Section 1. Section 2.4 of Ordinance No. 452, entitled "Forty miles per hour," is hereby amended to add new subsection 165 to read as follows:

Section 2.6 established a fifty
miles per hour speed limit on De WashIngton Street

Portola Road between Pauba Road and Glen Oaks Road, a total alstance of approximately 4.18 miles, in the Temecula area.

Section 8. Subsection 4 of Section 3.6 of Ordinance 452 adopted on March 29, 2016, pursuant to Ordinance No. 452.240, is repealed in its entirety. Subsection 4 of Section 3.6 established a twenty-five miles per hour speed limit on Leon Road between Borel Road and Auld Road, a total distance of approximately 0.76 miles, in the French Valley area.

Section 9. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days after its adoption.
