

**BACKGROUND:**

Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

1. **All From The Heart-** \$15,000- The funding will be used to provide refurbished power wheelchairs and scooters to veterans with disabilities.
2. **Riverside County Department of Public Social Services-** \$ 4,000- The funding will support the 2025 Elder and Dependent Adult Abuse Symposium, an event aimed at raising awareness about elder and dependent adult abuse by educating attendees on warning signs and available support programs.

3. **Antelope-Menifee Rural Center**-\$10,000 —The funding will be used to replace three steel entry/exit doors with panic hardware to ensure the building's doors comply with CalFire safety requirements.
4. **Riverside University Health System Foundation**-\$5,000-The funding will support the RUHS Foundation's Pinwheels for Prevention program, which provides foster children who have been neglected or abused with essential items, such as toothbrushes and medical care.
5. **The Salvation Army, A California Corporation**- \$7,500- The funds will be used to support the Child Spree 2025 program, which provides disadvantaged children with essential back-to-school supplies.
6. **Lake Elsinore Community Foundation** -\$1,200- The funds will be allocated to support the Wildomar Student of the Month program, which honors high school seniors for their achievements and provides them with college scholarships.
7. **VNW Circle of Care Inc.** -\$10,000- The funds will be used to provide grocery assistance to low-income residents of the Third District, including military families, single parents, and homeless individuals.
8. **Riverside County Deputy Sheriff Relief Foundation**- \$7,500- The funds will be used to purchase uniforms, training equipment, athletic shoes, and registration fees for advanced training and competition for youth 14 to 21 years of age.
9. **Canine Support Teams, Inc.**- \$5,000- The funds will be used to support the veterans' training program, which provides highly trained service dogs to veterans at no cost.
10. **Riverside County Youth Advisory Council**- \$4,000- The funds will support the annual Youth Summit, an event that offers high school students networking opportunities, career guidance, and financial literacy education.
11. **Mrs. B's Table**- \$3,000- The funds will support the Bee Ready Backpack Giveaway, a drive-thru event that provides students with backpacks filled with grade-appropriate school supplies along with bags of groceries to support families as they prepare for the school year.
