BACKGROUND:

Summary

On September 23, 2022, Governor Gavin Newsom signed Assembly Bill 2022 (Ramos) into law. This state-mandated legislation requires the removal of the term “squaw” (hereafter referenced as “sq_”) from all geographic features and place names in the State of California, recognizing the term as a racist and derogatory slur, particularly toward Indigenous women.

In response to this mandate, the County of Riverside is addressing an existing paved road easement in the Glen Ivy Hot Springs area. Although signs currently display the name “Sq___ Mountain Rd.” at both ends of the easement, the road has never been officially named. These signs are erroneous, and this resolution seeks to formally name the un-named road easement in compliance with state law.

In consultation with the County of Riverside, the California Advisory Committee on Geographic Names (CACGN) has designated “Hul’Vul Road” as the new name. This action will:

- Officially assign a name to the road easement;
- Facilitate the replacement of incorrect signage with signs displaying the correct, adopted name;
- Initiate coordination with the United States Postal Service (USPS) to update addresses as necessary; and
- Notify the California Highway Patrol (CHP) and other relevant agencies of the name change.

As determined in the attached Notice of Exemption, the name change is exempt from the provisions of CEQA pursuant to exemption Section 15061(b)(3) and not a project pursuant to Section 15060(c) of the State CEQA Guidelines. The name change will not result in any specific or general exceptions to the use of the exemption and will not cause any direct or indirect physical environmental impacts.

Resolution No. 2025-020 has been reviewed and approved as to form by County Counsel.

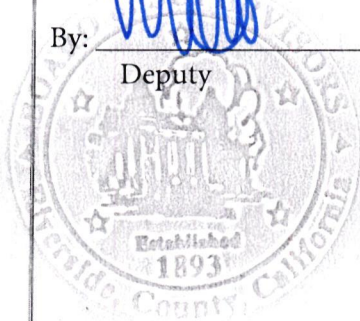


