Code Section 53166 and Approval of the Purchase of Cellular Interception Technology from Tactical Support Equipment, Inc. and West Coast Lights & Sirens, Inc., Without Seeking Competitive Bids. All Districts; \$1,047,734 [Total Cost - \$955,213 up to \$92,521 in Contingencies 100% Departmental Funds] (4/5 Vote Required)

**RECOMMENDED MOTION:** That the Board of Supervisors:

1. Adopt Resolution No. 2025-124 authorizing the District Attorney to acquire cellular interception technology and usage and privacy policy in accordance with Govt. Code Section 53166 on behalf of the County;
2. Approve the purchase of Cellular Communications interception technology and authorize the Purchasing Agent to issue a Purchase Order to Tactical Support Equipment, Inc., a North Carolina company, for a total amount of \$777,800; and
3. Approve the purchase and installation of enhancements of cellular interception technology and authorize the Purchasing Agent to issue a Purchase Order to West Coast Lights & Sirens, Inc., a California corporation, for a total amount of \$77,413; and
4. Request the purchase and authorize the Purchasing Agent to issue a Purchase Order for one (1) heavy duty specialized truck in the amount of up to \$100,000 after completing the competitive bid process; and



**BACKGROUND:**

**Summary**

The Bureau of Investigation (the Bureau) supports the prosecutorial and law enforcement endeavors of the Riverside County District Attorney’s Office. The Bureau provides a wide range of policing services, tasked with suppressing crime and ensuring all criminal cases filed in Riverside County are thoroughly investigated. The Bureau’s influence reaches Riverside County’s 7,300 square miles and provides dedicated service to the 2.4 million people who call Riverside County home. As the 4th largest law enforcement agency in Riverside County, Bureau staff include some of the most talented and experienced peace officers in California, comprised of more than 130 sworn investigators and 70 non-sworn support team members. With more than 3,000 years of combined law enforcement experience, these highly trained and skilled professionals are some of the most accomplished men and women in modern-day policing.

Through the several specialized disciplines throughout the Bureau, staff provide an incredible amount of investigative support to allied law enforcement partners and their communities. Some of the specialty investigative services are performed by personnel assigned to the homicide unit, sexual assault/child abuse unit, the Riverside County Child Exploitation Team (RCCET), Fugitive Apprehension Unit (FAU) and the Gang Impact Team (GIT). The members of these units are highly trained investigators who conduct complex investigations into incidents involving homicides, child exploitation, human trafficking, kidnapping, child abuse, and rape.

The Bureau is currently seeking Cell Site Simulation (CSS) technology to improve the investigative outcomes related to the crimes investigated not only by the Bureau but also law enforcement partners. Improved outcomes will aid in the quick apprehension of suspects involved in violent criminal behavior. The Bureau has conducted significant research with subject matter experts from across the United States, employed by both governmental agencies (local, regional, state, and federal levels) and private businesses. Their combined insight served in determining this optimal technological solution.

Deployment of the CSS equipment would commonly occur in critical incidents such as: lost and/or missing persons (Critical Missing / Amber / Ebony / Silver / Feather Alerts), homicides, attempted homicides, kidnappings, child exploitation, major drug trafficking, and credible school threats, The CCS would also be available to assist with credible threats to large scale events throughout Riverside County such as the Coachella/Stagecoach Concert series and the Festival of Lights. It is estimated 300,000 - 500,000 people collectively attend each of these events.

Currently, the Bureau has been relying on other law enforcement agencies for utilizing their CSS equipment. Although the assistance has been appreciated and effective, there have been delays associated with borrowing the technology; the consequences of which led to delays in locating the subjects.

From March of 2023 to May of 2023, Riverside County DA's Gang Impact Team (GIT) conducted a test and evaluation of the Octasic Nyxcell Cell Site Simulator. During this time GIT used the cell site simulator on approximately 75 missions, which included suspects of murder, fentanyl overdose, sexual assaults, robbery, home invasion, human trafficking, major narcotics, gang violence, and wanted fugitives. In about 30 of the 75 deployments, the CSS allowed GIT to locate the suspect miles outside of the cell phone ping radius provided by the phone carrier. Approximately 10 of those cases were murder investigations which would have resulted in countless hours of unnecessary surveillance at the wrong location.

CSS technology will enable authorized investigators to locate cellular devices in two scenarios:

- a) During exigent circumstances or emergencies, with a judicial search warrant submitted to a magistrate within 72 hours; or
- b) Following the issuance of a search warrant signed by a magistrate, in accordance with state and federal law.

In both scenarios, the search warrant must specifically request the use of CSS technology. Authorized investigators can use the CSS technology to help locate cellular devices whose unique identifiers are already known to law enforcement, or to determine the unique

identifiers of a cellular device. CSS equipment uses cellular technology to provide the precise geo-location of a cellular device. The system does not allow investigators to access, read, and/or listen to any communication, data, text messages, emails, etc. from the target's cellular communication device. There are no violations of privacy laws or infringement of personal privacy when CSS technology is utilized pursuant to magistrate approval based upon probable cause. CSS technology shall not be utilized unless the proper legal process has been followed.

The Riverside County District Attorney's Office recommends that the Board of Supervisors approve the purchase of the Cellular Interception Technology from Tactical Support Equipment, a Chevrolet Silverado 2500 truck to transport the equipment, and the upfitting of the equipment from West Coast Lights & Sirens.

In compliance with Government Code 53166(c)(1) and (2), Resolution No. 2025-124 has been drafted for approval from this Board. Resolution No. 2025-124 seeks the Board's authorization to implement a usage and privacy policy (Riverside County DA Policy Manual; Policy 606) to ensure that the collection, use, maintenance, sharing, and dissemination of information gathered using cellular communications interception technology complies with all applicable law and is consistent with respect for an individual's privacy and civil liberties. This usage and privacy policy shall be available in writing to the public, and the usage and privacy policy shall be posted conspicuously on the District Attorney's Internet Web site.

**Impact on Residents and Businesses**

This equipment will greatly enhance public safety by improving suspect location and apprehension.

**Contract History and Price Reasonableness**

The Octasic Nyxcell Cell Site Simulator is manufactured in Canada and sold through Tactical Support Equipment (TSE) in North Carolina. They are the sole source supplier for this equipment in the United States of America. In addition, TSE is providing a 27% discount, resulting in cost avoidance of \$299,116. The approval of Sole Source No. 26-005 will support the purchase of this equipment.

The Octasic Nyxcell is the same equipment used by Riverside County Sheriff, San Bernardino Sheriff Department, Anaheim Police Department, and several others. These agencies have operated the equipment with an SUV and pickup truck. The recommendation is to use a specialized pickup truck only for ease of maintenance and reduced cost. The District Attorney's Office will work with Purchasing and Fleet Services to structure a Request for Quote for a heavy-duty specialized truck to support the equipment purchase, and a vendor will be selected via a competitive solicitation process.

Once the specialized truck has been purchased, West Coast Lights & Sirens will perform necessary upfitting to the vehicle and install the equipment for operational readiness. This

vendor is the only TSE recommended installer of this highly specialized equipment. The approval of Sole Source No. 26-004 will support this function.

8 WHEREAS, cellular communications interception technology exists and provides  
9 valuable assistance in support of public safety objectives when deployed as part of  
10 response to emergency situations such as locating at-risk persons or missing children, or  
11 part of a criminal investigation/apprehension effort;

12 WHEREAS, California Government Code Section 53166(c)(1) & (2), requires that  
13 "cellular communications interception technology shall not be acquired by a local agency  
14 unless approved by its legislative body by adoption, at a regularly public meeting held  
15 pursuant to the Ralph M. Brown Act [...], of a resolution or ordinance authorizing that  
16 acquisition and the usage and privacy policy required by this section";

17 WHEREAS, the use of this technology appears on, or is in conformance with, the  
18 County's goals & objectives to provide for the safety, health and social service needs of  
19 County residents;

20 WHEREAS, the Riverside County District Attorney's Office seeks the authorization to  
21 implement a usage and privacy policy (attached hereto as Riverside County DA Policy  
22 Manual; Policy 606) to ensure that the collection, use, maintenance, sharing, and  
23 dissemination of information gathered through the use of cellular communications  
24 interception technology complies with all applicable law and is consistent with respect for  
25 an individual's privacy and civil liberties;

26 WHEREAS, this usage and privacy policy shall be available in writing to the public, as  
27 well as on the District Attorney's website; and

28 WHEREAS, the use of this technology is employed by the Riverside County District  
Attorney's Office after a court order or search warrant signed by a magistrate is obtained, or  
in an exigent circumstance, and in a manner consistent with the requirements and  
protections of applicable statutes, regulations, and policies.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, DETERMINED, AND ORDERED by the Board of  
Supervisors of the County of Riverside, State of California, in regular session assembled on



## Radio Frequency Measurement Equipment

### 606.1 PURPOSE AND SCOPE

The purpose of this policy is to provide guidelines for the use of Radio Frequency Measurement Equipment (RF Equipment) such as Cellular Site Simulators (CSS).

### 606.2 AUTHORIZED USES

RF Equipment may be used to gather information leading to the identity or whereabouts of persons in the following circumstances:

- (a) Apprehension of fugitives
- (b) Locating at-risk individuals or victims
- (c) Locating missing persons
- (d) Locating victims of mass casualty incidents
- (e) Assist in felony investigations

### 606.3 AUTHORIZED USERS AND TRAINING REQUIREMENTS

RF Equipment operators require training to ensure they are operating the equipment correctly and within legal guidelines. Bureau personnel must be trained in the use of the equipment by a qualified Bureau trainer or, when available, from the product manufacturer. The training must include instruction on the function and proper use of the equipment along with the applicable laws and concerns related to civil liberties.

### 606.4 GENERAL DEPLOYMENT

Cellular site simulator (CSS) technology must be used in a manner that is consistent with the requirements and protections of the U.S. and California Constitutions, including the Fourth Amendment and applicable statutory authorities. Moreover, any information resulting from the use of cellular site simulators must be handled in a way that is consistent with the array of applicable statutes, regulations, and policies that guide law-enforcement and how it may and may not collect, retain, and disclose data.

606.4.1 Except as provided in the Exigent Circumstances Deployment section of this policy, the party desiring to use RF Equipment shall obtain a search warrant prior to its use.

The search warrant shall include:

- (a) An advisement that the RF Equipment sends signals to all cellular devices within range which will cause the devices to emit unique identifiers.
- (b) An advisement when the intent is to determine unique identifiers at multiple locations and/or multiple times.

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- (c) An advisement that all data collected during use of the RF Equipment will be deleted at the conclusion of the use.

606.4.2 As a means of protecting investigative integrity and operational capabilities of the RF Equipment, the author may:

- (a) Request that the court order the search warrant, in whole or in part, including any attachments or exhibits be sealed unless otherwise ordered by the court.
- (b) Address privileged information as it relates to California Evidence Code 1040.

606.4.3 Consistent with applicable existing laws and requirements, including any duty to preserve exculpatory evidence, the Department's use of the RF equipment shall include the following privacy practices:

- (a) When the equipment is used to locate a known cellular device, all data must be deleted as soon as that device is physically located and no less than once daily.
- (b) Prior to deploying the equipment for any mission, the CSS operator must verify that the equipment has been cleared of any previous operational data.
- (c) When a suspect is known to have been in two geographical different areas, any data collected in an effort to identify the cellular device shall be deleted upon completion of the mission, unless that data collected is deemed to have evidentiary value.

### **606.5 EXIGENT CIRCUMSTANCES DEPLOYMENT**

As an exception to the general requirement that use of RF Equipment shall occur only in circumstances where a search warrant has been obtained, use without a search warrant may occur in exigent circumstances.

606.5.1 Examples of exigent circumstances may include, but are not limited to the following:

- (a) Missing persons
- (b) Disaster response
- (c) Any circumstance where death or great bodily injury may occur.

606.5.2 In exigent circumstances, the Unit Supervising Investigator with authority over use of the RF Equipment shall:

- (a) Advise the Division Commander regarding the use of the RF Equipment.
- (b) Identify the facts and reasoning for not obtaining a search warrant. In most cases of exigent circumstances, a search warrant will be obtained within three (3) days of use of the equipment and will be completed in accordance with the requirements set forth in the Deployment section of this policy.

### **606.6 OUTSIDE AGENCY REQUESTS**

The Bureau of Investigation may assist any Federal, State, or local law enforcement agency with a law enforcement or lifesaving purpose. Requests from outside agencies for assistance involving

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the use of RF Equipment must be approved by a Bureau Commander or his/her designee, and must be compliant with the requirements established forth below:

- (a) The required deployment is for an approved purpose in compliance with this policy.
- (b) A search warrant has been obtained that meets the requirements listed in section 606.4 of this policy.
- (c) If a warrantless use of the RF Equipment is requested, it must involve an emergency involving risk of death or serious physical injury to any person that requires the use of RF Equipment without delay. The agency requesting the use of the device must apply for a warrant or court order authorizing the use of the device within (3) days after the emergency use. A copy of any warrant or court order obtained must be provided to the Bureau of Investigation.
- (d) Only the location and/or device identification number shall be provided to the outside agency. All data that is unrelated to the outside agency's investigation shall not be shared, and will be destroyed by the Bureau of Investigation, unless otherwise ordered by the court issuing the search warrant.

### **606.7 RETENTION AND DESTRUCTION OF INFORMATION GATHERED**

All information obtained during a deployment of RF Equipment must be deleted at the conclusion of the operation within the following time periods:

- (a) When the equipment is used to locate a known cellular device, all data must be deleted as soon as the target device is located, or at least once daily.
- (b) When the equipment is used to locate an unknown cellular device, data must be deleted as soon as the target cellular device is identified, and in any event no less than every 30 days.
- (c) If the operator identified exculpatory data or evidence during the use of the equipment, any data or evidence obtained must be preserved.
- (d) When the equipment is used following a disaster, or in a search and rescue context, all data must be deleted as soon as the person(s) in need of assistance has been located, and no less than once every ten days.

### **606.8 MONITORING AND AUDITS**

Operators using RF Equipment will be appropriately supervised to ensure they are operating the equipment in compliance with applicable laws and this policy. The Bureau Commander will audit the use of the equipment on an annual basis to ensure compliance.

The purchase of a 16 channel Portable Base Station Unit with 5G SA Coverage and G350 Geolocation Device.
  - b. Explain the unique features of the goods/services being requested from this supplier: This Cell Site Simulator will locate any phone operating in the US on any US carrier. This can also include certain tablets, watches and vehicles with cellular connectivity. The DA Investigators will be capable of locating criminals, Amber

and Silver alert victims, suicidal citizens, lost individuals, or natural disaster victims via their cell phone activity. Additionally, the equipment comes with a proprietary Mission Control (NyxMC), which is the graphical user interface software hosted on a laptop. This allows maximum operational flexibility. The solution is available in various configurations and can be deployed from a mobile vehicle, aerial, or fixed platforms.

CSS technology will enable authorized investigators to locate cellular devices in two scenarios:

1. During exigent circumstances or emergencies, with a judicial search warrant submitted to a magistrate within 72 hours; or
2. Following the issuance of a search warrant signed by a magistrate, in accordance with state and federal law.

In both scenarios, the search warrant must specifically request the use of CSS technology. Authorized investigators can use the CSS technology to help locate cellular devices whose unique identifiers are already known to law enforcement, or to determine the unique identifiers of a cellular device. CSS equipment uses cellular technology to provide the precise geo-location of a cellular device. ### **1. SALE, PRICES AND RELEASES**

TSE determines product prices by TSE published price lists in effect and TSE price quote. In the event of extraordinary market-price increases for fuels, metals, raw materials, components, equipment and other production costs, TSE shall have the right and Buyer shall have the obligation to renegotiate in good faith the price of the goods hereunder not yet shipped, and if agreement is not reached, TSE shall have the right to cancel this contract without liability.

### **2. TERMS AND METHOD OF PAYMENT**

Where TSE has extended credit to Buyer, terms of payment shall be Net thirty (30) days from date of invoice. The amount of credit or terms of payment may be changed or credit withdrawn by TSE at any time for any reason. If the goods are delivered in installments, Buyer shall pay for each installment in accordance with the terms of payment hereof. When Buyer fails to make each payment when it is due, TSE reserves the right to withdraw credit and thereby suspend or cancel performance under any or all purchase orders or agreements in which TSE has extended credit to Buyer. TSE's suspension of performance may result in a rescheduling delay contingent on current product availability. If TSE deems Buyer's financial condition does not justify the terms of payment specified herein, TSE may cancel this contract unless Buyer shall immediately pay for all goods which have been delivered and pay in advance for all goods to be delivered.

### **3. TAXES**

Prices do not include taxes. TSE is a manufacturer and wholesale distributor and does not collect or pay sales, excise or franchise taxes. Buyer must provide TSE with a tax-exemption certificate if they are a non-government entity. Buyer pays international duties and taxes (if any). Any and all taxes are the buyer's responsibility.

### **4. TITLE AND DELIVERY**

Domestic shipments of goods within the U.S. shall be delivered F.O.B. shipping point. Title and liability for loss or damage shall pass to Buyer upon TSE's tender of delivery of goods to a carrier or forwarder for shipment to Buyer, and any subsequent loss or damage shall not relieve Buyer from any obligation. Buyer shall reimburse TSE for costs of insurance and transportation on international shipments and shall be responsible for all import duties, taxes and any other expenses incurred or licenses or clearances required at port of entry and destination. TSE may deliver the goods in installments. Delivery dates are estimates. TSE shall not be liable for any loss or expense (consequential or otherwise) incurred by Buyer if TSE fails to meet the estimated delivery dates because of unavoidable production or other delays.

### **5. WARRANTIES AND RELATED REMEDIES**

*The following are in lieu of all conditions or warranties, express, implied or statutory, including but not limited to, any implied conditions or warranty of merchantability or fitness for a particular purpose and of any other warranty obligation on the part of TSE.*

TSE, except as otherwise provided below, warrants the product against faulty workmanship or use of defective materials, and warrants that the products conform to TSE's published specifications or other mutually agreed upon written specifications for a period of one (1) year from the date of shipment. Testing and other quality control techniques are used to the extent TSE deems necessary to support this warranty. TSE warrants that at the time of delivery, TSE has title to the products free and clear of all liens and encumbrances. These warranties are only warranties made by TSE and only a written document signed by an authorized TSE officer can amend the warranty.

Continued use or possession of the products after expiration of the applicable warranty period stated above shall be conclusive evidence that the warranty is fulfilled to the full satisfaction of Buyer. TSE makes no warranty as to software products, which are supplied "AS-IS", or as to experimental or developmental products or products not manufactured by TSE. For products not manufactured by TSE, TSE shall assign to Buyer any rights TSE may have under any warranty of the supplier to the extent permitted by TSE's contract with its supplier.

If TSE breaches its warranties as contained herein, TSE's sole maximum liability shall be – at TSE's option – to repair, replace, or credit Buyer's account for any products returned by Buyer

- (a) The buyer promptly notifies TSE with a detailed list of alleged deficiencies upon the discovery by the Buyer that the products failed to conform to this contract.
- (b) The Buyer returns the products F.O.B. to TSE's plant from where products were shipped; and
- (c) TSE's examination of the products discloses that such alleged deficiencies actually exist and were: not caused by damage that occurred in shipment; failure caused by products not supplied by TSE; failures that result from accident, misuse, abuse, neglect, mishandling, misapplication, alteration, modifications, improper installation, unauthorized repair or improper testing; or damage attributable to Acts of God. Product(s) under warranty shall be shipped prepaid to TSE for a Return Material Authorization (RMA) number. An original packing slip, invoice or other proof of date of original purchase will be required before TSE renders warranty performance.

**Domestic customers within the Continental USA are responsible for shipping/transportation cost from the customer to TSE.** TSE pays the return shipping cost from TSE to the customer via ground or USPS parcel service only. International customers are responsible for shipping/transportation from the customer to TSE and from TSE to the customer. The customer is responsible for all local and international customs, duties and taxes (if any). If TSE elects to repair or replace the products, TSE shall have a reasonable time to make the repair(s) or replacement. There are no express warranties except as listed above. *TSE shall not be liable, or in any way responsible for special, incidental, consequential, punitive, property, or other damages, including, without limitation, loss of goodwill, profits or revenue, loss of use of this product(s) or any associated equipment, cost of substitute equipment, downtime cost, or claims of any part dealing with Buyer for such damages, resulting from the use of this product(s), or arising from breach of warranty or contract, negligence, or any other legal theory. All express and implied warranties, including the warranties of merchantability and fitness for a particular purpose, are limited to the applicable warranty period set forth above.*

*TSE may provide technical, applications or design advice, quality characterization, and reliability data or service in connection with Buyer's order. Providing these items shall not expand or otherwise affect TSE's warranties set forth above and no obligation or liability shall arise from TSE's provision of such items.*

### **6. CONTINGENCIES**

TSE is not liable, either wholly or in part, for nonperformance or a delay in performance due to *force majeure* or contingencies or causes beyond the reasonable control of TSE, including but not limited to, shortage of labor, fuel, raw material, components or machinery or technical or yield failure where TSE has exercised ordinary care in the prevention thereof. Production and deliveries may be allocated by TSE in a reasonable manner in the event of shortage of goods.

### **7. MILITARY APPLICATIONS AND/OR ENVIRONMENTS.**

TSE products are considered Commercial off the Shelf (COTS) products that are suitable for use "AS-IS" in military application and or military environments that do not exceed TSE products' specifications.

### **8. CRITICAL APPLICATIONS**

Certain applications using TSE product may invoke potential risks of death, personal injury or severe property or environmental damage ("Critical Applications"). TSE products are not designed and are not warranted as suitable for use in life-support applications, devices or systems or other Critical Applications. ### **9. CONFIDENTIALITY**

"Confidential information" means information of TSE that relates to TSE products, specifications, drawings, design, computer programs, trade secrets, business and technical information, and data disclosed by TSE to Buyer in document or other tangible form bearing an appropriate legend indicating its confidential or proprietary nature. TSE shall indicate "Confidential Information" to the Buyer within fifteen (15) days of the initial disclosure. Buyer may use Confidential Information of TSE only for the purpose of this contract and shall protect such Confidential Information from disclosure to others, using the same degree of care used to protect its own proprietary information of like importance, but in any case using no less than a reasonable degree of care. Buyer agrees not to "reverse engineer" Tactical Support Equipment products by any means, shape or form. Buyer may disclose Confidential information received hereunder only for the purpose described in this contract and only to its employees and consultants who have a need to know for such purpose and who are bound by signed, written agreements to protect the received Confidential Information for unauthorized use and disclosure. All obligations hereunder, including without limitation any and all obligations regarding the use and disclosure of Confidential Information, shall continue for a period of ten (10) years from the disclosure date of the affected Confidential Information.

### **10. LIMITATION AND DISCLAIMER OF DAMAGES**

If TSE breaches any provisions of this contract other than its warranties as contained in Section 8, TSE's sole liability shall not exceed the total contract price specified herein less the purchase price for any items delivered and accepted hereunder. Remedies for breach of warranty are limited to those stated in Section 8.

*In no event shall TSE be liable to anyone for special, collateral, indirect, exemplary, incidental or consequential damages for breach of any of the provisions of this contract, such damages to include but not be limited to, costs of rework, retesting or removal and reinstallation of products, loss of goodwill, loss of profits, or loss of use.*

### **11. TERMINATION AND CANCELLATION**

All sales are final. No returns. Buyer may terminate this contract in whole or in part upon (120) days advance written notice with the exception of Training Contracts. In such event, the Buyer shall pay for products shipped before the termination date and is responsible for all costs incurred by TSE including, but not limited to, initial costs, labor costs, cost of procured parts, termination costs of contracts with sub-contractors, and other costs, expenses and losses incurred by TSE in the performance of the work terminated. Training contracts may not be modified or cancelled within (30) days of scheduled training. Any requests for changes or cancellations will result in the course being charged at the contracted price.

### **12. NON-WAIVER OF DEFAULT**

TSE may decline to make further shipments for any default by the Buyer. If TSE elects to continue to make shipments, TSE's action shall not constitute a waiver of any default by Buyer or in any way affect TSE's legal remedies for any such default.

### **13. GOVERNING LAW**

State of North Carolina laws shall govern the validity, performance and construction of this contract.

### **14. EXPORT CONTROL**

*The products covered by this contract may fall within the group of "strategic" electronic products or technical data that are wholly or partly of U.S. origin or technology, the export of which is subject to export license control by the U.S. government. Therefore, prior to exportation, Buyer is required to obtain any licenses which may be required under the idea and Cost Accounting Standards, Defective Pricing, and Audit requirements will not apply.*

### **15. ASSIGNMENT**

This contract shall not be assignable by either party without the written consent of the other party. Unauthorized assignment shall be void.

### **16. MODIFICATION**

*This contract constitutes the entire agreement between the parties relating to the sale of the goods described on the face hereof and supersedes all previous communications, representations, or agreement, either oral or written, with respect to the subject matter hereof. No representations or statements of any kind made by any representative of TSE, which are not stated herein, shall be binding on TSE. No addition to or modification of any provision upon the face or reverse of this contract shall be binding upon TSE unless made in writing and signed by a duly authorized representative of TSE. No course of dealing or usage of trade or course of performance shall be relevant to explain or supplement any term expressed in this contract.*
