BACKGROUND: Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

1. **Riverside County Works’** mission is to help today’s youth prepare for tomorrow’s success. The **\$2,500** is a sponsorship for the 2025 Jamil Dada Character Excellence Youth Awards, scheduled for July 11, 2025, at March Field Air Museum in Riverside. Students from all five supervisory districts receive recognition for their academic achievements as well as exemplary character traits while overcoming some of life’s most difficult and tragic situations.
2. **Vivian Stancil Olympian Foundation, Inc.**, promotes healthy lifestyles that enhance the quality of life for children, youth, and adults through providing water safety swim methods, community speakers on behalf of nutrition and resources that will proactively impact the lives of all participants. The **\$2,000** funds will assist with the Splish Splash Water Safety Swim Program.
3. **NAACP Empowerment Program, Inc. dba Riverside County NAACP Youth Council 17-AJ**, mission is to inform youth of the problems affecting African Americans and other racial and ethnic minorities; to advance the economic, education, social and political status of racial and ethnical minorities. The **\$2,000** is to support the Riverside County NAACP Youth Council’s participation in the National NAACP Convention, which will take place in Charlotte, North Carolina, from July 12 – 16, 2025. The convention provides critical leadership development, networking, and advocacy training for youth nationwide.
4. **Unidos For La Causa, Inc.**, supports the community in the social, cultural issues affecting and impacting the Chicano Latino community. This **\$1,500** is to support the arts in the preservation and promotion of history and culture, focusing on our local communities throughout Riverside.
