#### BACKGROUND:

#### Summary

The Riverside County Transportation Department (Transportation Department) is proceeding to implement onsite landscape restoration from project environmental impacts in accordance with the permit requirements for the Hamner Avenue Bridge Over Santa Ana River project.

The landscape restoration will be implemented in accordance with permit approvals associated with the project issued by the California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW), Regional Water Quality Control Board (RWQCB), and U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE).

On December 17, 2024, (Agenda Item 3.27) the Board of Supervisors approved project advertisement to solicit prequalification packages from Landscaping Contractors.

On January 16, 2025, five prequalification applications were received from potential landscaping contractors. One contractor, Marina Landscape Inc., was determined not to be qualified for the type of work required for this project.

Four prequalification applications were accepted, and all four landscape contractors were determined to be qualified. The following are the companies whose applications are recommended to be approved and allowed to bid on this project:

- 1. Dudek
- 2. Natures Image, Inc.
- 3. Helix Environmental Planning, Inc.
- 4. Pacific Restoration Group, Inc.

The proposed restoration project includes various sites located adjacent to the new Hamner Avenue Bridge over Santa Ana River. The combined restoration sites consist of approximately 5.8 acres. Mainly, the restoration project will consist of removal of nonnative plant species, trash, and debris; soil preparation, installation of temporary irrigation system, installation of

native plant species by planting and seeding followed by hydroseeding that will provide the basis for ecosystem restoration, and a five-year monitoring and maintenance period. The awarded landscaping contractor will enhance and restore areas by preparing the sites, remove invasive species of plants, obtain seeds and plant material from reliable native plant nurseries, properly plant, irrigate, and monitor native plants to ensure successful establishment.

The bid documents include the following bid schedule of work:

Base Bid Schedule: Bridge Channel Revegetation for Replacement of Hamner Avenue Bridge Over Santa Ana River

The Transportation Department will select the contractor based upon the lowest responsive and responsible bid.

The submitted plans and specifications have been approved as to form by County Counsel.

#### **Environmental Findings**

The City of Norco is the lead agency for the approval of the CEQA document for the Project. By Minute Order dated April 17, 2019 (Agenda item 6B), the Norco City Council adopted the Initial Study/Mitigated Negative Declaration for the Hamner Avenue Bridge Replacement Project. The Notice of Determination was posted with the Riverside County Recorder's Office on April 22, 2019.

The County serves as a responsible agency pursuant to the requirements of CEQA. On May 5, 2020, the Board adopted Resolution 2020-067 and a Notice of Determination was filed to make the requisite responsible agency CEQA findings associated with the Project.

A Categorical Exclusion in accordance with 23 USC 327 for NEPA was executed on April 8, 2019 by the State Department of Transportation (Caltrans).

#### Impact on Citizens and Businesses

The ultimate goal of the project is to restore native plant communities that provide ecosystem benefits and wildlife habitat.

The project will restore and enhance various areas adjacent to the new Hamner Avenue Bridge over Santa Ana River by:

- 1. Restoring Santa Ana floodplain to pre-existing elevations and contours,
- 2. Enhancing floodplain through non-native/invasive plant removal and control, and

3. Restoring existing riparian and wetland habitat with revegetated areas using a variety of planting techniques including seeding, select container planting, and large tree planting.

The work is scheduled to begin in the Summer of 2025 and will take approximately five months to complete and will be followed by a 5-year monitoring and plant establishment maintenance period.

#### SUPPLEMENTAL:

#### **Additional Fiscal Information:**

The construction contract is estimated to cost approximately \$929,611. The Bridge Channel Revegetation for Replacement of Hamner Avenue Bridge Over Santa Ana River Project construction contract will be funded with Federal - Highway Infrastructure Program (HIP) funds for which the Department successfully competed, and DIF AP5 Maj. Imp. Fnd- Eastvale Area funds.

There are no General Funds used in this project.


