2. Approve the plans and specifications for the construction of Mission Boulevard Bridge Replacement over Santa Ana River Project in the Cities of Riverside and Jurupa Valley; and
3. Authorize the Clerk of the Board to advertise for bids to be received by the office of the Director of Transportation and Land Management at the Transportation Annex located at 3525 14th Street, Riverside, CA 92501. All bids must be received up to the hour of 2:00 p.m., Wednesday, September 24, 2025 at which time bids will be opened.



BACKGROUND:

Summary

The County of Riverside (County), in cooperation with the Cities of Riverside and Jurupa Valley, is proposing to replace the existing Mission Boulevard Bridge over the Santa Ana River, with a new, wider bridge to enhance safety and improve traffic circulation. The Mission Boulevard bridge is located within the City of Riverside and the City of Jurupa Valley.

The existing Mission Boulevard bridge carries four lanes of traffic over the Santa Ana River (two lanes in each direction) and is approximately 1,104 feet long and 61 feet wide with a 5-foot-wide sidewalk on the south side of the bridge. The proposed bridge will accommodate four traffic lanes, 4-foot concrete median, and 8-foot shoulders. A 12-foot-wide multi-purpose trail with concrete barrier separation from vehicular traffic will be located along the south side of the bridge in lieu of standard sidewalks on each side. The new bridge will be approximately 88 feet wide and 1,100 feet long.

On September 1, 2015 (Agenda Item 3.26), the Board of Supervisors approved the Service Agreement by and between the County of Riverside and the Cities of Riverside and Jurupa Valley to provide the administrative, technical, managerial, and support services for the project. Although the project is located within the jurisdictional boundaries of the Cities, the agencies desired to designate the County as the lead agency for the project since the County has extensive experience in the development and implementation of bridge projects involving federal and state agencies.

On December 11, 2018 (Agenda item 3.48), the Board of Supervisors adopted the Notice of Determination for the project pursuant to California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA).

The bid documents include the following bid schedule of work:

Base Bid: Mission Boulevard Bridge Replacement Project

The Transportation Department will select the contractor based upon the lowest responsive and responsible bid of the sum of all bid schedules.

The submitted plans and specifications have been approved as to form by County Counsel.

Environmental Findings

The County serves as a responsible agency pursuant to the requirements of CEQA. On December 11, 2018, the Board of Supervisors adopted the Final Initial Study/Mitigated Negative Declaration, and a Notice of Determination was filed to make the requisite responsible agency CEQA findings associated with the Project. As this is merely a continuation of the project as previously evaluated, nothing further is required under CEQA.

A Categorical Exclusion in accordance with 23 USC 327 for NEPA was executed on August 6, 2019, by State Department of Transportation (Caltrans).

Impact on Residents and Businesses

The Mission Boulevard Bridge replacement project will be designed in accordance with the latest state of the art design criteria, including current seismic design standards and protection for the 100-year storm event. The proposed bridge will enhance public safety and improve traffic circulation for motorists, residents, businesses, pedestrians, and emergency vehicles in the area. A multi-purpose trail is planned as part of this project providing connectivity to existing regional trails.

The work is scheduled to begin in late 2025 or early 2026. The work will be phased to keep the bridge open during construction as much as possible and will take approximately three and a half years to complete.

SUPPLEMENTAL:

Additional Fiscal Information

The construction contract is estimated to cost approximately \$52,363,586. Construction is expected to begin in FY 2025/2026 and will be mainly funded with federal funds - Highway Bridge Program (HBP), and partially funded with State Prop 1B Seismic Bridge funds, and local funds including City of Riverside funds, and City of Jurupa Valley funds.

No General Funds will be used on this project.

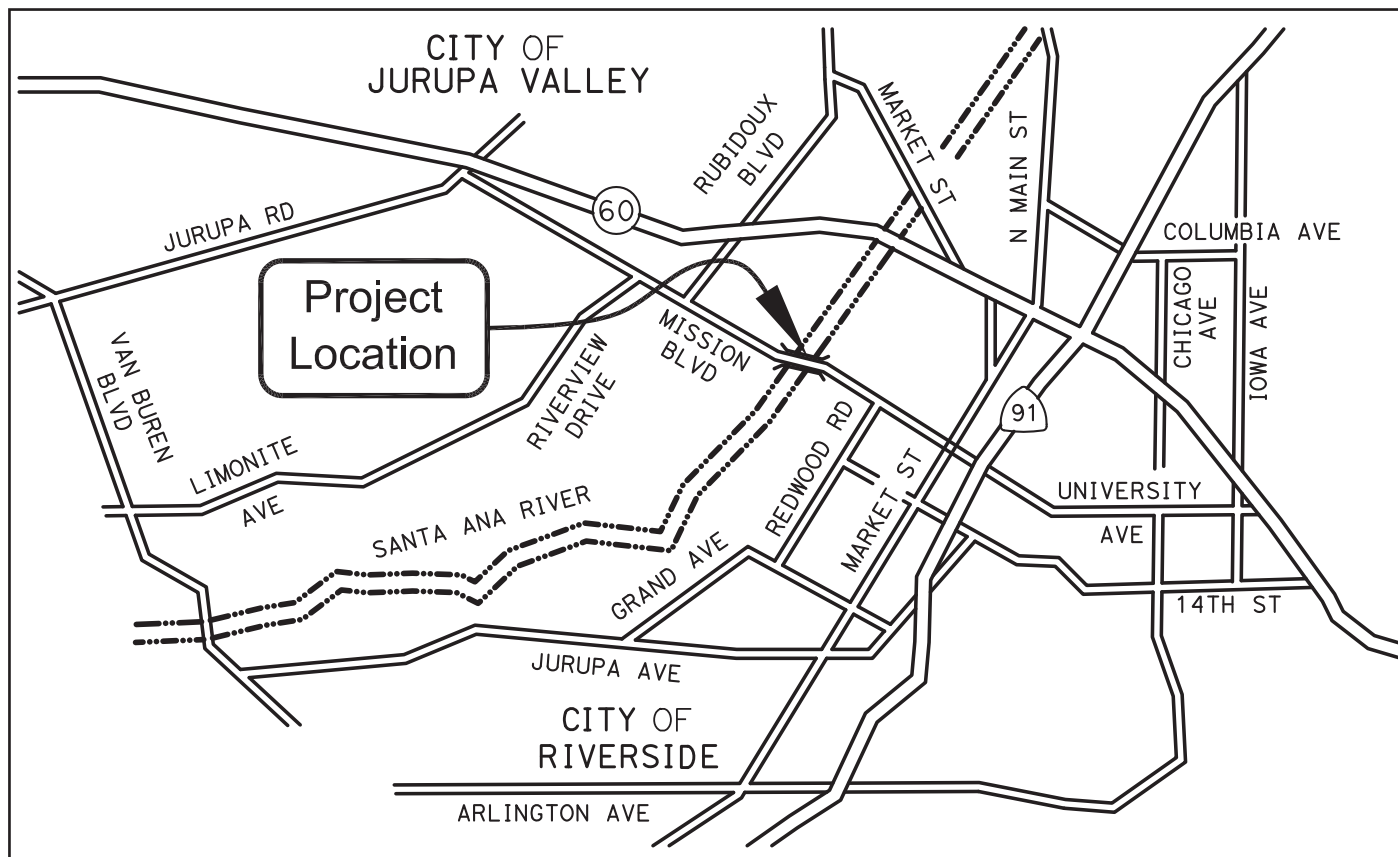
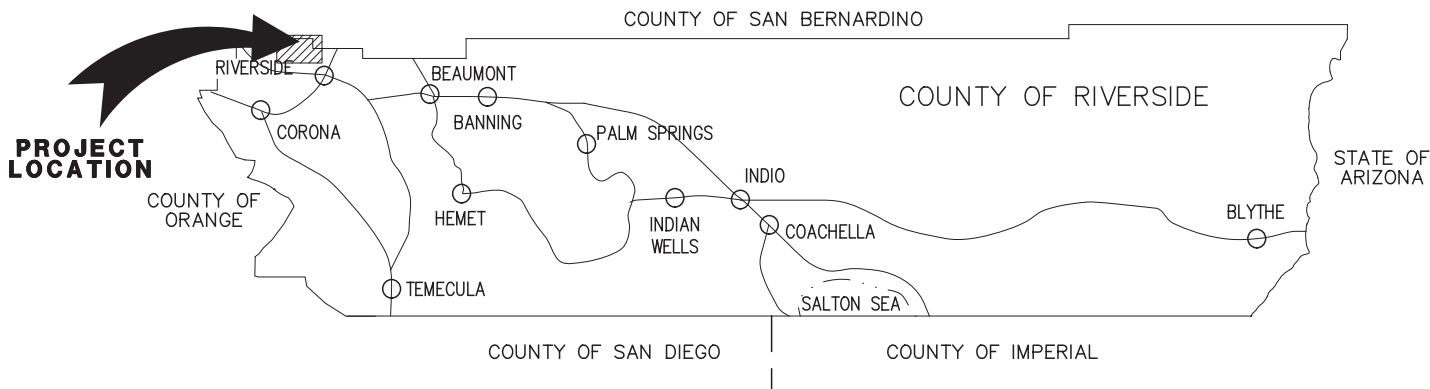
