[Total Amended Aggregate Amount: \$2,500,000; up to 20% of the aggregate amount for additional compensation, 100% Department Budgets.]

**RECOMMENDED MOTION:** That the Board of Supervisors:

1. Ratify and Approve Amendment No. 3 to the Professional Services Agreement with Clean Harbors Environmental Services, Inc. for Hazardous Waste Removal Services to extend the period of performance from July 31, 2026 to September 30, 2026, increase the maximum compensation from \$100,000 annually to \$1,500,000 in aggregate, increase the rates by 2.88% (CPI increase), and add additional supplies and services; authorize the Chair of the Board to sign the Amendment on behalf of the County;
2. Ratify and Approve Amendment No. 1 to the Professional Services Agreements with Industrial Waste Utilization, Inc. for Hazardous Waste Removal Services to extend the period of performance from July 31, 2026 to September 30, 2026, and increase the maximum compensation from \$100,000 annually to \$500,000 in aggregate; authorize the Chair of the Board to sign the Amendment on behalf of the County;

3. Ratify and Approve Amendment No. 1 to the Professional Services Agreement with NRC Environmental Services, Inc. for Hazardous Waste Removal Services to extend the period of performance from July 31, 2026 to September 30, 2026, and increase the maximum compensation from \$100,000 annually to \$500,000 in aggregate; authorize the Chair of the Board to sign the Amendment on behalf of the County;
  
4. Authorize the Purchasing Agent, in accordance with Ordinance No. 459, based on the availability of fiscal funding and as approved as to form by County Counsel, to (a) sign amendments that make modifications to the scope of services that stay within the intent of the Agreements, and (b) sign amendments to the compensation provisions that do not exceed the sum total of up to 20% of the total aggregate approved amount, and (c) move the allocated funds among the vendors; and,

**BACKGROUND:**

**Summary**

Purchasing & Fleet Services (Purchasing) has facilitated and administered agreements for Hazardous Waste Collection Services for countywide use with Clean Harbors Environmental Services, Inc. (CEHS), Industrial Waste Utilization, Inc (IWU), and NRC Environmental Services, Inc. (NRC) (collectively referred to as "Vendors") since October 2021. These Vendors have provided and maintained Hazardous Waste Collection services to the following departments and districts throughout the term: Department of Environmental Health, Behavioral Health, Flood Control and Water Conservation District, Facilities Management, Fire Department, Riverside University Health Systems, Regional Park and Open-Space District, Probation, Purchasing and Fleet Services, Public Health, Sheriff's Department, Transportation and Land Management Agency and Department of Waste Resources.

**SUBMITTAL TO THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE,  
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The intent of these amendments is to update the aggregate compensation amounts for these countywide agreements to more accurately reflect the spending by the 13 individual departments and special districts utilizing the services, ensure sufficient funding is available, and extend the periods of performance to align with full five-year terms from the original agreement execution date. Ratification of the agreements is requested to apply the aggregate amount to the full contract term for each vendor, thereby authorizing payment of invoices from each year that exceeds the Purchasing Agent's authority. Extension of the term is requested for each agreement to align with the full 5-year term referenced in the bid for services.

**Impact on Residents and Businesses**

There is no anticipated impact on the citizens or businesses throughout the County. The agreements comply with all state and federal regulations and laws including but not limited to; the California Department of Toxic Substance Control (DTSC), Vehicle Code, Code Regulations (CCR), Health and Safety Code and Medical Waste Management, and United States Department of Transportation (DOT), Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) and Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA).

**Additional Fiscal Information**

As the administrators of countywide agreements, Purchasing conducted routine contract management and noted discrepancies with the compensation amounts and department spending. Further analysis was done to determine the cause of the uptick in contract usage and to engage with departments utilizing services to better assess their usage and anticipated budgets moving forward. Spend rose due to a variety of factors including unique circumstances following the pandemic, an increased volume of items being banned from landfills, more community clean-up events hosted by the County, greater geographical service areas being absorbed by departments, and increased homeless encampment clean-up and abatement.

Based on expenditures to date and forecasted needs, the agreements require updating with a new aggregate amount that takes into consideration previous and forecasted expenditures with the option to reallocate as necessary. This will provide departments with better flexibility for contracting services with the Vendors and assessing pricing, service availability and response times of each vendor.

Historically, and over the past three contract terms, annual expenditures for these services have increased year over year. The highest utilizing departments are those that manage consistently large volumes and that are subject to progressively more stringent disposal regulations: Riverside University Health System (RUHS), the Transportation and Land Management Agency (TLMA), Facilities Management (FM) and the Department of Waste Resources

The following tables display spend per vendor agreement for each year. Years 1-3 for each vendor are actuals, while years 4-5 for each are projected within the updated aggregate amounts.

**Contract History and Price Reasonableness**

On July 19, 2021, Purchasing released Request for Proposal (RFP) PUARC-1680 for Hazardous Waste Removal Services. The RFP was advertised publicly with notifications sent to over one hundred (100) potential vendors, with a total of five (5) vendors submitting proposals. The proposals were reviewed and evaluated by an evaluation team consisting of personnel from Riverside University Health Systems (RUHS), Department of Waste Resources (RCDWR), Transportation and Land Management Agency (TLMA) and Purchasing on the criteria set forth in the RFP.

After thorough reviews, the evaluation committee determined to award to the three lowest responsive/responsible vendors: Clean Harbors Environmental Services, Inc., Industrial Waste Utilization, Inc., and NRC Environmental Inc.

With no sole provider offering the most economical rate for every service, the continued use of all vendors allows the Departments to compare rates and utilize the vendor with the most reasonable applicable rates, which meets each individual department's required service needs.

Since its initial execution, the agreement with Clean Harbors has been amended twice to account for requested price increases as per CPI. This is the first amendment for agreements with Industrial Waste Utilization and NRC Environmental Services, Inc.

(herein referred to as "Amendment No. 1") is made and entered into by and between INDUSTRIAL WASTE UTILIZATION, INC., a California corporation, (herein referred to as "CONTRACTOR") and the COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE, a political subdivision of the State of California, (herein referred to as "COUNTY").

RECITALS

WHEREAS, COUNTY and CONTRACTOR entered into that certain Professional Services Agreement for Hazardous Waste Removal Services, approved October 26, 2021, Agenda Item 3.17, (herein referred to as "Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, COUNTY and CONTRACTOR now desire to amend the Agreement to extend the period of performance and increase the maximum contract amount;

NOW THEREFORE, the parties agree as follows:

1. **Recitals.** The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by reference.
2. **Period of Performance.** The first sentence of Subsection 2.1 of Section 2. Period of Performance of the Agreement is hereby amended to extend the period of performance for two (2) additional months commencing on August 1, 2026 and continuing in effect through September 30, 2026, as follows:

"This Agreement shall be effective upon signature of this Agreement by both parties and continues in effect through September 30, 2026, unless terminated earlier."







Compensation of the Agreement;

WHEREAS, COUNTY and CONTRACTOR now desire to amend the Agreement to extend the period of performance, increase the maximum contract amount, increase the rates effective July 1, 2024 by 2.88%, which does not exceed the percentage change in the Consumer Price Index – All Urban Consumers, All Items – Greater Riverside, San Bernardino, Ontario CA areas ("CPI") over the preceding twelve (12) month period, in accordance with Subsection 3.2 of Section 3. Compensation of the Agreement, and add additional supplies and services;

NOW THEREFORE, the parties agree as follows:

1. **Recitals.** The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by reference.
2. **Period of Performance.** The first sentence of Subsection 2.1 of Section 2. Period of Performance of the Agreement is hereby amended to extend the period of

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performance for two (2) additional months commencing on August 1, 2026 and continuing in effect through September 30, 2026, as follows:

“This Agreement shall be effective upon signature of this Agreement by both parties and continues in effect through September 30, 2026, unless terminated earlier.”

3. **Compensation.** The second sentence of Subsection 3.1 of Section 3. Compensation of the Agreement is hereby amended to increase the maximum contract amount from \$100,000 annually to a total aggregate amount of \$1,500,000, as follows:

“Maximum payments by COUNTY to CONTRACTOR shall not exceed a total aggregate amount of one million five hundred thousand dollars (\$1,500,000) including all expenses throughout the period of performance.”


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



If requested, the CONTRACTOR shall define and list provisions affecting the cost for transportation and disposal of the wastes listed. Provisions may include information such as costs on a per length basis with any container requirements, maximum weights per container size, container requirements if the pricing is listed as a cost per pound, or weight to drum size conversion factors. Such provisions may be required to explain situations such as the disposal of mercury containing items, bulk wastes, or fluorescent light tubes.

**General Pricing Conditions  
Assumptions and Considerations**

Please find below the general pricing conditions for this contract. These conditions govern all waste streams and generic pricing covered under this contract. These conditions are in addition to specific pricing notes provided on the pricing matrixes.

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1. All approved (“Approved”) waste streams are coded with Clean Harbors’ Waste Classification Codes (WCCs), which define the specifications for drummed, containerized and bulked wastes. Wastes that are received not conforming to these specifications may be subject to additional costs. A completed waste profile sheet, as well as a sample, representative analysis and/or Safety Data Sheet (SDS) must be submitted prior to approval and scheduling.
2. Lab Pack rates do not include explosive or potentially explosive, radioactive, temperature sensitive or infectious materials. Clean Harbors reserves the right to decline to accept for disposal any waste materials which, in its reasonable judgment, it cannot dispose of in a lawful manner or without a risk of harm to public health or the environment, or for which no legal means of disposal exists. Clean Harbors will provide separate quotations for any potential high-hazard work (i.e. peroxidized ethers, explosives, cylinders, etc.) upon request.
3. Some bulk waste streams require a sample prior to acceptance and approval. Final pricing for bulk waste streams will be determined from actual samples and/or trial loads. Specifications for bulk waste streams will be individually defined, but will generally follow the same specifications as the containerized (i.e., drummed, lab packed, etc.) wastes.
4. All pricing presented in this contract is based on Clean Harbors’ ability to utilize our approved network of audited TSDFs. If the number of sites approved by (CLIENT) is reduced or restricted, additional costs may be applied due to increased handling of wastes and reduced economies of scale.
5. Except where specifically quoted otherwise in the pricing matrix, the following conditions will govern the way Clean Harbors invoices waste disposal for odd size shipping containers. Drum sizes or container types not covered herein will be quoted case-by-case.

5.1. Disposal Pricing Conversions – Pricing for container sizes other than 55-gallon will be extrapolated as follows:

6. Weight Surcharges – Some waste streams may be subject to additional surcharges if containers of the materials exceed a specific weight. Potential weight surcharges for materials in the pricing matrix are listed below by Waste Classification Code and would be charged in addition to the base disposal price.

- CCRK: \$1.00 for each pound more than 500 in a single drum  
\$1.00 for each pound more than 1,500 in a single flexbin
- CCRX: \$1.47 for each pound more than 500 in a single drum
- D20R: \$3.00 for each pound more than 300 in a single drum
- FB5: \$0.79 for each pound more than 200 in a single drum  
\$0.79 for each pound more than 800 in a single flexbin

7. Cancellation of a pickup with less than 24 hours notice will incur a \$350.00 cancellation fee.

8. Unless otherwise quoted, the following labor hours are considered Overtime . All hours worked in excess of eight (8) on a normal workday (Monday - Friday. All hours worked all day on a weekends and holidays..

9. Transportation Demurrage Schedules

9.1. **Drummed Waste** – The amount of time required by Clean Harbors' driver to load drums at a single stop is built into our transportation rates. As the number of drums to be loaded increases, the amount of loading time allocated increases.

The table below outlines Clean Harbors' sliding scale of "free" loading time versus the number of drums being loaded. Onsite time more than the free allocated loading hours below will be charged demurrage.

The demurrage rate for Vans, Box Trucks and Flat-Bed Trailers is \$107.00/hour.

9.2. **Bulk Waste** – Demurrage rates for bulk waste transportation are outlined below:

9.2.1. For conforming waste, demurrage only to be charged after one (1) hour on the generator's site.

9.2.2. Unloading demurrage will not be charged for wastes being delivered to Clean Harbors' plants, unless a very significant generator-caused problem develops, such as improperly identified or non-conforming waste or a chemical release because of a failed container. An exception to this allowance is for direct burn and/or direct feed materials being incinerated. Demurrage will be invoiced based on the hours it takes to burn the material unless the trailer can be dropped at the incinerator and picked up when empty.

9.2.3. Demurrage will be charged for time when shipments unloaded at non-Clean Harbors facilities is more than one (1) hour. Clean Harbors will do its best to properly coordinate such loads, however we cannot control the process times at non-Clean Harbors' facilities.

10. Clean Harbors requires free and easy access to each pickup site. Drums/containers must be in DOT shippable condition.

11. Prices for PCB items are only effective if the items are received within 9 months of the out of service date (OSD). Out of Service Date (OSD) for PCB incinerables should be clearly identified in Section J of the manifest. Prices for OSD's exceeding 9 months will be billed as follows:

11.1. Received over 9 months – 1.25 x base price

11.2. Received over 10 months – 1.50 x base price

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11.3. Received over 11 months – 2.00 x base price

12. Compressed Gas Cylinder Conditions

- 12.1. Certain high hazard and extremely reactive cylinders will be handled case-by-case including chlorine dioxide, xenon difluoride, pentaborane, tetrafluorohydrazine, hydrogen cyanide anhydrous, fluorine >5%, sodium potassium alloy, potassium, sulfur trioxide, bromine pentafluoride, bromine trifluoride, chlorine pentafluoride, chlorine trifluoride, trifluoromethyl peroxide, trifluoromethylhypofluorite, xenon dioxide, xenon hexafluoride, xenon tetrafluoride, bis (trifluoromethyl) peroxide, hydrazine, methyl hydrazine, oxygen difluoride.
- 12.2. Zone A cylinder transportation (as required) will be quoted case-by-case and will be billed in addition to disposal.
- 12.3. Cylinders required to be returned to the generator after processing must be properly labeled to indicate “Return to Generator” and have operable valves. Return transportation will be quoted case-by-case.
- 12.4. Cylinders without original stenciling, labels and/or tags will be subject to an additional analysis charge.
- 12.5. Cylinders with inoperable valves may be subject to rejection or may be charged an additional handling fee of \$400.
- 12.6. Cylinders with a stuck/ rusted valve cap will be subject to a \$55.00 stuck cap charge.
- 12.7. Cylinders must in DOT-shippable condition.
- 12.8. Cylinders with greater than 5% solids maybe subject to surcharge or rejection.
- 12.9. All ½ ton, 1 ton and larger cylinders will be quoted by case-by-case. These cylinders are subject to a connect and disconnect fee of \$ 1,624.00 each. If scrapping or disposal of the cylinder carcass is required, additional charges will be quoted individually.
- 12.10. All cylinders require an approved cylinder evaluation sheet and leak test for final acceptance
- 12.11. Phosgene leak test will be quoted case-by-case.
- 12.12. Cylinder pricing offered in this proposal is contingent upon approval of the Clean Harbors, LaPorte, TX transfer, storage and disposal facility.

13. A tank wash or rolloff wash fee of \$350.00 will apply any time a wash of a tanker or rolloff is required for non-PCB items. Additional fees will apply for any tank (confined space) entries or PCB washouts.
14. Solidification of free liquids in a bulk solid container will be subject to a Bin Top Stabilization Fee of \$300.00 per container.
15. Overpacked drums with the drum inverted will be subject to a \$25.00 inverted drum fee. If waste must be overpacked upon receipt at a Clean Harbors’ plant, an overpack fee of \$250.00 will be invoiced.
16. Fees & Taxes
  - 16.1. On June 30, 2018, the US EPA activated the E-Manifest system. The EPA will charge the receiving treatment, storage and disposal facility (TSDF) a fee per manifest. To cover the cost of the E-Manifest, Clean Harbors will charge \$20 per manifest on every invoice effective October 1, 2019.
  - 16.2. California Generators – CA RRAA Fee: The additional excise and sales tax added to the price of diesel fuel at the pump under the California Road Repair and

Accountability Act (CA RRAA) of 2017 has increased the cost of providing waste management services in the State of California. To offset this extra cost, Clean Harbors is implementing a 2.0% CA RRAA Fee on every invoice for a California generator.

16.3. Supplies qualified as Tangible Personal Property are subject to sales taxes.

16.4. Variable Energy and Security Recovery Fee

Clean Harbors is currently applying a Recovery Fee that is comprised of two components; a 2.5% charge covering insurance, liability, tolls and security costs plus a charge for Energy costs that is revised monthly based on the average diesel prices from the US Department of Energy. With current diesel prices, the total recovery fee is **22.5%**. The Recovery Fee is applied to the entire invoice and will be broken out separately.

The charge for energy costs will be set on the first Wednesday of the month based on data from the US Department of Energy (<https://www.eia.gov/petroleum/gasdiesel/>). The energy fee will be determined from the following table:
