**BACKGROUND:**

**Summary**

In 2004, Resolution 2004-285 established the Temescal Valley Community Fund, directing certain settlement fees into a subfund managed by the Department of Environmental Health. Due to an omission in the original setup of the account, the accrued interest has been deposited to the General Fund instead of the subfund as intended by the Board in 2004. Opportunities remain to leverage future interest as accrued by the fund's principal for the community's benefit, as originally intended with modification to the accounting structure of the fund.

**Impact on Residents and Businesses**

No negative impact. Accrued interest remaining within the subfund will provide area residents with additional resources for the benefit of the community.

4 **REMAIN WITHIN THE TEMESCAL VALLEY COMMUNITY FUND**


5 WHEREAS, On June 22, 2004, the Board of Supervisors unanimously approved the establishment of

8 surrounding community, as established in the original settlement agreement; and

9 WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors reaffirms and recognizes that there are current and future potential  
10 projects and activities that can improve the quality of life for the communities within the Temescal Valley; and

11 WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors recognizes that the prior arrangement was established in a manner  
12 that did not allow for the retention of interest on the original Host and Implementation Cost fees as remitted at  
13 the time by Synagro Corporation; and

14 BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside, State  
15 of California, in regular session assembled on July 29, 2025, does hereby approve and direct that all accrued  
16 interest shall remain within the Temescal Valley Community Fund.
