**BACKGROUND:** Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

1. **The Riverside County Department of Child Support Services** is hosting its annual Backpack and School Supply Giveaway on Saturday, August 9, 2025, from 8:00 AM to 12:00 PM at its Riverside branch office (2081 Iowa Avenue, Riverside, CA) in celebration of Child Support Awareness Month. The **\$2,500** will support the event that aims to support families in the First District by providing backpacks and school supplies for children aged 3-17, free haircuts, parent resource packets, educational materials, and outreach activities.
2. **The Kiwanis Club of Uptown Riverside**, founded in 1956, is a volunteer organization focused on serving children and the underserved community in Riverside. Their primary fundraising event, Casino Royale, attracts around 300 attendees and raises over \$50,000 annually, which is reinvested into the local community. The **\$1,000** funds will support initiatives such as providing Thanksgiving meals to 160 families, awarding scholarships to high school students, and donating to local programs.
3. **SAFE Alternatives for Everyone (S.A.F.E)** was founded in 1998 to address domestic violence in the community. It became a founding partner of the Family Justice Center movement in Riverside County in 2004. Their mission is to provide comprehensive services to protect families, seek justice, and foster safe futures for those impacted by violence. The **\$2,500** funds will sponsor their annual "An Evening of Hope" event on September 19, 2025, at Citrus State Historic Park in Riverside. The Event celebrates the impact of Camp HOPE, a program for young trauma survivors.
4. **Perris Valley Filipino American Association** founded in 1997, aims to promote and preserve Filipino arts, culture, and heritage while fostering community, family values, and the Filipino spirit of bayanihan. The organization has expanded its mission to include mental health advocacy and anti-hate initiatives, supported by partnerships and grants. The **\$2,500** funds will support the Baryo Fiesta (Fiesta), scheduled for October 18, 2025. The Fiesta is a vibrant community festival celebrating Filipino heritage and the cultural diversity of Perris. It will also have a resource fair, provides information on mental health, anti-hate efforts, and cultural education.
5. **Shoe That Fits** a nonprofit organization based in Claremont, California, founded in 1992. The organization provides new athletic shoes to children in need to address visible signs of poverty, improve their dignity, and enhance their ability to learn, play, and thrive. Shoes That Fit is receiving **\$1,000** to launch a program serving Riverside County's First Supervisorial District, in Mead Valley. The funds will provide new shoes for low-income children identified by school staff as lacking proper footwear.
