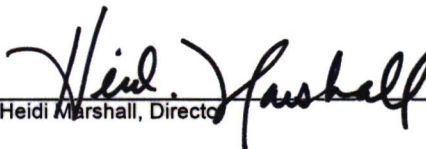

BACKGROUND:

Summary

The County of Riverside is designated as a local workforce development area and correspondingly receives funding under the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA). Federal funds received under WIOA are allocated to activities that link resources, people, business, and education resulting in a competitive workforce. Related programs and services benefit workers and employers in Riverside County. The Riverside County Housing and Workforce Solutions Department/Workforce Development Division (HWS/WDD) administers implementation of WIOA-funded programs and services.

The Federal Department of Labor (DOL) grants WIOA funds to local workforce development areas in California through the State of California Employment Development Department (EDD). In turn, EDD subgrants WIOA funds to HWS/WDD. As a subrecipient, HWS/WDD is responsible for meeting WIOA-related requirements promulgated by both the DOL and EDD. On August 30, 2022, the Board of Supervisors (Board) approved and accepted the allocation of WIOA funds Subgrant Agreement No. AA311025 (Minute Order #3.31).

EDD requires HWS/WDD to complete and submit the attached documents as part of the closeout process for WIOA subgrants, including the recently completed Subgrant No. AA311025 in the amount of \$19,505,601.00. The closeout is a requirement and stipulates that any and all further interests or claims against the sub-grant are assigned to the EDD. HWS/WDD has fulfilled all sub-grant requirements, including WIOA training expenditure requirements imposed by California Senate Bill (SB) 734.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

Under the leadership of the County's Workforce Development Board, HWS/WDD provides a comprehensive array of workforce development services to employers, laid-off workers, veterans, youth, justice-involved, and persons with disabilities throughout Riverside County. HWS/WDD was able to assist over 44,503 walk-in customers between the Workforce Development and Youth Opportunity Centers. The Workforce Development Centers (WDCs) assisted 2,362 customers with intensive career service, 911 of which completed vocational training certification programs. As of March 2025, 842 adult customers successfully obtained full-time employment. The number of customers employed will significantly increase as services are still being provided after the closeout of the Subgrant.

The Youth Opportunity Centers (YOCs) served 685 individual youth with a combination of services, including work experience programs, supportive services, and certification trainings. Of these youth, 435 have acquired employment or entered post-secondary education.

HWS/WDD's employer services team helped over 343 individuals obtain on the job training with local employers. The team hosted and attended a total of 40 job fairs which reached a combined total of 825 businesses and 5,706 potential jobseekers.

These services were fully funded by federal WIOA funds and implemented in concert with a variety of partners in the County's workforce system, including EDD, the community college system, and the Department of Vocational Rehabilitation, among others.

Riverside County has been awarded \$995,000 of WIOA 25% Additional Assistance funds for the Chuckawalla Valley State Prison Closure. The funds will be utilized to assist residents of Blythe affected by the impending closure of the State Prison by providing career and employment services, training opportunities and supportive services to 120 residents. The purpose of this modification is to incorporate \$400,000 of WIOA 25% Additional Assistance funding to the Chuckawalla Valley State Prison Closure into grant code 1295. The term of these funds is July 31, 2024 through March 31, 2025. The remaining funds of \$595,000 will be incorporated into Riverside County's AA411025 subgrant.

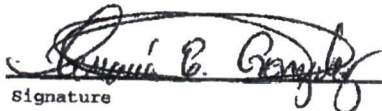

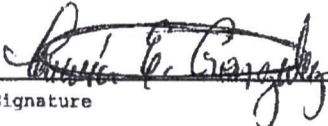

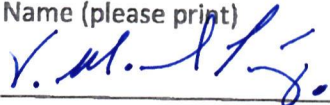

Assign, transfer, set over and release to the Central Office Workforce Services Division, Employment Development Department, the State of California (hereafter called COWSD), all right, title and interest thereon, arising out of the performance of said subgrant together with all the rights of action accrued or hereafter accrue thereunder.

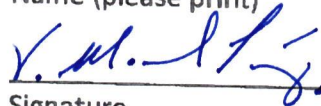

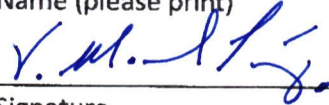

Requests to Address Board on "Agenda" Items:

You may request to be heard on a published agenda item. Requests to be heard must be submitted to the Clerk of the Board before the scheduled meeting time.

Requests to Address Board on items that are "NOT" on the Agenda:

Notwithstanding any other provisions of these rules, member of the public shall have the right to address the Board during the mid-morning "Oral Communications" segment of the published agenda. Said purpose for address must pertain to issues which are under the direct jurisdiction of the Board of Supervisors. YOUR TIME WILL BE LIMITED TO THREE (3) MINUTES.

Power Point Presentations/Printed Material:

Speakers who intend to conduct a formalized Power Point presentation or provide printed material must notify the Clerk of the Board's Office by 12 noon on the Monday preceding the Tuesday Board meeting, insuring that the Clerk's Office has sufficient copies of all printed materials and at least one (1) copy of the Power Point CD. Copies of printed material given to the Clerk (by Monday noon deadline) will be provided to each Supervisor. If you have the need to use the overhead "Elmo" projector at the Board meeting, please insure your material is clear and with proper contrast, notifying the Clerk well ahead of the meeting, of your intent to use the Elmo. **Speakers are prohibited from bringing signs, placards or posters into the hearing room.**

Individual Speaker Limits:

Individual speakers are limited to a maximum of three (3) minutes.

Please step up to the podium when the Chairman calls your name and begin speaking immediately. Pull the microphone to your mouth so that the Board, audience, and audio recording system hear you clearly. Once you start speaking, the "green" podium light will light. The "yellow" light will come on when you have one (1) minute remaining. When you have 30 seconds remaining, the "yellow" light will begin flash, indicating you must quickly wrap up your comments. Your time is up when the "red" light flashes. The Chairman adheres to a strict three (3) minutes per speaker. **Note: If you intend to give your time to a "Group/Organized Presentation", please state so clearly at the very bottom of the reverse side of this form.**

Group/Organized Presentations:

Group/organized presentations with more than one (1) speaker will be limited to nine (9) minutes at the Chairman's discretion. The organizer of the presentation will automatically receive the first three (3) minutes, with the remaining six (6) minutes relinquished by other speakers, as requested by them on a completed "Request to Speak" form, and clearly indicated at the front bottom of the form.

Addressing the Board & Acknowledgement by Chairman:

The Chairman will determine what order the speakers will address the Board, and will call on all speakers in pairs. The first speaker should immediately step to the podium and begin addressing the Board. The second speaker should take up a position in one of the chamber aisles in order to quickly step up to the podium after the preceding speaker. This is to afford an efficient and timely Board meeting, giving all attendees the opportunity to make their case. Speakers are prohibited from making personal attacks, and/or using coarse, crude, profane or vulgar language while speaking to the Board members, staff, the general public and/or meeting participants. Such behavior, at the discretion of the Board Chairman may result in removal from the Board Chambers by Sheriff Deputies.
