Authorize the Clerk of the Board to advertise for bids to be received by the office of the Director of Transportation and Land Management at the Transportation Annex located at 3525 14th Street, Riverside, CA 92501. All bids must be received up to the hour of 2:00 p.m., Wednesday, February 26, 2025 at which time bids will be opened; and
4. Direct the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors to file the Notice of Exemption with the County Clerk and the State Clearinghouse for posting within five (5) working days.



BACKGROUND:

Summary

The County of Riverside Transportation Department is proposing to resurface approximately 5.4 miles of 8 different roads in the Community of North Shore.

The roads included are as follows:

68th Avenue is a two-lane facility that currently ranges from 28 to 40 feet in width. 70th Avenue is a two-lane facility that currently ranges from 25 to 32 feet in width. 72nd Avenue is a two-lane facility that currently ranges from 36 to 44 feet in width. Bay Drive is a two-lane facility that is currently 28 feet in width. Commerce Street is a two-lane facility that is currently 26 feet in width. Compass Drive is a two-lane facility that is currently 26 feet in width. Sea View Way is a two-lane facility that currently ranges from 22 to 37 feet in width. Vander Veer Road is a two-lane

facility that currently ranges from 26 to 36 feet. All included roadways are classified as local streets.

Roadway resurfacing is needed due to the deteriorated pavement conditions, generally associated with age and traffic loading. Mainly, the proposed resurfacing project will include two treatment types. The first treatment consists of removing the existing asphalt concrete pavement and underlying material and placing back new Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA) pavement. The second treatment consists of grinding down a portion of the existing asphalt concrete pavement followed by overlaying back with HMA pavement.

Improvements also include the construction of a reinforced concrete berm to replace the existing asphalt concrete berm along 70th Avenue, Vander Veer Road, and Sea View Way. Additionally, improvements will include the reconstruction of driveways, curb, cross-gutter and spandrels, Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) compliant curb ramps, placing of traffic striping, thermoplastic crosswalk, and pavement markings.

The submitted plans and specifications have been approved as to form by County Counsel.

The bid documents include the following bid schedule of work:

The Transportation Department will select the contractor based upon the lowest responsive and responsible bid.

Environmental Findings

The proposed project is exempt from CEQA under Section 15301 (c) – Existing Facilities exemption because the North Shore Area resurfacing does not create additional traffic lanes and involves negligible or no expansion of existing or former use of the existing roadway and associated facilities.

Impact on Citizens and Businesses

The purpose of this project is to replace existing deteriorated pavement with new hot mix asphalt for the approximate 5.4-miles of various streets in the Community of North Shore to provide the public with a smooth paved roadway that will improve the safety and efficiency of vehicular traffic.

The work is scheduled to begin in early summer 2025. The work will be phased to keep the roads open during construction as much as possible and will take approximately five months to complete.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The County of Riverside Transportation Department is proposing to resurface approximately 31,667 feet (6 miles) of road located in the North Shore community. The County of Riverside General Plan classifies 68th, 70th, 72nd Ave., Commerce St., Sea View Way, and Vander Veer Rd. as secondary highways and Compass Dr., and 72nd Ave from (Compass Dr. to Leeward Dr.) as local roads. All roads are currently two-lane roads and ranges from 24 to 40 feet wide and contain a mix of curb and gutter, Asphalt Concrete Dike, and Asphalt berm throughout the various segments of the roadway. The proposed project will include removing the existing roadway followed by paving back with hot mix asphalt (HMA).

The proposed project will also include:

- Reconstruction of concrete curb ramps, driveways, curbs, and gutters
- Reconstruction of asphalt dikes and driveways
- Construct modified concrete berm, cross gutters, and spandrels
- Utility adjustments
- Striping of roadway, including pavement markers/reflectors

ENVIRONMENTAL ANALYSIS:

No additional Right of Way or Temporary Construction Easements will be required to construct the proposed improvements. All improvements are to be done within the existing right of way.

This project is subject to compliance with the Coachella Valley Multiple Species Habitat Conservation Plan (CVMSHCP). In accordance with Section 7.1 of the CVMSHCP, necessary operation and maintenance along existing roadways are considered a covered activity outside/inside of cell criteria area/conservation areas. This project is considered to be an operation and maintenance; therefore, it is a covered activity under the CVMSHCP.

If tree and/or vegetation removal takes place during the migratory bird breeding season (February 1 – September 1), a preconstruction nesting survey will be conducted pursuant to the Migratory Bird Treaty Act (MBTA).

The County of Riverside Transportation Department has found that the above-described project is exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), based on the following:

Section 15301 (c) – Existing Facilities – The project proposes to resurface approximately 31,667 feet (6 miles) of existing roadway located in the North Shore community. The proposed project will include removing the existing roadway followed by paving back with hot mix asphalt (HMA). The project in its entirety is consistent with Section 15301(c) because it does not create additional traffic lanes and involves no expansion of use of the existing roadway and associated facilities.

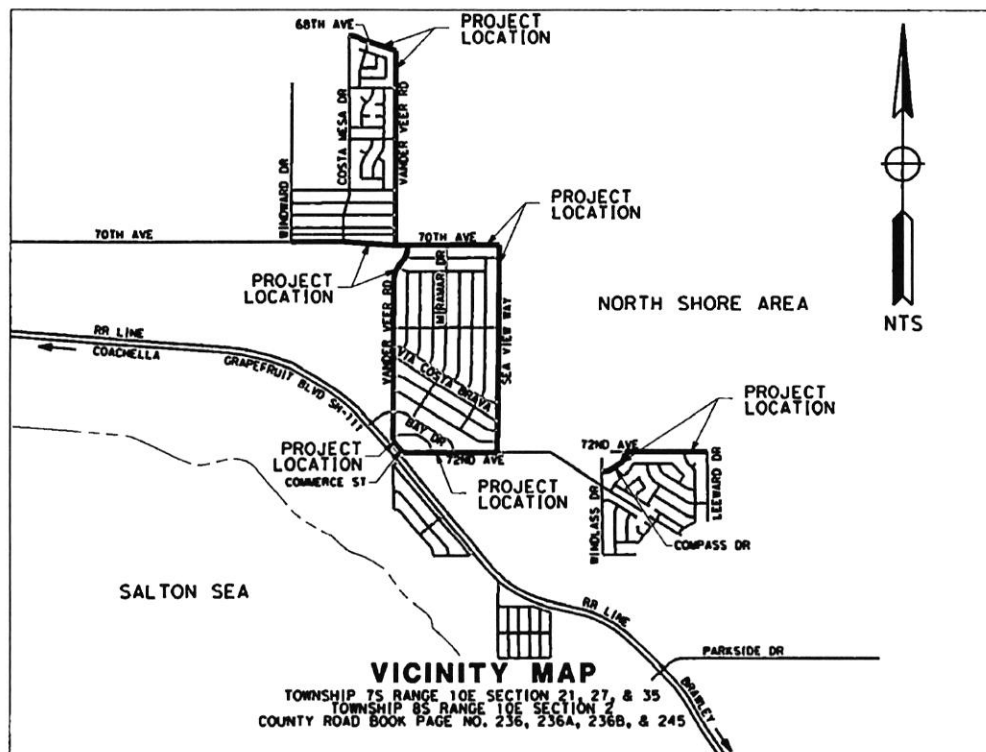
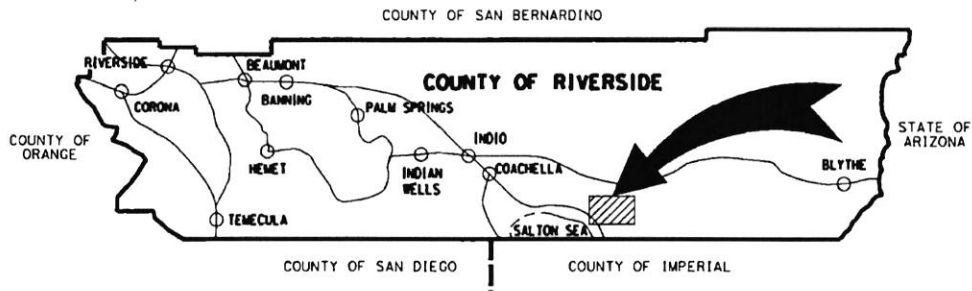

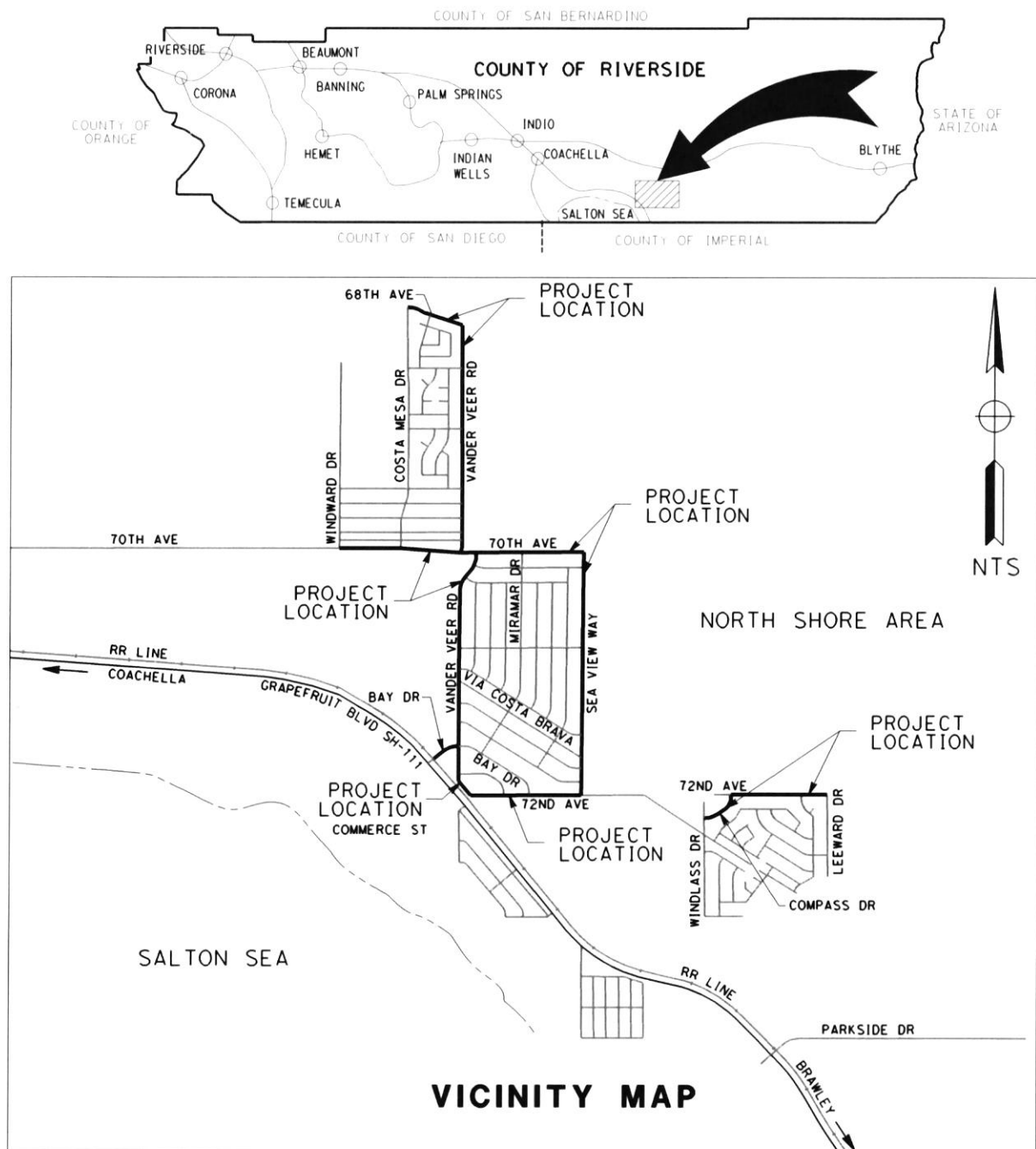

Power Point Presentations/Printed Material:

Speakers who intend to conduct a formalized Power Point presentation or provide printed material must notify the Clerk of the Board's Office by 12 noon on the Monday preceding the Tuesday Board meeting, ensuring that the Clerk's Office has sufficient copies of all printed materials and at least one (1) copy of the Power Point CD. Copies of printed material given to the Clerk (by Monday noon deadline) will be provided to each Supervisor. If you have the need to use the overhead "Elmo" projector at the Board meeting, please ensure your material is clear and with proper contrast, notifying the Clerk well ahead of the meeting, of your intent to use the Elmo. Individual Speaker Limits:

When you have 30 seconds remaining, the "yellow" light will begin flash, indicating you must quickly wrap up your comments. Your time is up when the "red" light flashes. 
