

BACKGROUND: Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

1. Boys & Girls Clubs of the San Geronio Pass is receiving Community Improvement Designation Funds (CID) in the amount of \$2,500. Funding will support their annual Horses & Hattitudes fundraiser, which raises critical dollars for youth programming across Banning, Beaumont, Cabazon, and Yucaipa-Calimesa, serving over 1,500 economically disadvantaged youth.
2. Riverside County Department of Child Support Services is receiving Community Improvement Designation Funds (CID) in the amount of \$1,000. Funding will support their annual Backpack & School Supply Giveaway on August 9, 2025, providing backpacks, supplies, and resources to families and children across District 5 to promote educational readiness.
3. Black Voices of the Valley is receiving Community Improvement Designation Funds (CID) in the amount of \$2,500. Funding will support programs and events including the Night of Black Excellence Scholarship Ceremony, Kidpreneurship event, Juneteenth celebration, Turkey Drive, and Toy Drive, uplifting Black and Brown youth and families through advocacy, education, and community engagement.
4. Rancho Encino Mountain Club / Twin Pines – High Valley Mountain Disaster Team is receiving Community Improvement Designation Funds (CID) in the amount of \$2,500. Funding will support the purchase and storage of emergency supplies and equipment, the construction of a secure storage facility, and volunteer training to assist 400 full-time residents in a high-risk wildfire area near Banning.
5. Pacific Crest Youth Arts Organization is receiving Community Improvement Designation Funds (CID) in the amount of \$10,000. Funding will support the Pacific Crest Outreach Program, which provides financial assistance for economically disadvantaged students to cover transportation and participation costs for the Drum Corps event at the Rose Bowl Stadium.
