Powers.**

§25201: Subject to the provisions of the Elections Code, the board may establish, abolish, and change election precincts, appoint inspectors, clerks, and judges of election, canvass all election returns, declare the result, and order the county elections official to issue certificates of election.

§25207: The board may do and perform all other acts and things required by law, not enumerated in this part, or which are necessary to the full discharge of the duties of the legislative authority of the county government.

**§25207.5: A county may disseminate information to the public concerning the rights, duties, properties, and activities of the county.**

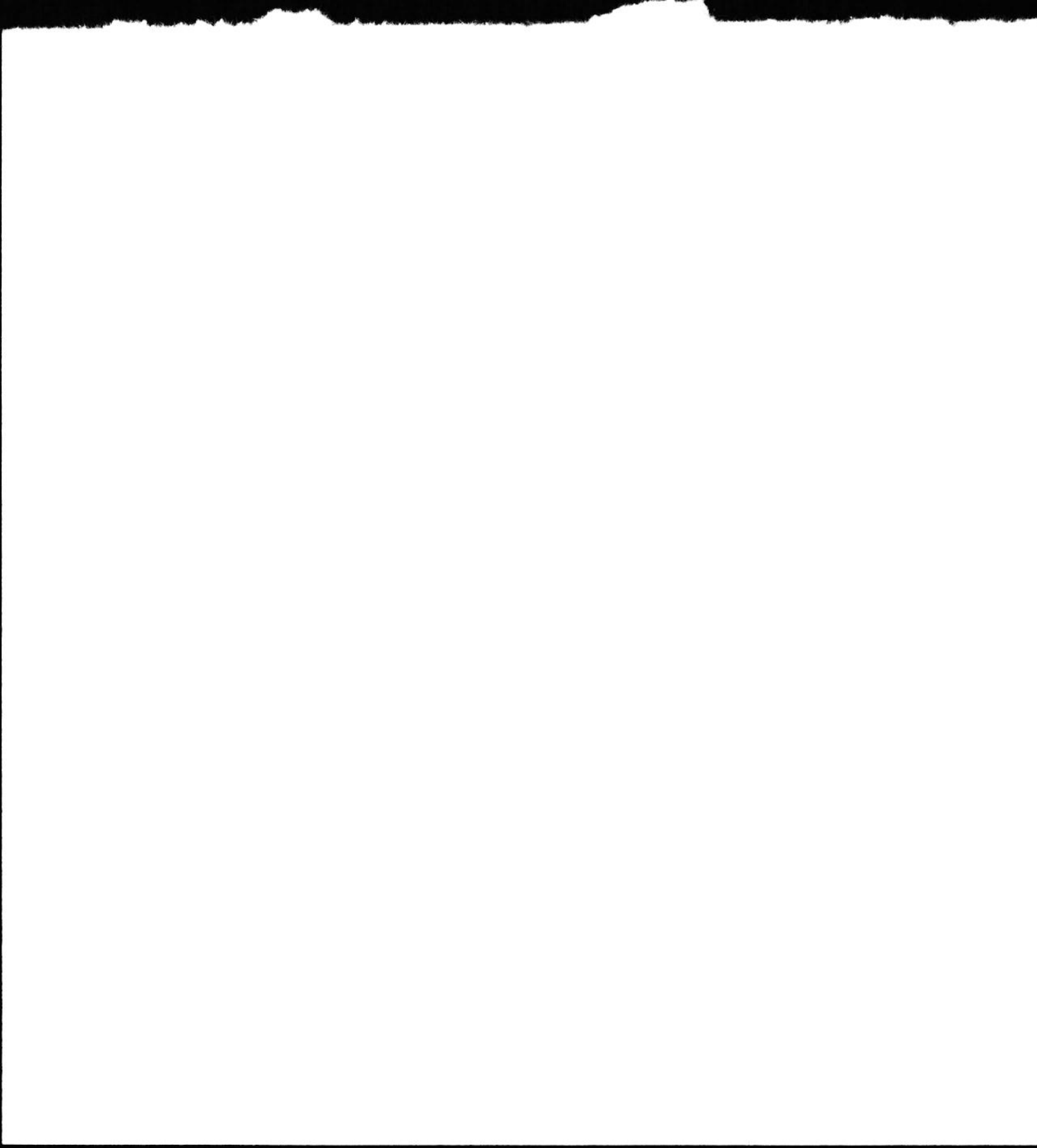

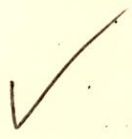

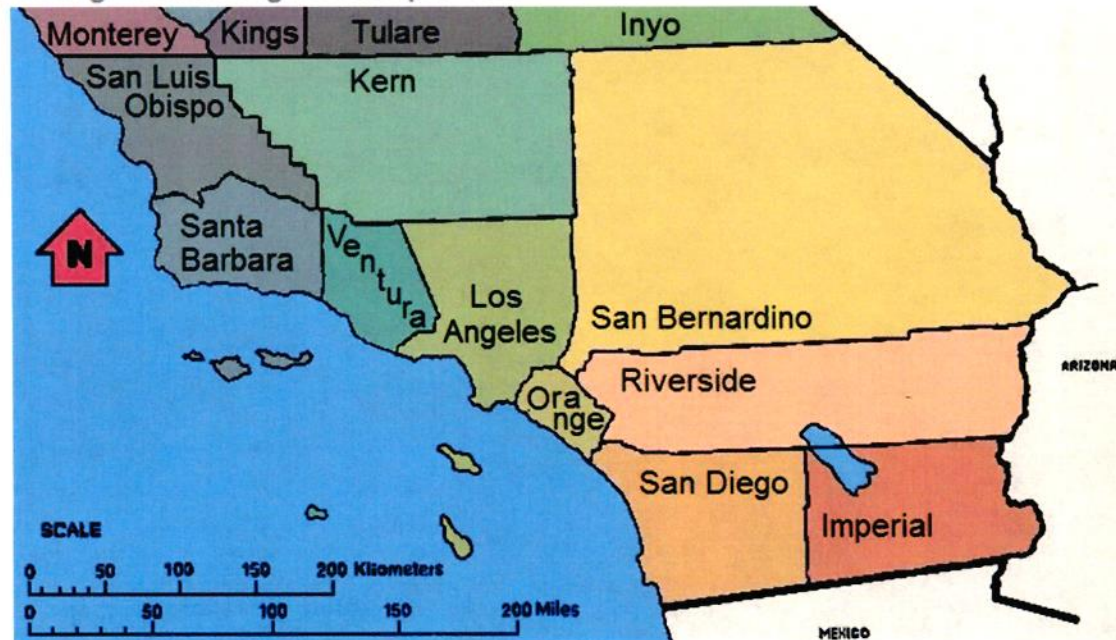

A study by the University of Pennsylvania Kleinman Center for Energy Policy contradicts CARB estimates by estimating that retail prices will increase by \$0.65 a gallon in 2025, \$.85 a gallon in 2030, and \$1.50 a gallon in 2035.<sup>3</sup> Early modeling indicates that the regulation will have at least a \$0.27 to \$0.43 impact on the price of regular fuel.<sup>4</sup> However, depending on the timing and costs incurred by refiners, wholesalers and retailers to comply with the regulations, the impact on retail prices for regular grade gasoline could be significantly higher ranging from \$0.40 to \$0.65 in year one, 2025.<sup>5</sup> Most refineries perform major repairs, upgrades, and maintenance in January and February when demand is lowest and before they are required to switchover to the summer seasonal blend, which has higher refining costs and higher retail prices.

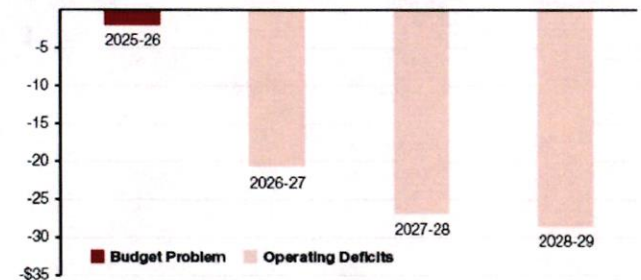

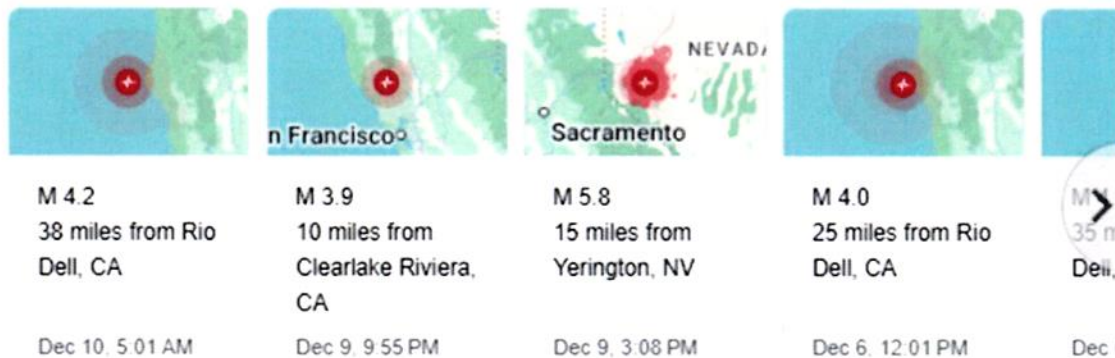

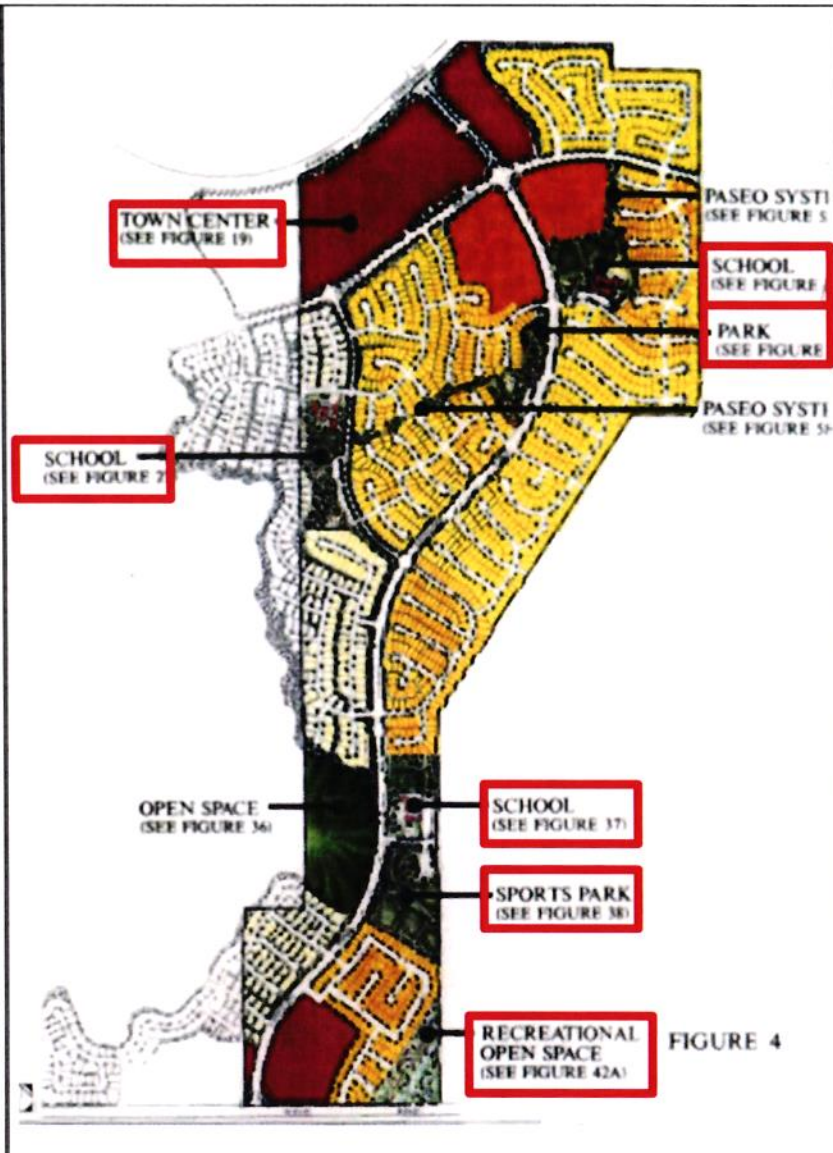
SANTA ANA, California – The District One Supervisor on the Orange County Board of Supervisors has agreed to plead guilty to a felony federal charge for accepting more than \$550,000 in bribes for directing and voting in favor of more than \$10 million in COVID funds to a charity affiliated with one of his daughters, Rhiannon Do, the Justice Department announced today.

Andrew Hoang Do, 62, agreed to plead guilty to one count of conspiracy to commit bribery concerning programs receiving federal funds. His plea agreement and information were filed today. He is expected to make his initial appearance in United States District Court in Santa Ana later this month.

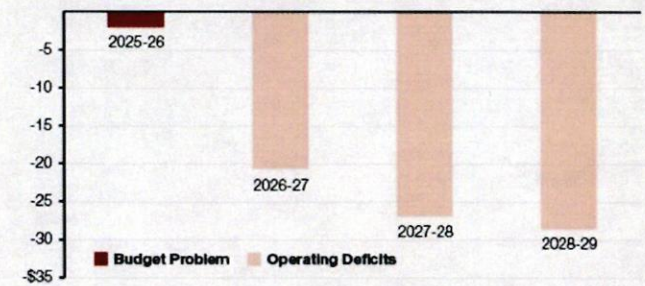

A mobile surgery unit can accommodate 27 animals INCLUDING 6 large Breed female dogs ( important because they produce larger litters) per day.

IF these mobile clinics are 100% sponsored, and this means no cost to the clients, it would cost 4,000.00. This pays for Veterinarian, vet techs, gas, insurance, 3 employees, pain injections, pain meds and generator to run facility.

If you divide 4k by 210k this equals 52. 52 weeks in a year = 1 clinic per week for 1 calendar year.

1,404 animals would be sterilized. This amounts to 150.00 per animal. Might seem expensive but this is a bargain considering the alternative of unaltered pets. Also, a brick-and-mortar vet charges up to 300.00. Animal Samaritans charges CVAC 200.00 per spay/neuter. Even they are making money off the taxpayer.

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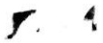

### Power Point Presentations/Printed Material:

Speakers who intend to conduct a formalized Power Point presentation or provide printed material must notify the Clerk of the Board's Office by 12 noon on the Monday preceding the Tuesday Board meeting, ensuring that the Clerk's Office has sufficient copies of all printed materials and at least one (1) copy of the Power Point CD. Copies of printed material given to the Clerk (by Monday noon deadline) will be provided to each Supervisor. If you have the need to use the overhead "Elmo" projector at the Board meeting, please ensure your material is clear and with proper contrast, notifying the Clerk well ahead of the meeting, of your intent to use the Elmo.
