**BACKGROUND:** Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

1. The donation to the RAP Foundation (\$10,000.00) will support technical assistance programs that help build high-impact non-profits by strengthening their program designs, improving internal systems and infrastructure, and enhancing their strategies for financial management and long-term sustainability.
2. The donation to Nueva Vista Continuation High School (\$2,000.00) will support the Nueva Vista Family Engagement Initiative, which features informational stations about academic programs, student demonstrations, and multilingual presentations, and a community resource fair that will showcase county services available to families.
3. The donation to Reach One, Teach One (\$1,000.00) will provide substance abuse prevention and treatment, anger management, conflict resolution, domestic violence counseling, and holistic mental health support to teens to equip them with the skills, knowledge, and resources they need to thrive and overcome challenges.
4. The donation to the Norco High School Alumni Association (\$5,000.00) will support the Norco Film Festival, which brings community and educators together to support the educational needs of students at Norco High School and provide an opportunity for students to be educated about the work in the film industry.
5. The donation to the Riverside Sheriff's Association (\$3,000.00) will support the Sheriff's Annual Awards event, which recognizes public safety officers whose

The donation to Soroptimist International of Corona (\$5,000.00) will support projects that improve the lives of women and girls, including scholarships to graduating seniors at every high school in Corona-Norco Unified School District, the Dreams and Decisions workshop for youth to build self-esteem and the Live Your Dream Scholarship which supports young women returning to school to achieve their educational goals.
