BACKGROUND:

Summary

On December 03, 2024 (Minute Order 3.7) the Board of Supervisors approved the First Quarter Adjustment Report submitted by the Executive Office. The report included a recommendation from the Executive Office to transfer the Sheriff's Office remaining general fund balance at year end into capital project fund 30704. For FY 2023/24, \$3,291,860 was available to transfer from the Sheriff's general fund to the capital project fund 30704. This funding will be used toward expenses related to the Ben Clark Training Center (BCTC) modernization project.

As the Sheriff's Office incurs costs for the BCTC modernization project, a monthly request for revenue reimbursement will be submitted to the Executive Office to offset posted expenses from the CIP Fund 30704. The revenue request for reimbursement will follow the same process as County DIF project reimbursements. Once expenses are realized by the Sheriff's Office, claims will be submitted to the Executive Office for revenue reimbursement. The Sheriff's Office expenses related to the BCTC modernization project will balance to the revenue reimbursement at fiscal year-end, therefore resulting in no effect to Net County Cost.

The project balances will be monitored by the Executive Office. Project reimbursements from capital project fund 30704 will not exceed \$3,291,860 for the following BCTC P3 related projects.
