BACKGROUND:

Summary

By Minute Order dated October 22, 2024 (Agenda Item 3.44), the County of Riverside Board of Supervisors authorized the Clerk of the Board to advertise for the construction of the Bennett Road Resurfacing Project in the Community of Southeast Desert Hot Springs in the Coachella Valley area of Riverside County. The segment length of Bennett Road to be resurfaced is approximately 1.1-miles between Dillon Road and 700-feet south of 19th Avenue.

Bennett Road is a two-lane road with graded shoulders that travels in the North-South directions with a road width that varies between 23-feet and 42-feet; and it is classified as an Arterial Highway in the circulation element of the County of Riverside's General Plan.

Roadway resurfacing is needed due to the deteriorated pavement conditions, which is generally associated with age and weathering. Mainly, the resurfacing project consists of grinding existing asphalt concrete in place (pulverize), mixing and compacting grindings with native soil, and overlaying the new base with new hot mix asphalt (HMA). At the Wild Canyon Wash culvert crossing, the resurfacing treatment will consist of grinding down a portion of the existing asphalt concrete pavement followed by overlaying back with HMA pavement.

Additional improvements include construction of concrete cross gutter and spandrels, asphalt concrete dike, reconstruction of asphalt concrete driveways, placement of safety edge to protect the outside edge of pavement, construction of a 2-foot deep cutoff wall at the southern end of the project to protect the new asphalt concrete pavement from damage caused by off-road vehicles, safety features include placing of thermoplastic crosswalk and pavement marking, roadside signs, and other associated work.

The Contract includes the following schedule of work:

Base Bid Schedule: Bennett Road Resurfacing

The contractor, Granite, is qualified to perform the work as outlined in the bid, has executed the contract, and has provided bonds and insurance documents which meet the requirements of the contract documents.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

The purpose of this project is to replace existing deteriorated pavement with new hot mix asphalt for an approximate 1.1-mile segment of Bennet Road in the Community of Southeast Desert Hot Springs to provide the public with a smooth paved roadway that will improve the safety and efficiency of vehicular traffic.

The work is scheduled to begin in spring 2025. The work will be phased to keep the road open during construction as much as possible and will take approximately one and a half months to complete.

SUPPLEMENTAL:

Additional Fiscal Information

Construction is expected to be completed in Fiscal Year 2024/2025 and will be funded with Gas Tax/SB-1 funds.

There are no General Funds used in this project.

Contract History and Price Reasonableness

A total of seven bids were received on Wednesday, November 13, 2024 ranging from \$778,520 to \$991,522. The basis for the selection of a contractor is the lowest responsive and responsible bid. The lowest responsive and responsible bid was submitted by Granite in the amount of \$778,520 which is \$159,280 (17%) below the engineer's cost estimate.

The Transportation Department recommends the award of the contract to Granite in the amount of \$778,520.

THIS CONTRACT is entered into at Riverside, California as of the date set forth below is between County of Riverside hereafter called "County" and Granite Construction Company, hereafter called "Contractor".

Recitals:

1. Contractor has submitted to County his Contractor's Proposal for the construction of County Project, **Bennett Road Resurfacing, Dillon Road to 700 Feet S/O 19th Avenue, Community of Southeast Desert Hot Springs, Project No. D1-0071**, in strict accordance with the Contract Documents identified below and County has accepted said Proposal.
2. Contractor states that he has reexamined his Contractor's Proposal and found it to be correct, has ascertained that his subcontractors are properly licensed and possess the requisite skill and forces, has reexamined the site and Contract Documents and is of the opinion that he can presently do the work in accordance with the Contract Documents for the money set forth in his Proposal to be paid as provided in the Contract Documents.

Agreement:

It is agreed by the parties as follows:

1. Contract Documents

The entire Contract consists of the following: (a) The Construction Contract, (b) The Notice to Bidders, (c) The Instruction to Bidders, (d) The Bid, (e) The Bid Bond, (f) The Payment Bond, (g) The Performance Bond, (h) The General Conditions, (i) The Special Provisions, (j) The Standard Specifications of the State of California Department of Transportation edition of **2018** as modified in other portions of the Contract Documents and as amended by the State of California Department of Transportation, (k) The Standard Plans of the Department of Transportation identified on the plans or in the Special Provisions, (l) The Plans, (m) Addenda **(One)**, (n) The Determination of Prevailing Wage Rates for Public Works, (o) Any Change Orders issued, and (p) Any additional or supplemental specific drawings issued in accordance with the provisions of the Contract Documents presently in existence are by this reference incorporated here set forth in full and upon the proper issuance of other documents deemed incorporated. The Bid Bond is exonerated upon execution of the Payment Bond and Performance Bond.

2. The Work

Contractor shall do all tasks necessary to construct the work generally described in Recital No. 1 in accordance with the Contract Documents.

3. Prosecution, Progress and Liquidated Damages

Attention is directed to the provisions in Section 8-1.04, "Start of Job Site Activities", Section 8-1.05, "Time", and in Section 8-1.10 "Liquidated Damages" of the Standard Specifications and these Special Provisions.

Standard Specification Section 8-1.04B, "Standard Start" is modified to read as follows:

The Contractor shall begin work within fifteen (15) calendar days, or as revised in the Special Provisions, of the date stated within the written "Notice to Proceed".

The Contractor shall notify the Engineer, in writing, of the Contractor's intent to begin work at least 72 hours before work is begun. If the project has more than one (1) location of work, Contractor shall submit a separate notice for each location. The notice shall be delivered to the Transportation Department's Construction Engineer and shall specify the date the Contractor intends to start at said location.

Should the Contractor begin work in advance of receiving a written "Notice to Proceed", any work performed by the Contractor in advance of the date stated in the "Notice to Proceed" shall be considered as having been done by the Contractor at his own risk and as a volunteer and subject to the following:

- A. The Contractor shall, on commencing operations, take all precautions required for public safety and shall observe all the provisions in the Specifications and the Special Provisions.
- B. All work done according to the Contract, prior to the issuance of the "Notice to Proceed", will be considered authorized work and will be paid for as provided in the contract.
- C. The Contractor shall not be entitled to any additional compensation or an extension of time for any delay, hindrance or interference caused by or attributable to commencement of work prior to the issuance of the "Notice to Proceed".

4. Compensation

Contractor shall be paid in the manner set forth in the Contract Documents the amount of his Proposal as accepted by County, the above rates, subject to additions and deductions as provided in the Contract Documents. Said Proposal is on file in the Office of the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors of County.

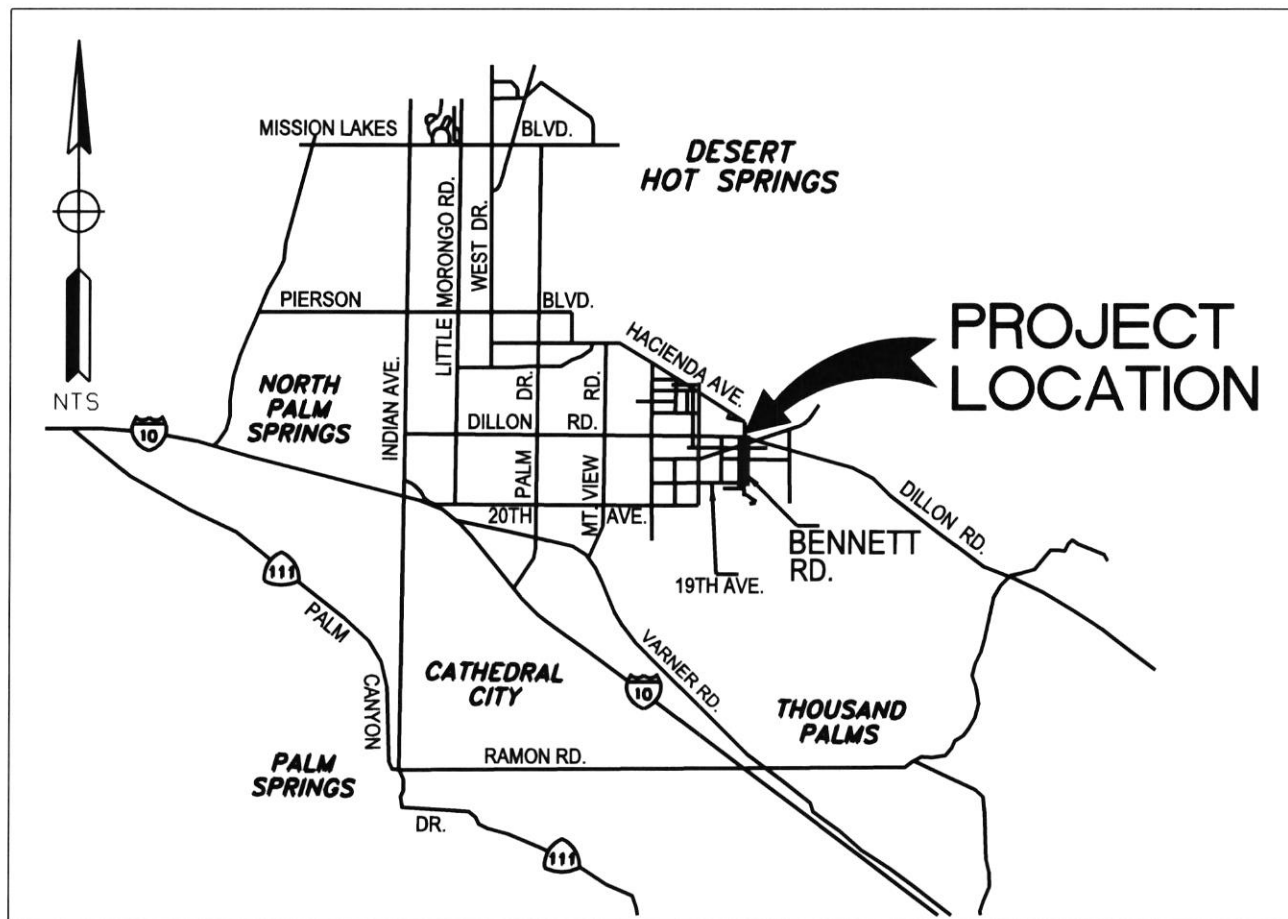
