#### Summary 5 1

The original authorized amount of the contract was \$64,790,010. The County Board of Supervisors approved Amendment No. 1 to the contract in the amount of \$117,250,000.00 on December 3, 2024 (Agenda Item 3.89). The total amount of Contract Change Order No. 24 exceeded the cumulative change order amounts that can be authorized by the Director of Transportation prior to the approval of Amendment No. 1. Therefore, this change order requires approval from the Board of Supervisors in accordance with Resolution No. 2019-035:

Details of the Contract Change Order is as follows:

• Contract Change Order No. 24 is \$0.00 (0.00% of the original contract amount)

Contract Change Order No. 24 represents a Contractor Requested Design Change as set forth in Amendment No. 1 to the Contract. Granite Construction Company requests plan modifications and hydraulic assessment to eliminate the proposed temporary shoring retaining wall as shown on Contract Plan Sheet Nos. P004 and P009 of 037 (Attachment 'A').

In addition to this Contract Change Order, the Transportation Department has issued 15 Contract Change Orders to date totaling \$12,650,884.90 (19.83% of the original contract amount). # Contractor Requested Design Change/Zero Dollar CCO:

This Contract Change Order (CCO) represents a Contractor Requested Design Change as set forth in Amendment No. 1 to the Contract. Granite Construction Company (Granite) has requested plan modifications to eliminate the proposed temporary shoring retaining wall as shown on Contract Plan Sheet Nos. P004 and P009 of 037 (see attached Attachment 'A'). Granite is pursuing the elimination of the temporary shoring retaining wall and the use of an alternate shoring system through Project Submittal 432 and resubmittals of Submittal 432.

Pursuant to Amendment No. 1 to the Contract, a Contractor Requested Design Change shall be memorialized in a zero dollar CCO signed by County and Granite. The cost of said Contractor Requested Design Change, including any and all associated fees (e.g. UPRR fees), shall be completely borne by Granite. Granite will reimburse the County for these costs within thirty (30) days of receipt of invoices from County showing said costs. Granite agrees to bear the following costs associated with these modifications, including but not limited to:

 Plan Modification & Hydraulic Assessment Costs: Granite shall be responsible for covering all costs related to plan modifications and the hydraulic assessment performed by HNTB, including design revisions, resubmissions, and any associated fees. HNTB's fees will be based on the amended contract between the County and HNTB and not the current contract terms between the County and HNTB.

**Coordination & Communication:** Granite shall coordinate the plan modifications and hydraulic assessment directly with HNTB. The County shall be included in all communications. The County will compensate HNTB for their associated costs, and Granite will reimburse the County for these costs. The County will coordinate the plan modifications with UPRR.

# Time Impact:

The contract critical path schedule will not be impacted due to these modifications. Therefore, no time adjustment will be warranted. All potential delay impacts for review whether plan modifications are approved or not shall be borne by Granite.

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




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
