BACKGROUND:

Summary

The Sheriff's Department recently expanded the Coroner's Incident Response Team (CIRT) to include Coroner Technicians, Forensic Technicians, and Senior Coroner Technicians. These classifications assist with death investigations in the field by collecting evidence, documenting scenes, and supporting the coroner investigators during complex or large-scale incidents. Members assigned to the CIRT receive a \$2.00 per hour premium pay when deployed on these missions.

CIRT members receive specialized training and are dispatched to complex recovery and investigative scenarios, including body recoveries in deep water, strong currents, or hazardous underwater conditions; remote recoveries requiring navigation over difficult terrain such as mountains or cliffs; helicopter-assisted death investigations in inaccessible locations; recovery of scattered human remains due to animal activity or environmental factors; retrieval efforts in canyons, ravines, or bodies of water requiring extensive coordination; and large-scale emergency responses to events such as earthquakes, wildfires, and floods that result in multiple casualties. The scenarios in which the premium pay is applicable is determined by Sheriff's Administration and the pay only applies for the time on the mission.

The County has reached tentative agreement via Side Letter with LIUNA, subject to Board's approval, to add the CIRT premium pay to the Premium Pay provision in the MOU. Full details of the Side Letter Agreement can be found in the attachment.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

While this side letter does not have an immediate impact on residents or businesses, approving the CIRT premium pay ensures that County employees are fairly compensated for performing specialized and potentially hazardous duties. It also ensures that the recovery of remains—an effort that can affect the community—is carried out by trained professionals.

Additional Fiscal Information

The Sheriff's Department can absorb the cost of the premium pay within their current budget allocation.

SIDE LETTER TO THE

2024-2027

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING ("MOU")

BETWEEN

THE COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE ("County")

AND

THE LABORERS' INTERNATIONAL UNION OF NORTH AMERICA, LOCAL 777 ("LIUNA")

The County and LIUNA agree to amend the 2024 – 2027 MOU between the County and LIUNA as follows:

Amend Article IV, <u>Pay Period. Workweek, Overtime and Premium Pay</u>, Section 6, <u>Premium Pay</u>, to include the following:

S. Coroner Incident Response Team (CIRT) Premium

Certain deaths occur within hazardous situations or environments, which require employees to utilize specialized skills or techniques in order to complete the scene investigation and recover the remains. Sheriff Department employees who are assigned to the Coroner Incident Response Team (CIRT), including Coroner Technicians, Forensics Technicians, and Senior Coroner Technicians, have received specialized training to conduct death investigations and body recoveries within hazardous situations and environments will receive an additional \$2.00 per hour for time deployed on a mission, as identified by Sheriff's Department Administration. This pay does not apply to training. The pay applies for the time on the mission as determined by the mission supervisor.

The terms of this Side Letter shall be incorporated into the successor MOU between the County and LIUNA unless otherwise negotiated.

The terms of this Side Letter shall become effective the first full pay period following signature of this Side Letter by both parties and approval by the Board of Supervisors.
