BACKGROUND: Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

1. The donation to Milvet (\$2,500.00) will be used to support the MilVet Honors event, which addresses the needs of veterans by providing vital resources, assisting with filing for disability benefits, food/household pantry needs, holiday support, and expanding outreach efforts and programs for veterans and their families.
2. The donation to Hospice of the Valleys SC (\$2,500.00) will support the Senior Assistance Program, which helps patients and families cover costs associated with hospice care in the City of Canyon Lake and Lake Elsinore.
3. The donation to the Rondo School of Discovery (\$4,000.00) will be used to support the Rondo Art Walk, which raises funds for elementary school students to participate in art lessons and art supplies. The Art Walk showcases the students' work and allows families to participate in crafts and activities.
4. The donation to Eastvale Kiwanis Club (\$5,000.00) will support the Ike Bootsma Memorial Scholarship, Today a Reader Tomorrow a Leader, which helps deserving Eleanor Roosevelt High School Key Club members to attend college/university and the 7 elementary school libraries in the district with the costs for items and books for students.

The donation to the Rotary Club of Corona (\$5,000.00) will directly support community enrichment efforts to provide contributions to the local YMCA, Corona-Norco Settlement House, Corona Police Explorers, U.S. Naval Sea Cadet Corps, and Peppermint Ridge. Additionally, the grant will support college scholarships to graduating seniors and sponsor high school juniors to attend the Rotary Youth Leadership Awards Camp.
6. The donation to the Foundation for Anoxic Injury Recovery (FAIR) (\$750.00) will support the Pediatrician Water Safety Initiative & Swim Scholarships to significantly reduce drowning incidents and equip parents with vital knowledge and skills to protect their children from life-long disabilities caused by non-fatal drowning incidents.
