BACKGROUND:

Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

1. **City of Murrieta** - \$1,921- The funds will support the Southwest Riverside Elected Leaders Collaborative in producing a video that highlights critical transportation and infrastructure challenges. The video will be used to advocate for much-needed state and federal support and investment.
2. **Riverside County Office on Aging**- \$35,997- The funds will be utilized to support the Riverside County Office on Aging Material Aid Program, which serves senior residents in D3 with home repair, prescription costs, utility bills, etc.
3. **Murrieta Chamber of Commerce**- \$3,500- The funds will be used to support two events: (1) the Mega Mixer, an event that promotes local businesses, and (2) the 65th Annual Awards, which honor small business owners and civic leaders in the Murrieta/Wildomar area.
4. **Favors for Neighbors**-\$5,000- The funding will be used to provide seniors with minor home repairs, transportation to medical visits, and meal deliveries.
5. **Boys & Girls Club of Southwest County**- \$7,000- The funding will support the Summer Day Camp for children ages 6 to 17 years old in the Southwest area.
