**BACKGROUND:**

**Summary**

The Political Reform Act prohibits a public official from using his or her position to influence a government decision in which he or she has a financial interest. Government Code section 87300 requires local government agencies to adopt and promulgate a Conflict of Interest Code identifying officials and employees required to file statements of economic interest based on the positions they hold. A local government agency, as defined by Government Code section 82041, includes the Riverside Transit Agency.

Each even-numbered year, Government Code section 87306.5 requires local government agencies to review their Conflict of Interest Code, make appropriate revisions, if necessary, and submit an amended Conflict of Interest Code to the code reviewing body. Government Code section 82011(b) identifies the Board of Supervisors for the County of Riverside as the code reviewing body for a local government agency within its county.

The Riverside Transit Agency amended its Conflict of Interest Code on June 27, 2024, to add positions, delete positions, and revise titles of positions that participate in making governmental decisions. The Board of Directors for Riverside Transit Agency has adopted Item 8J from its June 27, 2024 Agenda, amending its Conflict of Interest Code. The Riverside Transit Agency has submitted its amended Conflict of Interest Code for approval by the Board of Supervisors as the code reviewing body.

This office has reviewed the Conflict of Interest Code of the Riverside Transit Agency and has found that it complies with statutory requirements. A complete copy of the Conflict of Interest Code of the Riverside Transit Agency is attached.

It is recommended that the Board of Supervisors approve the Conflict of Interest Code of the Riverside Transit Agency and direct the Clerk of the Board to notify the Riverside Transit Agency of the action taken.
