**SUBJECT:** EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT DEPARTMENT: Ratify and Approve Amendment No. 1 to the Professional Services Agreement between Emergency Management Department's (EMD) Riverside County Emergency Medical Services Agency and Pediatric Emergency Standards, Inc. for Handtevy Pediatric Resuscitation Systems Suite to increase the Aggregate Cost by \$9,626. All Districts. [Total Aggregate Cost: \$302,997; additional compensation not to exceed 15% total aggregate cost – 100% American Medical Response Agreement Funds]

**RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:**

1. Ratify and Approve Amendment No. 1 to the Professional Services Agreement #EMARC-2004-06/28 with Pediatric Emergency Standards, Inc.; and
2. Authorize the Chair of the Board of Supervisors to sign the Amendment; and
3. Authorize the Purchasing Agent, in accordance with Ordinance No. 459, based on the availability of funding and as approved as to form by County Counsel, to a) sign amendments that make modifications to the scope of services that stay within the intent of the Agreement; and b) sign amendments to the compensation provisions that do not exceed the sum total of fifteen percent (15%) of the total aggregate cost of the Agreement; and
4. Authorize the Purchasing Agent to issue Purchase Orders to Pediatric Emergency Standards, Inc. for required services that do not exceed the Board of Supervisors approved total amount.



**BACKGROUND:**

**Summary**

The Board of Supervisors approved a Professional Services Agreement with Pediatric Emergency Standards, Inc. for the provision of Handtevy Pediatric Resuscitation Systems Suite and support services for Advanced Life Support (ALS) providers operating within the County of Riverside EMS System. Amendment No. 1, presented to the Board, includes the addition of the City of Calimesa ALS, in the amount of \$9,626.

The Riverside County Emergency Medical Services Agency (REMSA) and Pediatric Emergency Standards, Inc. entered into this Agreement on June 4, 2024 (Agenda Item #3.17) for the use of Handtevy Pediatric Resuscitation Systems Suite. The Handtevy System is the leading integrated mobile software solution designed to provide paramedics rapid access to lifesaving dosing information while documenting every action in real time.

With the largest advanced life support provider in Riverside County currently utilizing Handtevy, its adoption and distribution county-wide will support REMSA's goal of delivering patient care through a systems-based approach. The software is fully customizable and will align with all REMSA-treatment protocols as established by the REMSA Medical Director. Additionally, Handtevy is able to integrate with REMSA's electronic Patient Care Reporting (ePCR) system, allowing for documentation created within the Handtevy mobile application to be uploaded directly into the patient's care record via Bluetooth at the scene of the incident.

**Impact on Residents and Businesses**

The Handtevy Pediatric Resuscitation System Suite provides paramedics with the opportunity to cognitively offload the task of performing weight-based medication calculations while treating sick and injured children. This enables paramedics to focus on patient care rather than medication math, effectively reducing medication errors and significantly minimizing the risk of patient harm.

**Additional Fiscal Information**

As compared to other proprietary software programs and annual support/maintenance fees charged, the cost is significantly less expensive.

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**Contract History and Price Reasonableness**

The County of Riverside originally entered into Agreement No. EMARC-2004-0628 with Pediatric Emergency Standards, Inc. (Handtevy) in June 2024, at an initial cost of \$293,370. With the inclusion of this Amendment No. 1 and a 15% aggregate additional compensation amount, the total potential contract value will now be \$348,446.55. Amendment No. 1 expands the scope of services to enhance the County's pediatric emergency care capabilities. Specifically, it adds Handtevy's proprietary Medication Management Software, which includes a one-time setup and customization fee and an initial year cost of \$2,691.88. Annual renewal costs for years two through five range from \$1,608.81 to \$1,862.40. The pricing reflects a discounted rate of approximately thirty percent (30%) off list pricing. To support price reasonableness, the department has submitted a Sole Source Justification letter confirming that Handtevy is the exclusive provider of this proprietary pediatric resuscitation system.

This Amendment No. 1 to the Professional Service Agreement is entered into by and between County of Riverside (“COUNTY”) and Pediatric Emergency Standards, Inc., a Florida Cooperation (“CONTRACTOR”), effective August 1, 2024.

WHEREAS, COUNTY and CONTRACTOR entered into that Professional Service Agreement for Handtevy Pediatric Resuscitation System Suite, dated June 4, 2024, through June 30, 2028 (the “Original Agreement”);

WHEREAS COUNTY and CONTRACTOR now desire to amend the Original Agreement to adjust the maximum annual contract amount, and replace Exhibit B with Exhibit B-1

NOW, THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration, the receipt and adequacy of which is hereby acknowledged, COUNTY and CONTRACTOR agree as follows:

1. The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by reference.
2. The second sentence of Section 3.1 of the Original Agreement (“Compensation”) is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following: “Maximum payments by COUNTY to CONTRACTOR shall not exceed three hundred two thousand nine hundred ninety-seven dollars (\$302,997) for the term of the agreement including all expenses.”
3. Exhibit B (Payment Provisions) is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the attached Exhibit B-1.
4. All other terms and conditions of the Original Agreement not modified herein shall remain unchanged.




