SUBJECT: RIVERSIDE UNIVERSITY HEALTH SYSTEM-MEDICAL CENTER: Ratify and Approve Second Amendment to the Professional Medical Services Agreement with Brian J. Eichenberg, M.D., A Professional Corporation dba Renuance Cosmetic Surgery Center, to provide Plastic and Reconstructive Surgery Services effective June 30, 2025 through June 30, 2026, with the option to renew for two additional one year periods through June 30, 2028, All Districts. [Total Amendment Cost \$1,048,800, Annual Cost \$348,600; up to \$241,272 in Additional Compensation, 100% Hospital Enterprise Fund]

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:

1. Ratify and Approve Second Amendment to the Professional Medical Services Agreement with Dr. Brian J. Eichenberg, M.D., A Professional Corporation dba Renuance Cosmetic Surgery Center, to provide Plastic and Reconstructive Surgery Services effective June 30, 2025 through June 30, 2026, with the option to renew for two additional one year periods through June 30, 2028, to increase the annual maximum contract amount by \$348,600 from \$2,064,127 to \$2,412,727; and authorize the Chair of the Board to sign the Amendment on behalf of the County; and

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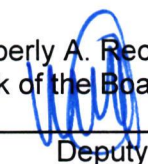

2. Authorize the Purchasing Agent, in accordance with Ordinance No. 459 and based on the availability of fiscal funding and as approved as to form by County Counsel, to; (a) sign amendments including modifications to the statement of work that stay within the intent of the Agreement, and (b) sign amendments to the compensation provisions that do not exceed the sum total of ten percent (10%) of the total annual cost of the Agreement.

3. Authorize the Purchasing Agent to issue Purchase Order(s) for the services provided not to exceed the approved amounts.

BACKGROUND:

Summary

There is a current Agreement in place with Brian J. Eichenberg, M.D for Plastic and Reconstructive Surgery Services. Given the success of this Agreement, as well as RUHS-MC's continued commitment to improve service levels, RUHS-MC wishes to extend the term of this Agreement. In addition to extending the term of the Agreement, RUHS-MC intends to amend the Agreement to ensure that the necessary staffing is in place to meet the increased level of healthcare needs.

The current Agreement provides inpatient, outpatient and on-call services related to surgeries and clinic-based care in the specialty of Plastic and Reconstructive Surgery. These services include surgical care and clinic-based treatment, as well as on-call coverage for patients with facial trauma. This Amendment will allow for the following changes if approved by the Board:

- Provide (1) FTE Advanced Practice Provider (APP) to support both clinic and inpatient rounding.

The volume of RUHS-MC patients seeking Plastic and Reconstructive Surgery services has resulted in an increased amount of work on the existing medical staff. To address this increase, RUHS-MC is in the process of implementing a Plastic Surgery Residency

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program. However, until the Residency Program becomes fully operational, the need for an APP is necessary to support ongoing patient care. Additionally, there has been an increased demand for 24/7 call coverage to support our emergency department and inpatient teams. Therefore, it was deemed appropriate to increase the night call compensation for this increased volume.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

These services are a component of RUHS's system of care aimed at improving the health and safety of its patients and the community.

Additional Fiscal Information

RUHS anticipates that with additional appropriations included in the Department's requested FY25/26 budget, sufficient funding will be available. No additional County funds are required.

Contract History and Price Reasonableness

On July 7, 2023, a four-month Professional Medical Services Agreement with Brian J. Eichenberg, M.D was executed under the Purchasing Agent's authority per Resolution 2021-116 for Plastic and Reconstructive Surgery Services effective July 1, 2023, through October 31, 2023, with a contract maximum of \$688,043.

On September 12, 2023, Agenda Item Number 15.1, the Board of Supervisors approved a Professional Medical Services Agreement with Brian J. Eichenberg, M.D for Plastic and Reconstructive Surgery Services effective November 1, 2023 through June 30, 2024, with the option to renew for four additional one-year periods, not to exceed an annual amount of \$2,064,128 per fiscal year.

On April 12, 2024, a First Amendment to the Agreement was executed under the Purchasing Agent's authority per Resolution 2021-116 to extend the Term of the Agreement and amend the Payment Provisions, effective July 1, 2024, through June 30, 2025.



Due to the addition of one FTE Advance Practice Provider and an increase in the Night Call compensation rate, this Second Amendment will increase the annual maximum compensation amount by \$348,600 from \$2,064,127 to \$2,412,727.

This Agreement requires Board approval as the compensation provision exceeds the Purchasing Agent's authority and the \$750,000 threshold for contracting with a single vendor for physician services per Resolution 2024-127.

**SECOND AMENDMENT TO THE
AGREEMENT FOR
PROFESSIONAL MEDICAL SERVICES
(Plastic and Reconstructive Surgery Services)**

This Second Amendment to the Agreement for Professional Medical Services (Plastic and Reconstructive Surgery Services) (“Second Amendment”), is entered into by and between the **County of Riverside** (COUNTY), a political subdivision of the State of California, on behalf of the **Riverside University Health System – Medical Center** (HOSPITAL) and **Brian J. Eichenberg, M.D.**, a California professional corporation, dba **Renuance Cosmetic Surgery Center** (CONTRACTOR), sometimes collectively referred to as the “Parties” or individually referred to as a “Party.”

WHEREAS, COUNTY and CONTRACTOR have entered into that certain Agreement for Professional Medical Services (Plastic and Reconstructive Surgery Services), approved September 12, 2023, Agenda Item #15.1, and effective November 1, 2023 (Agreement), whereby CONTRACTOR agreed to provide COUNTY with professional medical services in the specialty practice of Plastic and Reconstructive Surgery Services (SPECIALTY); and,

WHEREAS, COUNTY and CONTRACTOR entered into that certain First Amendment to the Agreement approved April 12, 2024, and effective July 1, 2024; and

WHEREAS, the Parties now desire to extend the Term of the Agreement by exercising a renewal option, amend the Compensation Provisions and amend the Scope of Work provided in the Agreement.

NOW THEREFORE, the Parties agree to amend their Agreement as follows:

1. **Ratification.** All actions taken by both Parties prior to the date hereof were in compliance with, and pursuant to the terms and conditions of the Agreement, and are hereby confirmed and ratified.
2. **Renewal.** The parties hereby agree to exercise the second one-year renewal option per Section 2.1 of the Agreement, commencing July 1, 2025 through June 30, 2026, with two (2) one-year renewal options remaining, unless terminated earlier.
3. **Compensation.** Section 3.1 Compensation, second sentence, is hereby amended to read as follows:

“Maximum payments by COUNTY to CONTRACTOR shall not exceed two million four hundred twelve thousand seven hundred twenty-seven dollars (\$2,412,727) per county fiscal year including all expenses.”

4. **Scope of Work.** Exhibit A Scope of Work, Section 1.0 CONTRACTOR STAFFING, Subsection A, is hereby deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

“Provide adequate staffing to assume medical care responsibilities for SPECIALTY services under the direction of the HOSPITAL Medical Director. It is contemplated there shall be the following positions staffed:

A full time equivalent (FTE) is agreed to be coverage at the HOSPITAL for forty-two (42) weeks per year, consisting of two operating room focused days averaging eight to ten (8-10) hours per day and three clinic focused days averaging eight (8) hours per day. It is agreed that at a staffing level of 2.2 FTEs CONTRACTOR is responsible for staffing the HOSPITAL's operating room and clinics for SPECIALTY services fifty-two (52) weeks per year. It is further agreed that at a staffing level of 1.0 FTEs CONTRACTOR is responsible for staffing the HOSPITAL and clinics for Advanced Practice Provider services to include clinic and inpatient rounding.”

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5. **Payment Provisions.** Exhibit B Payment Provisions, Section 1.0 Compensation, is hereby deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

“ Subject to the conditions set forth below, as payment for CONTRACTOR's provision of SPECIALTY outpatient/clinical services, administrative duties, supervisory duties, teaching services, inpatient care, development of treatment protocols, on-call coverage, supervision of SPECIALTY services provided at HOSPITAL, and all other services contemplated by this Agreement, HOSPITAL shall pay CONTRACTOR as specified in the table below.

If the parties mutually agree to change the staffing levels as contemplated above and such change is not effectuated on the first day of a month, then COUNTY shall pay CONTRACTOR a pro rata amount for each of the staffing levels used during such month. Any change to the staffing level must be mutually agreed upon by the Parties and evidenced by a written amendment to this Agreement.

The parties acknowledge that all amounts paid under this Agreement have been determined to be fair market value and commercially reasonable. Payments to CONTRACTOR shall be made on a monthly basis during the term of this Agreement. HOSPITAL shall pay CONTRACTOR payments by the invoice process described in this Agreement.”

6. **Maximum Compensation.** Exhibit B Payment Provisions, Section 4.0, is hereby deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

“Maximum compensation payable under this Agreement shall not exceed the amount of two million four hundred twelve thousand seven hundred twenty-seven dollars (\$2,412,727) per county fiscal year.”

7. **Miscellaneous.** All other terms and conditions of this Agreement are to remain unchanged.


8. **Effective Date.** This Second Amendment to the Agreement shall become effective on June 30, 2025.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the Parties have caused their duly authorized representatives to execute this Second Amendment.

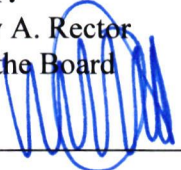
