3. Authorize the Clerk of the Board to advertise for bids to be received by the office of the office of the Director of Transportation and Land Management at the Transportation Annex located at 3525 14th Street, Riverside, CA 92501. All bids must be received up to the hour of 2:00 p.m., Wednesday, June 4, 2025 at which time bids will be opened; and
4. Direct the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors to file the Notice of Exemption with the County Clerk and the State Clearinghouse for posting within five (5) working days.



BACKGROUND:

Summary

The Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) provides for the construction of the Cajalco Road and Lake Mathews Drive Guardrail Reconstruction Project, in the Community of Lake Mathews. The project limits on Cajalco Road are between La Sierra Avenue and Kirkpatrick Road, and between Harley John Road and Wood Road. The limits on Lake Mathews Drive are between Capello Drive and Malta Place.

The proposed improvements include removing existing segments of guardrail at various locations and replacing them with new up-to-date standards for guardrail. Additional work includes placement of guard rail reflective delineators, reconstruction of existing asphalt concrete dike, and other work that may be required. An approximate combined length of 3,972 feet of existing metal beam guardrail will be replaced along Cajalco Road and Lake Mathews Drive.

The submitted plans and specifications have been approved as to form by County Counsel.

The bid documents include the following bid schedule of work:

The Transportation Department will select the contractor based upon the lowest responsive and responsible bid.

Environmental Findings

The project proposes to replace existing guardrail and associated safety improvements. These safety improvements to the existing roadway are exempt from CEQA under Section 15301 (c) because the activity does not create additional automobile lanes and involves no expansion of use of the existing roadway and associated facilities. None of the exceptions to the use of the exemption pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines Section 15300.2 apply.

Impact on Citizens and Businesses

The proposed guardrail improvements will enhance roadway safety within the project limits by providing a safety barrier intended to shield motorists who leave the roadway.

The work is anticipated to begin in the summer of 2025. The work will be phased to keep the road open during construction as much as possible and will take approximately one and a half months to complete.

Additional Fiscal Information

The construction contract is estimated to cost approximately \$802,645 and will be funded with Highway Safety Improvement Program funds for which the Department successfully obtained and Gas Tax/HUTA Funds.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The County of Riverside Transportation Department proposes to remove approximately 603 linear feet and reconstruct approximately 3,972 linear feet of guardrail on Cajalco Road from La Sierra Avenue to Wood Road and on Lake Mathews Drive from Capello Drive to Malta Place. Cajalco Road is classified as an Expressway in the County of Riverside General Plan and currently consists of one travel lane in each direction with a total width of 28 to 60 feet. The proposed work will include:

- Replacing the old existing guardrail system with the new Midwest Guardrail System to meet Caltrans standards.
- Replacing the existing guardrail end flared terminals with the new In-Line end treatments
- Installing reflective markers
- Installing signs

ENVIRONMENTAL ANALYSIS:

All improvements are to be done within the existing right-of-way.

This project is subject to compliance with the Western Riverside MSHCP. In accordance with Section 7 of the Western Riverside MSHCP, necessary operation and maintenance activities along existing roadways are considered a covered activity within cell criteria areas. This project is considered to be an operation and maintenance activity and therefore is covered under the Western Riverside MSHCP. The project will comply with construction guidelines provided in Section 7.5.3, as well as Best Management Practices (BMPs) outlined in Appendix C.

If tree and/or vegetation removal takes place during the migratory bird breeding season (February 1 – September 1), a preconstruction nesting survey will be conducted pursuant to the Migratory Bird Treaty Act (MBTA).

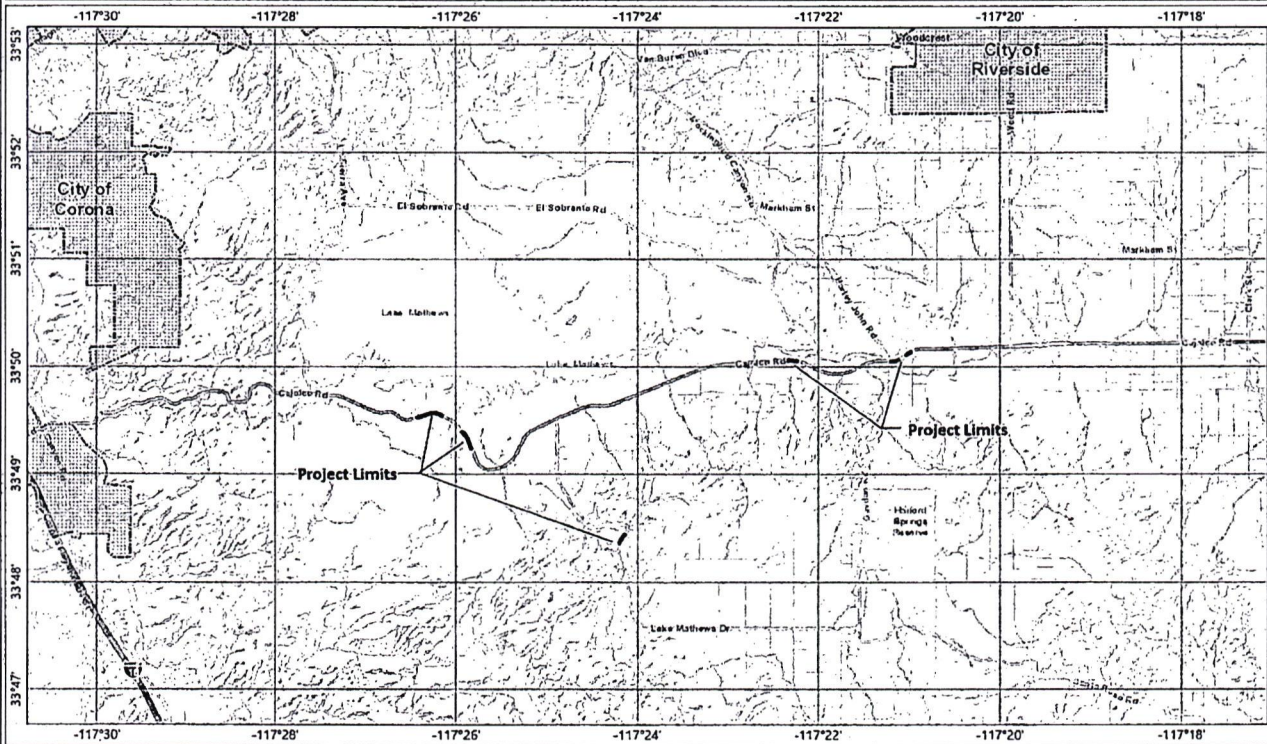

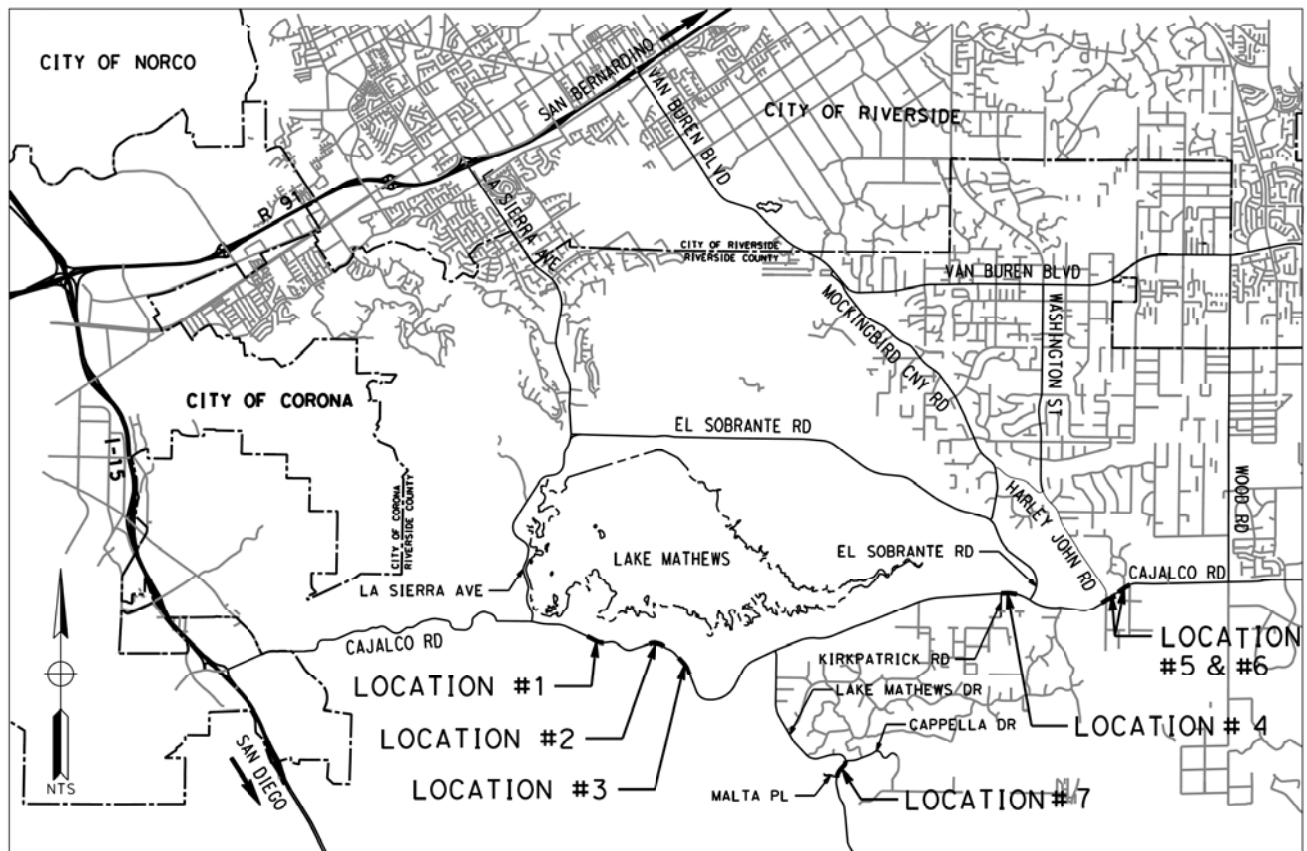
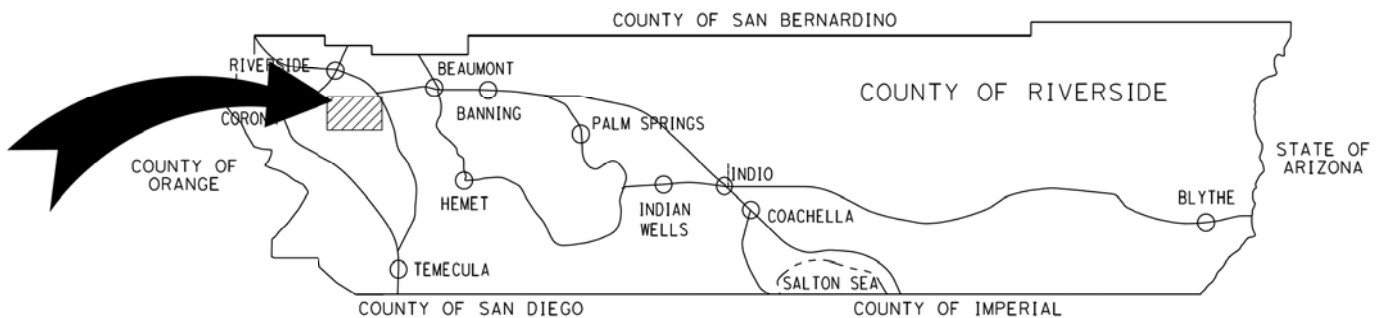
