BACKGROUND:

Summary

On January 28, 2025, the Board of Supervisors directed the County Executive Officer and County Counsel to prepare a resolution affirming that the County of Riverside is a vibrant, compassionate, and inclusionary county for all law-abiding immigrants and refugees for the Board of Supervisors' consideration at their meeting on February 4, 2025.

The proposed resolution seeks to reinforce the Board of Supervisors' commitment to follow the law and to support for the law-abiding immigrant and refugee community.

RESOLUTION NO. 2025-055
A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE
AFFIRMING RIVERSIDE COUNTY TO BE A VIBRANT, COMPASSIONATE, AND
WELCOMING COUNTY FOR ALL LAW-ABIDING IMMIGRANTS AND REFUGEES

WHEREAS, Riverside County is home to persons of diverse racial, ethnic, and national backgrounds, including a large immigrant population, with foreign-born residents comprising over 22% of the County's total population; and

WHEREAS, All Riverside County immigrant residents, whether they are U.S. citizens, permanent residents, undocumented residents, refugees, or residents with any other immigration status, are valued and integral members of our social, cultural, and economic fabric; and

WHEREAS, Riverside County recognizes its long and rich history of immigrants who have contributed to our cultural community, local economy, and become leaders in agriculture, tourism, military, education, business, healthcare, government, and other professions; and

WHEREAS, Law-abiding immigrants and refugees add significantly not only to the County's economy, but also to the vitality of the state and national economies, with foreign-born workers representing almost 20% of the United States labor force and more than 35% of business owners in California; and

WHEREAS, Riverside County endeavors to inform all residents that interacting with local government should not put any residents at risk, regardless of immigration status, and irrespective of what service the individual is seeking to access, including benefits, reporting a crime, filing a legal document, or any of the countless other ways a resident and government come together; and

WHEREAS, Reducing language and cultural barriers to services and participation in civic life promotes coordination of services and resources for law-abiding immigrants and refugees across all systems, champions cultural competence and understanding, and strengthens accountability to maintain the highest quality of services for our communities; and

WHEREAS, The recent heightened attention on immigration has resulted in concerns and uncertainty among many, including but not limited to immigrants, vulnerable residents, families in our community, and service providers; and

WHEREAS, The State of California has enacted several statewide laws as a deliberate declaration that California recognizes and values the contributions of immigrants in our communities, including:

- The TRUST Act, Assembly Bill 4 (Chapter 570, Statutes of 2013), which limits the circumstances under which local law enforcement can detain individuals on behalf of federal immigration authorities; and
- The TRUTH Act, Assembly Bill 2792 (Chapter 768, Statutes of 2016), which ensures transparency and oversight regarding local law enforcement's communication with federal immigration authorities; and

- The VALUES Act, Senate Bill 54 (Chapter 495, Statutes of 2017), which limits the circumstances under which local law enforcement may use funds or personnel to support immigration enforcement and prevents police and sheriff's deputies from asking about an individual's immigration status, from sharing a person's personal information with immigration authorities, unless otherwise required or permitted by law, or from arresting anyone only for having a deportation removal order or for most other immigration violations; and
- California Welfare and Institutions Code section 831, which: 1) clarifies that juvenile court records and information are confidential regardless of a youth's immigration status; 2) makes clear that federal officials do not get automatic access to juvenile court records and must petition the juvenile court in order to be permitted access; and, 3) states that a child's name and immigration status are protected by California's confidentiality laws and cannot be disclosed without court permission; and
- California Government Code section 7285.1, which prohibits employers from voluntarily allowing ICE agents access to non-public areas of their workplaces or employee records without a judicial warrant; and
- California Government Code section 7285.2, which prohibits employers from allowing ICE agents to access, review, or obtain the employer's employee records without a subpoena or judicial warrant; and

WHEREAS, The Board of Supervisors has an established history of taking steps to support immigrants in Riverside County, including:

- Adopting a resolution in 2013 in support of comprehensive immigration reform, advocating for security/national defense, a tough but fair pathway to citizenship, a guest worker program for agricultural workers and other subsistence-wage workers, a special provision to ensure minor children are treated separately, a registration program with the government to combat visa overstay, and an improved process for admitting future workers to serve our nation's workforce needs while simultaneously protecting all workers (Resolution No. 2013-050); and
- Adopting a resolution in 2018 in support of undocumented immigrants who came to the United States as children ("Dreamers") and/or participants in the Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals (DACA) program, advocating for a federal legislative solution to allow Dreamers to remain in the country (Resolution No. 2018-028); and
- Creating subject matter expert attorney and paralegal positions for the Law Offices of the Public Defender's Office to provide legal assistance to noncitizen indigent clients facing criminal charges in state court, allowing the County to provide effective legal assistance to noncitizen clients as required pursuant to the United States Supreme Court decision in *Padilla v. Kentucky*, 559 U.S. 356 (2010) (Item 3.25 on the Board of Supervisors agenda for October 23, 2018); and
- Adopting a resolution in 2023 establishing the Eastern Coachella Valley Enhanced Infrastructure Financing District, also known as *ECV Prospera*, will result in funding for expanded public infrastructure (including but not limited to infrastructure for water and

wastewater, transportation, utilities, and telecommunication) and for improvements to the Salton Sea (Resolution No. 2023-051); and

- Enhancing efforts to provide meaningful access to Spanish-speaking residents at Board of Supervisors' meeting by providing simultaneous Spanish interpretation of all comments made by board members, county staff, and members of the public, resulting in increased understanding, engagement and civic participation (Item 3.6 on the Board of Supervisors agenda for November 7, 2023); and

WHEREAS, It is important that Riverside County remains a vibrant, compassionate, and welcoming county for all law-abiding immigrants and refugees, and that we are One County and that all of our residents, regardless of immigration status, contribute to the social and economic fabric of this county.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside:

1. Affirms that Riverside County is a vibrant, compassionate, and welcoming county for all law-abiding immigrants and refugees; and
2. Commits to safeguarding the civil rights of all our residents to the fullest extent provided by the law; and
3. Directs all County departments to continue to follow California state law, including the TRUST Act, the TRUTH Act, the VALUES Act, and Welfare and Institutions Code sections 827 et seq, Government Code sections 7285.1 and 7285.2 (and as they may be subsequently amended); and
4. Confirms that no County department or employee will initiate inquiry or enforcement action based solely on a person's actual or suspected immigration status, national origin, race, ethnicity and/or English proficiency, unless required to do so by state or federal law; and
5. Directs all County departments to review their confidentiality policies to ensure that eligible individuals are not deterred from seeking services or engaging with services based on immigration status; and
6. Promotes the value among residents of advancing efforts for integrating law-abiding immigrant and refugee communities, recognizing that a community is strongest when everyone feels welcomed; and
7. Continues to advocate for comprehensive, commonsense, and compassionate immigration reform and collaborate with stakeholders (including local institutions, organizations, and individuals) who are committed to this work.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside:

8. Intends that this Resolution shall not be construed to prohibit any County department's assistance or cooperation with federal authorities if required by state and/or federal laws; and

9. Intends that this Resolution shall not be construed to affect the independent and constitutionally designated investigative and prosecutorial functions of the Sheriff and District Attorney as provided in Government Code section 25303.

RESOLUCIÓN NO. 2025-055

UNA RESOLUCIÓN DE LA JUNTA DE SUPERVISORES DEL CONDADO DE RIVERSIDE QUE AFIRMA QUE EL CONDADO DE RIVERSIDE SEA VIBRANTE, COMPASIVO Y LE DE LA BIENVENIDA A TODOS LOS INMIGRANTES Y REFUGIADOS QUE RESPETAN LA LEY

MIENTRAS QUE, el Condado de Riverside es hogar de personas de diversos orígenes raciales, étnicos y nacionales, incluida una gran población de inmigrantes, y los residentes nacidos en el extranjero representan más del 22% de la población total del Condado; y

MIENTRAS QUE, todos los residentes inmigrantes del Condado de Riverside ya sean ciudadanos estadounidenses, residentes permanentes, residentes indocumentados, refugiados o residentes con cualquier otro estatus migratorio, son miembros valiosos e integrales de nuestro tejido social, cultural y económico; y

MIENTRAS QUE, el Condado de Riverside reconoce su larga y rica historia de inmigrantes que han contribuido a nuestra comunidad cultural, economía local y se han convertido en líderes en agricultura, turismo, ejército, educación, negocios, atención médica, gobierno y otras profesiones; y

MIENTRAS QUE, los inmigrantes y refugiados respetuosos de la ley aportan significativamente no sólo a la economía del condado, sino también a la vitalidad de las economía estatal y nacional, con trabajadores nacidos en el extranjero que representan casi el 20% de la fuerza laboral de los Estados Unidos y más del 35% de dueños de negocios en California; y

MIENTRAS QUE, el Condado de Riverside se esfuerza por informar a todos los residentes que la interacción con el gobierno local no debe poner a ningún residente en riesgo, independientemente de su estatus migratorio e independientemente del servicio al que el individuo busca acceder, incluidos beneficios, denuncia de un delito, presentación de un documento legal., o cualquiera de las innumerables otras formas en que un residente y el gobierno se unen; y

MIENTRAS QUE, la reducción de las barreras lingüísticas y culturales a los servicios y la participación en la vida cívica promueve la coordinación de servicios y recursos para inmigrantes y refugiados respetuosos de la ley en todos los sistemas, defiende la competencia y la comprensión cultural y fortalece la responsabilidad para mantener la más alta calidad de los servicios para nuestras comunidades.; y

MIENTRAS QUE, el reciente enfoque a la inmigración ha resultado en preocupaciones e incertidumbre entre muchos, incluidos, entre otros, inmigrantes, residentes vulnerables, familias de nuestra comunidad y proveedores de servicios; y

MIENTRAS QUE, el Estado de California ha promulgado varias leyes estatales como una declaración deliberada de que California reconoce y valora las contribuciones de los inmigrantes en nuestras comunidades, que incluyen:

- La Ley de Confianza, Proyecto de Ley 4 de la Asamblea (Capítulo 570, Estatutos de 2013), que limita las circunstancias bajo las cuales las autoridades locales pueden detener a personas en nombre de las autoridades federales de inmigración; y

- La Ley VERDAD, Proyecto de Ley de la Asamblea 2792 (Capítulo 768, Estatutos de 2016), que garantiza la transparencia y la supervisión de la comunicación de las autoridades locales con las autoridades federales de inmigración; y

- La Ley VALORES, Proyecto de Ley del Senado 54 (Capítulo 495, Estatutos de 2017), que limita las circunstancias bajo las cuales las autoridades locales pueden usar fondos o personal para apoyar la aplicación de la ley de inmigración y evita que la policía y los ayudantes del alguacil pregunten sobre el estatus migratorio de un individuo, compartan la información personal de una persona ante las autoridades de inmigración, a menos que la ley exija o permita lo contrario, o arrestar a alguien sólo por tener una orden de deportación o por la mayoría de las otras violaciones de inmigración; y

- Sección 831 del Código de Bienestar e Instituciones de California, que: 1) aclara que los registros y la información del tribunal juvenil son confidenciales independientemente del estado migratorio del joven; 2) deja claro que los funcionarios federales no obtienen acceso automático a los registros del tribunal de menores y deben solicitar al tribunal de menores que se les permita el acceso; y, 3) establece que el nombre y el estado migratorio de un niño están protegidos por las leyes de confidencialidad de California y no pueden divulgarse sin permiso judicial; y

- Sección 7285.1 del Código de Gobierno de California, que prohíbe a los empleadores permitir voluntariamente que los agentes de ICE accedan a áreas

no públicas de sus lugares de trabajo o a los registros de los empleados sin una orden judicial; y

- Sección 7285.2 del Código de Gobierno de California, que prohíbe a los empleadores permitir que los agentes de ICE accedan, revisen u obtengan los registros de los empleados del empleador sin una comparecencia u orden judicial; y

MIENTRAS QUE, la Junta de Supervisores tiene un historial establecido de tomar medidas para apoyar a los inmigrantes en el condado de Riverside, que incluyen:

- Adoptar una resolución en 2013 en apoyo de una reforma migratoria integral, abogar por la seguridad/defensa nacional, un camino difícil pero justo hacia la ciudadanía, un programa de trabajadores invitados para trabajadores agrícolas y otros trabajadores con salarios de subsistencia, una disposición especial para garantizar que los niños menores reciban tratamiento por separado, un programa de registro con el gobierno para combatir las estadías vencidas de las visas y un proceso mejorado para admitir a futuros trabajadores para satisfacer las necesidades de la fuerza laboral de nuestra nación y al mismo tiempo proteger a todos los trabajadores (Resolución No. 2013-050); y
- Adoptar una resolución en 2018 en apoyo de los inmigrantes indocumentados que llegaron a los Estados Unidos cuando eran niños (“Dreamers”) y/o participantes en el programa de Acción Diferida para los Llegados en la Infancia

(DACA), abogando por una solución legislativa federal para permitir que los Dreamers permanezcan en el país (Resolución No. 2018-028); y

- Crear puestos de abogados expertos en la materia y asistentes legales para las Oficinas Legales de la Oficina del Defensor Público para brindar asistencia legal a clientes indigentes no ciudadanos que enfrentan cargos penales en los tribunales estatales, lo que permite al Condado brindar asistencia legal efectiva a clientes no ciudadanos según lo exigen los Estados Unidos. Decisión de la Corte Suprema en Padilla v. Kentucky, 559 U.S. 356 (2010) (Punto 3.25 de la agenda de la Junta de Supervisores del 23 de octubre de 2018); y
- La adopción de una resolución en 2023 que establece el Distrito de Financiamiento de Infraestructura Mejorada del Este del Valle de Coachella, también conocido como ECV Prospera, resultará en financiamiento para infraestructura pública ampliada (que incluye, entre otros, infraestructura para agua y aguas residuales, transporte, servicios públicos y telecomunicaciones) y para mejoras al lago Salton Sea (Resolución No. 2023-051); y
- Mejorar los esfuerzos para proporcionar un acceso significativo a los residentes de habla hispana en las reuniones de la Junta de Supervisores proporcionando interpretación simultánea en español de todos los comentarios hechos por los miembros de la junta, el personal del condado y los miembros del público, lo que

resulta en una mayor comprensión, compromiso y participación cívica (Artículo 3.6 de la agenda de la Junta de Supervisores para el 7 de noviembre de 2023); y

MIENTRAS QUE, es importante que el Condado de Riverside siga siendo un condado vibrante, compasivo y acogedor para todos los inmigrantes y refugiados respetuosos de la ley, y que seamos un Condado y que todos nuestros residentes, independientemente de su estatus migratorio, contribuyan al desarrollo social y económico de este condado. AHORA, POR LO TANTO, SE RESUELVE que la Junta de Supervisores del Condado de Riverside:

1. Afirma que el Condado de Riverside es un condado vibrante, compasivo y acogedor para todos los inmigrantes y refugiados respetuosos de la ley; y
2. Se compromete a salvaguardar los derechos civiles de todos nuestros residentes en la máxima medida prevista por la ley; y
3. Ordena a todos los departamentos del condado que continúen cumpliendo con la ley del estado de California, incluida la Ley de CONFIANZA, la Ley de VERDAD, la Ley de VALORES y las secciones 827 y siguientes del Código de Bienestar e Instituciones, y las secciones 7285.1 y 7285.2 del Código de Gobierno (y sus modificaciones posteriores).; y
4. Confirma que ningún departamento o empleado del Condado iniciará una investigación o acción coercitiva basándose únicamente en el estatus migratorio, origen nacional, raza, etnia y/o dominio del inglés, real o sospechado, de una persona, a menos que así lo exija la ley estatal o federal; y

5. Ordena a todos los departamentos del condado que revisen sus políticas de confidencialidad para garantizar que las personas elegibles no se vean disuadidas de buscar servicios o contratar servicios según su estado migratorio; y
6. Promueve el valor entre los residentes de avanzar en los esfuerzos para integrar a las comunidades de inmigrantes y refugiados que respetan la ley, reconociendo que una comunidad es más fuerte cuando todos se sienten bienvenidos; y
7. Continúa abogando por una reforma migratoria integral, compasiva y de sentido común y colabora con las partes interesadas (incluidas instituciones, organizaciones e individuos locales) que están comprometidos con este trabajo.

SE RESUELVE ADEMÁS que la Junta de Supervisores del Condado de Riverside:

8. Pretende que esta Resolución no se interprete en el sentido de prohibir la asistencia o cooperación de cualquier departamento del Condado con las autoridades federales si así lo exigen las leyes estatales y/o federales; y
9. Pretende que esta Resolución no se interprete en el sentido de afectar las funciones de investigación y procesamiento independientes y constitucionalmente designadas del Alguacil y la Fiscalía según lo dispuesto en la sección 25303 del Código de Gobierno.
