1. Find that the 6th Avenue and 10th Avenue Resurfacing Project is categorically exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines Section 15301 (c) - Existing Facilities;
2. Approve the plans and specifications for the construction of the 6th Avenue and 10th Avenue Resurfacing Project, in the Community of West Blythe;
3. Authorize the Clerk of the Board to advertise for bids to be received by the office of the Director of Transportation and Land Management at the Transportation Annex located at 3525 14th Street, Riverside, CA 92501. All bids must be received up to the hour of 2:00 p.m., Wednesday, August 20, 2025 at which time bids will be opened; and
4. Direct the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors to file the Notice of Exemption with the County Clerk for posting within five (5) working days.

BACKGROUND:

Summary

The County of Riverside Transportation Department proposes to resurface approximately 5 miles of 6th Avenue from 2 miles west of De Frain Boulevard to Intake Boulevard / State Highway 95 (SH-95), and to resurface approximately 1.6 miles of 10th Avenue from 0.6 mile west of Arrowhead Boulevard to De Frain Boulevard in the community of West Blythe.

Both 6th Avenue and 10th Avenue are two-lane roads in the West-East direction and both roads are classified as Secondary Highways in the circulation element of the County of Riverside's General Plan. 6th Avenue has a road width that ranges between 24 feet and 39 feet, and 10th Avenue has a road width of 26 feet.

Four projects are being combined to bid as one project in order to gain efficiencies by eliminating multiple bidding and administrative procedures, and to seek more favorable bid costs associated with larger bid quantities.

Roadway resurfacing is needed due to the deteriorated pavement condition, which is generally associated with age and weathering. The proposed resurfacing project consists of grinding existing asphalt concrete in place (pulverize), mixing and compacting grindings with native soil, and overlaying the new base with new hot mix asphalt (HMA) concrete.

Additional improvements include adjusting utility manholes, placement of safety edge and grading dirt shoulders to protect the outside edge of pavement, reconstructing asphalt concrete dikes, safety features including reconstructing metal beam guardrails, installing pavement striping, pavement markers and reflectors, thermoplastic pavement markings, removing and installing roadside signs, and other associated work.

The submitted plans and specifications have been approved as to form by County Counsel.

Improvements within the City of Blythe are included in the bid package as alternate bid schedules. If the City of Blythe approves the award of their alternate bid schedules, as bid by the apparent low bidder, the cost for the work will be funded by the City of Blythe through a reimbursement agreement, which will be submitted to the Board of Supervisors for approval prior to or concurrent with the award of the construction contract.

The Transportation Department will select the contractor based upon the lowest responsive and responsible bid.

Environmental Findings

The proposed project is exempt from CEQA under Section 15301 (c) – Existing Facilities exemption because the 6th Avenue and 10th Avenue Resurfacing Projects do not create additional traffic lanes and involve negligible or no expansion of existing or former use of the existing roadways and associated facilities.

Impact on Citizens and Businesses

The purpose of this project is to replace existing deteriorated pavement with new hot mix asphalt concrete for a combined total of 6.6-miles of 6th Avenue and 10th Avenue in the Community of West Blythe to provide the public with a smooth paved roadway that will improve the safety and efficiency of vehicular traffic. 6th Avenue is used as a route to the Palo Verde Community College located 2-miles west of De Frain Boulevard intersection.

The work is anticipated to begin in fall 2025. The work will be phased to keep the roads open during construction as much as possible and will take approximately two and a half months to complete.

10th Ave is a secondary road that travels in the West-East direction from 0.61 west of Arrowhead Blvd to DeFrain Blvd - a total of 1.6 miles. 10th Ave is currently a two-lane facility with a road width of 26 feet.

- Adjusting utility manholes
- Grading shoulder
- Reconstructing asphalt concrete dikes
- Reconstructing guardrail
- Re-application of pavement striping
- Removing and installing various signs

ENVIRONMENTAL ANALYSIS:

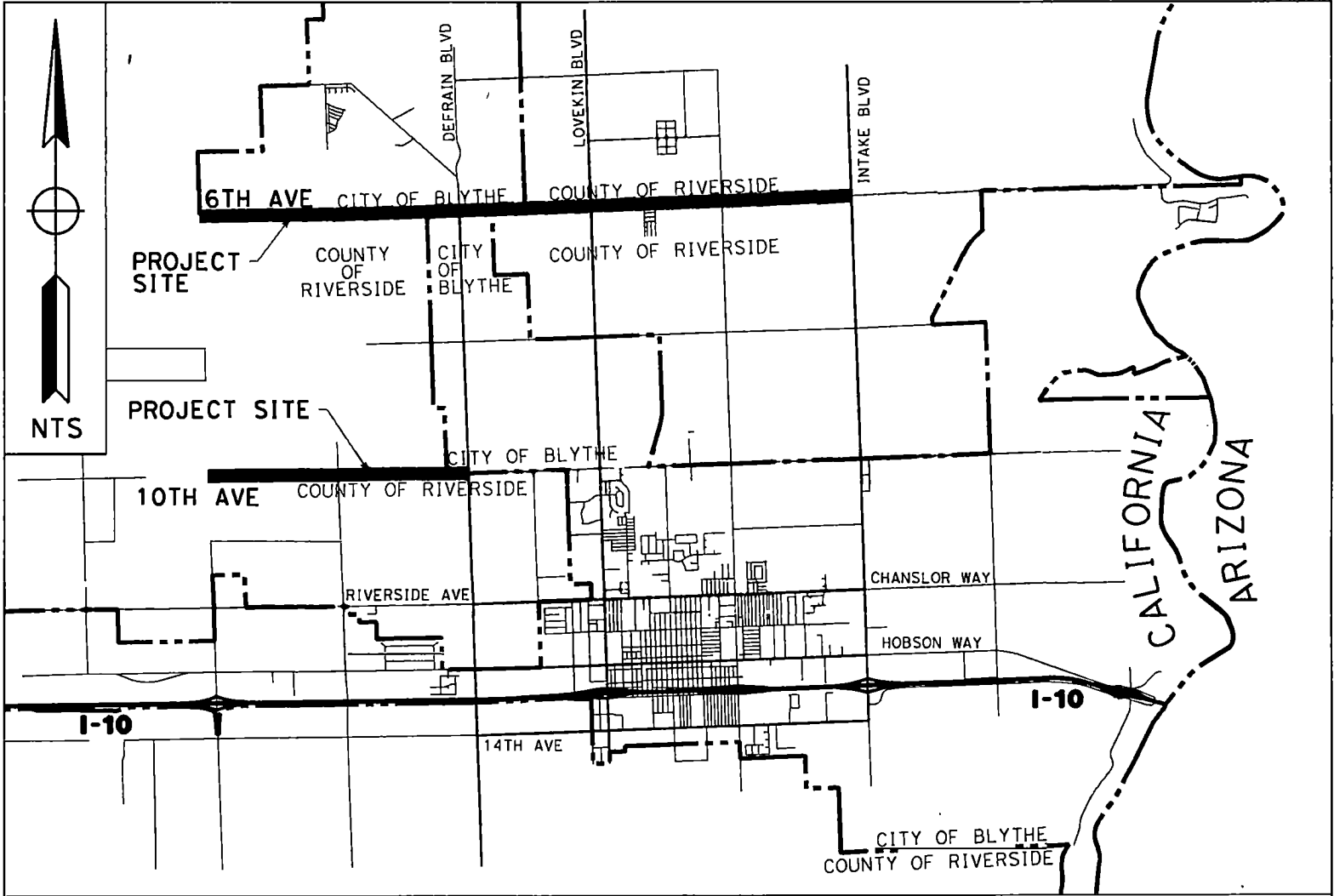
If tree and/or vegetation removal takes place during the migratory bird breeding season (February 1 – September 1), a preconstruction nesting survey will be conducted pursuant to the Migratory Bird Treaty Act.

The County of Riverside Transportation Department has found that the above-described project is exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), based on the following:

Section 15301 (c) – Existing Facilities – The proposed project of pulverizing existing pavement and repaving approximately 6.6 miles of existing asphalt concrete (AC) pavement on 6th Avenue and 10th Avenue in the area of Mesa Verde and communities of North and West Blythe. The proposed project is consistent with Section 15301(c) which exempts existing highways and streets, sidewalks, gutters, bicycle and pedestrian trail, and similar facilities, (this includes road grading for the purpose of public safety). Furthermore, the project does not create additional automobile lanes and involves minimal to no expansion of use of the exiting roadway and associated facilities.

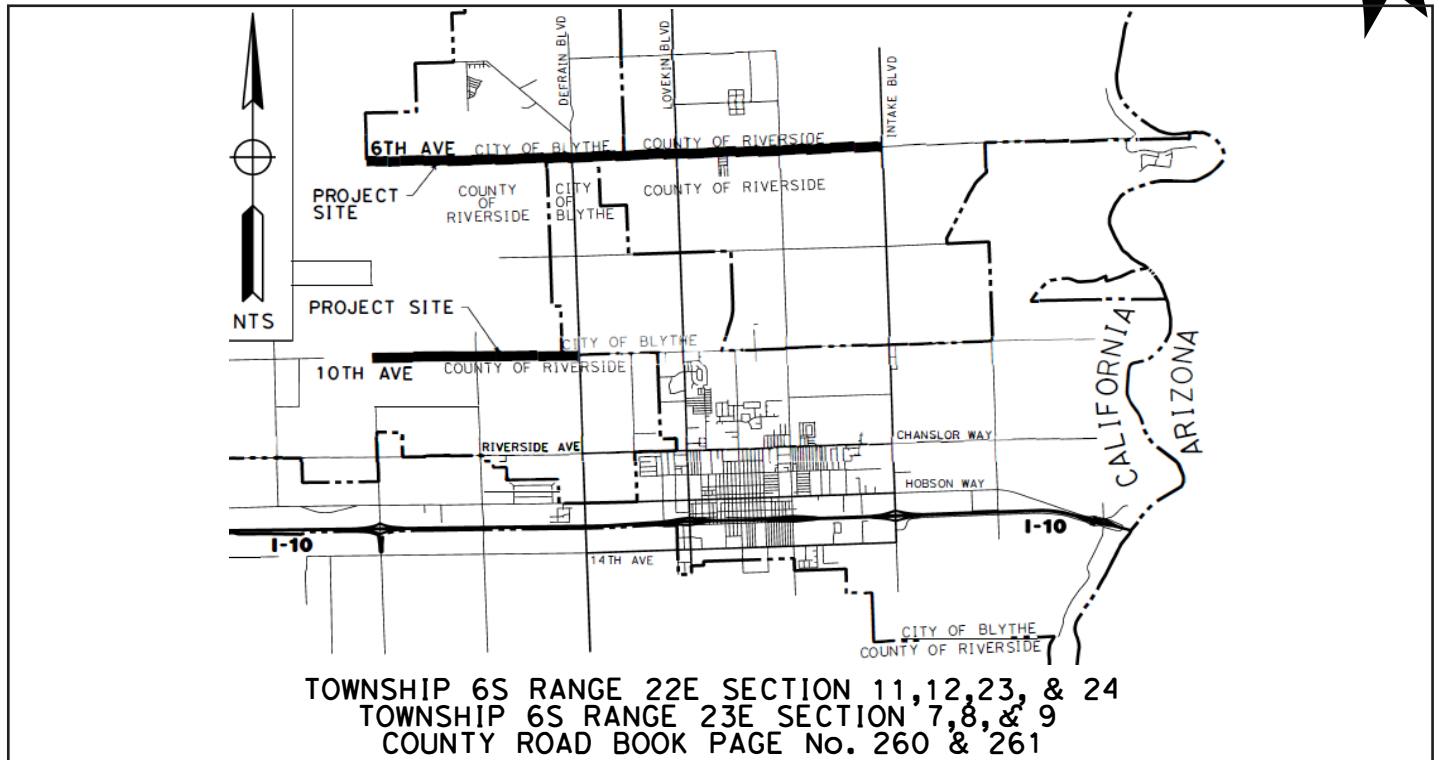
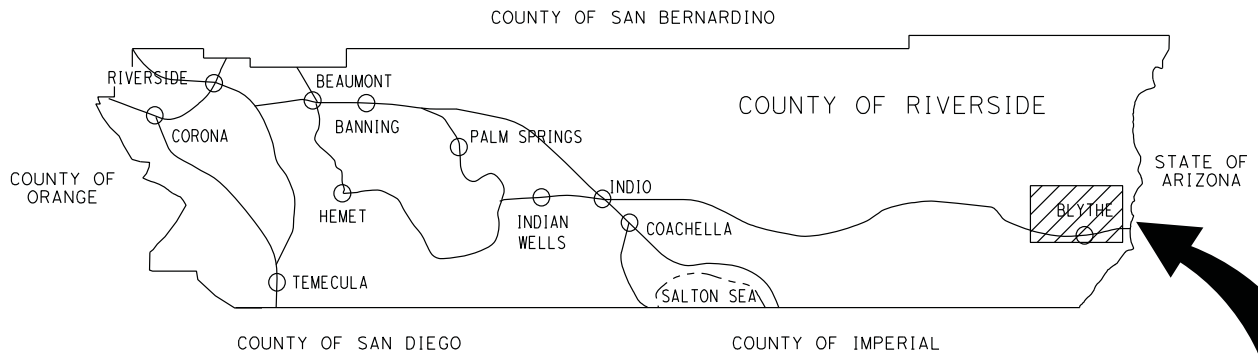
