SUBJECT: SHERIFF-CORONER-PA: Approve the Third Amendment to Agreement for Law Enforcement Services between the City of Rancho Mirage and the County of Riverside (FY21/22-25/26); Amend Salary Ordinance No. 440 pursuant to Resolution No. 440-9503 submitted herewith; District 4; [\$157,600 – 100% Contract City Law Enforcement Revenue]; 4/5th Vote

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:



BACKGROUND:

Summary

The City of Rancho Mirage approved the Third Amendment to the Law Enforcement Services Agreement for a modification of the level of service for FY21/22 through FY25/26. This Third Amendment to the Agreement for Law Enforcement Services with the City of Rancho Mirage modifies the level of law enforcement service provided by the Sheriff's Office with the addition of one (1) Sheriff Sergeant and two (2) Deputy Sheriff – 80 positions and the deletion of three (3) Deputy Sheriff - 84 positions. County Counsel has approved the Third Amendment as to form.

The FY25/26 estimated law enforcement service cost is \$14,590,600. Sheriff's Office staff has recommended budget adjustments that correspond with the additional contract position. Sheriff's Office staff has estimated this change will result in an estimated increase of \$157,600 in Contract Law Enforcement Revenue. The Sheriff's Office is recommending these budget adjustments now as it could not anticipate the additional expenditures to include them in its FY25/26 budget.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

This is a Third Amendment between the City of Rancho Mirage and the Sheriff's Office for law enforcement services, which the City of Rancho Mirage approved and executed on behalf of its citizens. All costs for this service will be fully recovered through the Sheriff's Office Board-approved rates.
