**BACKGROUND:**

Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

1. **City of Murrieta Senior Center** - \$2,000- The funding will support the Murrieta Senior Center’s 20th Anniversary Dedication Ceremony.
2. **Professional Women’s Roundtable**- \$1,250- The funding will support Living the Legacy, Leading the Future, an event that equips aspiring women leaders with business resources and opportunities for community involvement.
3. **SAFE Family Justice Centers**- \$5,000- The funding will support the 2025 Camp Hope–Riverside County, a summer program for children and teens ages 7–17 who have been impacted by violence and abuse
4. **Temecula Valley Chamber of Commerce**-\$1,300- The funding will support the 19th Annual Women in Business event, which empowers businesswomen by providing education on building strong, supportive networks.
5. **Menifee Valley Community Cupboard**- \$6,500- The funding will be used to support (1) the food pantry distribution program and (2) the annual “Celebrity Karaoke” fundraiser, which raises funds for the emergency food assistance program.
6. **Hemet San Jacinto Community Health Foundation**-\$1,500- The funding will be used to support the Heart Alliance Pulse Point Program, which offers free CPR and AED training to educate the public on how to respond to cardiac arrest and save lives.
