

BACKGROUND:

Riverside County Workforce Development Board (WDB) is a private sector led policy and oversight body that supports the development of the regional workforce. The WDB is governed by the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act of 2014 (WIOA) which mandates that more than 50% of the WDB's members must come from the business community. In addition, WDBs are required to have representation from universities or community colleges, economic development, and workforce representatives including labor organizations. This ensures that federal funds for workforce development activities are expended on training and career coaching that meets the needs of the business community. Pursuant to WIOA, the Board of Supervisors, led by the Board Chairman who serves as the Chief Local Elected Official (CLEO), is responsible for appointing WDB members for two-year terms.

Mr. Patrick Ellis, President/CEO of Murrieta/Wildomar Chamber of Commerce, has expressed interest in continuing to serve on the Workforce Development Board (WDB) as a private-sector member for the 3rd district. Mr. Ellis has more than 14 years of experience in the Chamber

industry and helped revitalize the Murrieta Chamber of Commerce. In 2017, he led the merger of the Murrieta Chamber and Wildomar Chamber into the Murrieta/Wildomar Chamber of Commerce.

Mr. Ellis is active with the Southwest California Legislative Council, a coalition of five chambers, to address Federal, State and County legislative issues. He sits on the board of directors for the Economic Development Coalition and served as the Riverside County Workforce Development Board Chair from 2021-2024. With his leadership on the WDB and in the Southwest region, the WDB is optimistic about increasing business participation in WDB activities.

If reappointed, Mr. Ellis will serve a two-year term commencing May 2, 2025, and expiring May 2, 2027.
