

**BACKGROUND:** Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

1. The donation to Region 13 Key Clubs (\$2,000.00) will be used to provide students, especially those from lower-income backgrounds, with a summer opportunity to build leadership, teamwork, and civic engagement skills. Funding helps cover transportation and ensures equitable access. Students earn community service hours, connect with like-minded peers, and gain experiences that support their future college and career success.
2. The donation to the Jurupa Unified School District – Parent Involvement & Community Outreach (\$2,000.00) will be used to provide vital resources, such as food, supplies, marketing and services for families and students as they prepare for the upcoming school year.
3. The donation to the Rivers & Lands Conservancy (\$3,000.00) will support the 12th Annual Fundraising Gala, Connecting through Conservation, which directly benefits RLC's expanding environmental education and community outreach programs, increasing access to conservation resources and learning opportunities.

4. The donation to Inspire Life Skills Training, Inc. (\$4,000.00) will support the 20th Annual Make a Difference Gala, which raises essential funds to ensure youth have access to safe, stable housing and remain connected to critical support services and resources.
5. The donation to Jurupa Valley High School (\$2,000.00) will support the Jurupa Valley Level Up Attendance Program, a semester-long initiative aimed at reducing chronic absenteeism and increasing academic motivation among vulnerable student populations. The program addresses barriers to participation by providing food, incentives such as awards and certificates, Chromebooks, and essential logistical supplies.
6. The donation to Angels Over Cliffs (\$4,000.00) will directly support programs such as emergency motel assistance and permanent housing move-in costs, Kids Programs, which include back to school supplies and winter coats, their education program and case management and resource navigation.
7. The donation to the FIATM Group, Inc. (\$2,000.00) will be used to provide tutoring, counseling, cultural awareness, workshops and personal development during their after-school mentoring program.
8. The donation to Reach Out (Reach Out West End) (\$2,500.00) will support the State of Latino Health Conference which designed to address the pressing physical, mental and behavioral health disparities impacting Latino communities throughout the Second District.
9. The donation to the Corona Historic Preservation Society (\$5,000.00) will support the Silver Dollar Pancake House Neon Sign Restoration Project that has adorned the Silver Dollar Pancake House since 1962. The Restaurant originally opened in 1936 as the Copper Kettle, is Corona's oldest continuously operating eatery. Restoration will include structural repairs, neon tube replacement, electrical upgrades and preservation treatments.
