BACKGROUND:

Summary

Section 18 of the District Act requires the District's Board of Supervisors ("Board") to hold a public hearing for the purpose of considering all comments regarding any proposed facilities before authorizing the construction of such facilities.

The Project consists of the construction, operation and maintenance of approximately 12,500 feet (ft) of storm drains ranging in diameter from 18"-84", a detention basin, three (3) inlet structures, multiple catch basins, an outlet structure and rock riprap energy dissipators in the Project area. Storm drains are proposed in the rights of way of existing roads, providing 100-year flood protection to the properties between Quail Drive and Spring Street and properties east of Spring Street and west of Theda Street between Olive Avenue and Eucalyptus Avenue. The District has also partnered with the Riverside County Transportation Department to provide road improvements to a portion of the Project area in conjunction with the installation of the underground facilities. Collectively, these improvements will safely convey stormwater flows to the existing box culvert located near the intersection of SR-74 and Theda Street, thereby eliminating significant surface drainage from meandering through existing residential properties during large storm events.

The Project will also construct three (3) inlet structures at the northwest corner of Read Street and Mountain Avenue, the northwest corner of Olympia Avenue and Read Street, and northwest of Eucalyptus Avenue and Quail Road to collect storm flows from within the Project area and convey them to a detention basin at the northwest corner of Spring Street and Olive Avenue, which will then drain to the existing culvert and cross underneath SR-74. The Project will also repair and replace the existing outlet structure and riprap located at the southeast side of SR-74.

California Environmental Quality Act ("CEQA")

In accordance with the California Environmental Quality Act ("CEQA"), the District prepared and circulated an Initial Study (SCH #2024081408), which analyzed the environmental impacts of the Project. The results of the Initial Study ("IS") showed the Project, with the incorporation of feasible mitigation, would not result in a significant impact on the environment and a Mitigated Negative Declaration ("MND") was proposed. The District circulated the IS, Mitigation Monitoring and Reporting Program ("MMRP"), a Notice of Intent to Adopt an MND and an MND

for a thirty (30) day public review period. On April 1, 2025, the date of the Section 18 public hearing, the District's Board will consider the IS/MND. Nothing further is required at this time pursuant to CEQA.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

The proposed Project will result in improved flood protection within the Project vicinity. Additionally, some unpaved roads will be paved and improved within the proposed Project area.





Good Hope - Olive Avenue Storm Drain, Stages 1 and 2 Project No. 4-0-00425 Engineer's Statement

Good Hope - Olive Avenue Storm Drain, Stages 1 and 2 is located in the unincorporated community of Good Hope, between the cities of Perris and Lake Elsinore. The project area is bounded by Mountain Avenue to the north, Eucalyptus Avenue to the south, Highway 74 to the southeast, Theda Street to the east, and Read Street to the west, and is located just southwest of the limits of the Good Hope Master Drainage Plan (MDP).

The proposed project is a storm drain improvement project to alleviate flooding issues experienced by properties downstream of the Gavilan Hills mountain range. The project will construct storm drain infrastructures, including approximately 12,200 feet of different sized reinforced concrete pipe, 140 lineal feet of 5' x 10' reinforced concrete box (RCB), a basin, three inlet structures, outlet energy dissipation measures, and potential slope stabilization.

The project also proposes road improvements along sections of unpaved roadway within Read Street, Mountain Avenue, and Steele Peak Avenue. The proposed improvements will safely convey stormwater flows to an existing box culvert located just east of the intersection of Theda Street and Highway 74 to eliminate significant surface drainage from going through existing residential properties during large storm events. The proposed project would disturb approximately 8.21 acres either temporarily or permanently.

Estimated project cost: \$20.0 million.

Estimated construction duration: 13 months (256 Working Days).
