BACKGROUND:

Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

1. **Oak Grove Institute Foundation** - \$1,500- The funds will be used to support the Evening Under the Oaks event, an event that raises funds for the Arts and special needs programs at the Oak Grove Center.
2. **Latter Days Help for the Seniors**- \$4,000-The funds will be used to provide low-income seniors with pantry staples such as canned goods, produce, and non-perishable items.
3. **Thessalonika Family Services**-\$2,500- The funds will be used to support the Deuces Wild, an event that raises money for Mission Hope’s Empowerment Village campus, which provides housing for single mothers and their young children

4. **Riverside University Health System Foundation-** \$8,500- The funds will be utilized to support the purchase of a new ventilator machine for the RUHS Pediatric Intensive Care Unit.
5. **Sheriff Special Events-**\$1,500- The funds will support the Sheriff's Annual Award Ceremony, which honors law enforcement and volunteer members for their commendable service to the department and community.
6. **Murrieta Chamber of Commerce-** \$4,000- The funds will be used to support the (1) Murrieta State of the City Address and (2) the Wildomar State of the City address.
7. **Riverside County Works-**\$2,500- The funds will be used to support the Jamil Dada Character Excellence Youth Awards, an event that provides scholarships to deserving youth exhibiting remarkable leadership and character.
8. **Angel View, Inc.** \$7,500- The funds will be used to support the Angel View Outreach program, a program that supports families raising children with disabilities.
9. **Student of the Month Program, Inc.** -\$1,000- The funds will be used to support the Menifee Student of the Month program for the 2025-2026 academic year.
10. **MilVet-** \$10,000- The funds will be used to support the monthly MilVet Military Care Package Program, a program that provides deployed military personnel with a personalized care package that includes a variety of hygiene products and non-perishable snacks.
11. **Impact Riverside County-** \$1,000- The funding will be used to support the Murrieta Student of the Month program for the 2025-2026 academic year.
12. **Lake Elsinore Community Foundation-** \$1,000- The funding will be used to support the Wildomar Student of the Month program for the 2025-2026 academic year.
13. **Shuttles4Soldiers-**\$15,000- This allocation will provide non-emergency medical appointment transportation to low-income veterans with severe chronic/physical disabilities.
