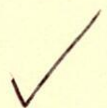

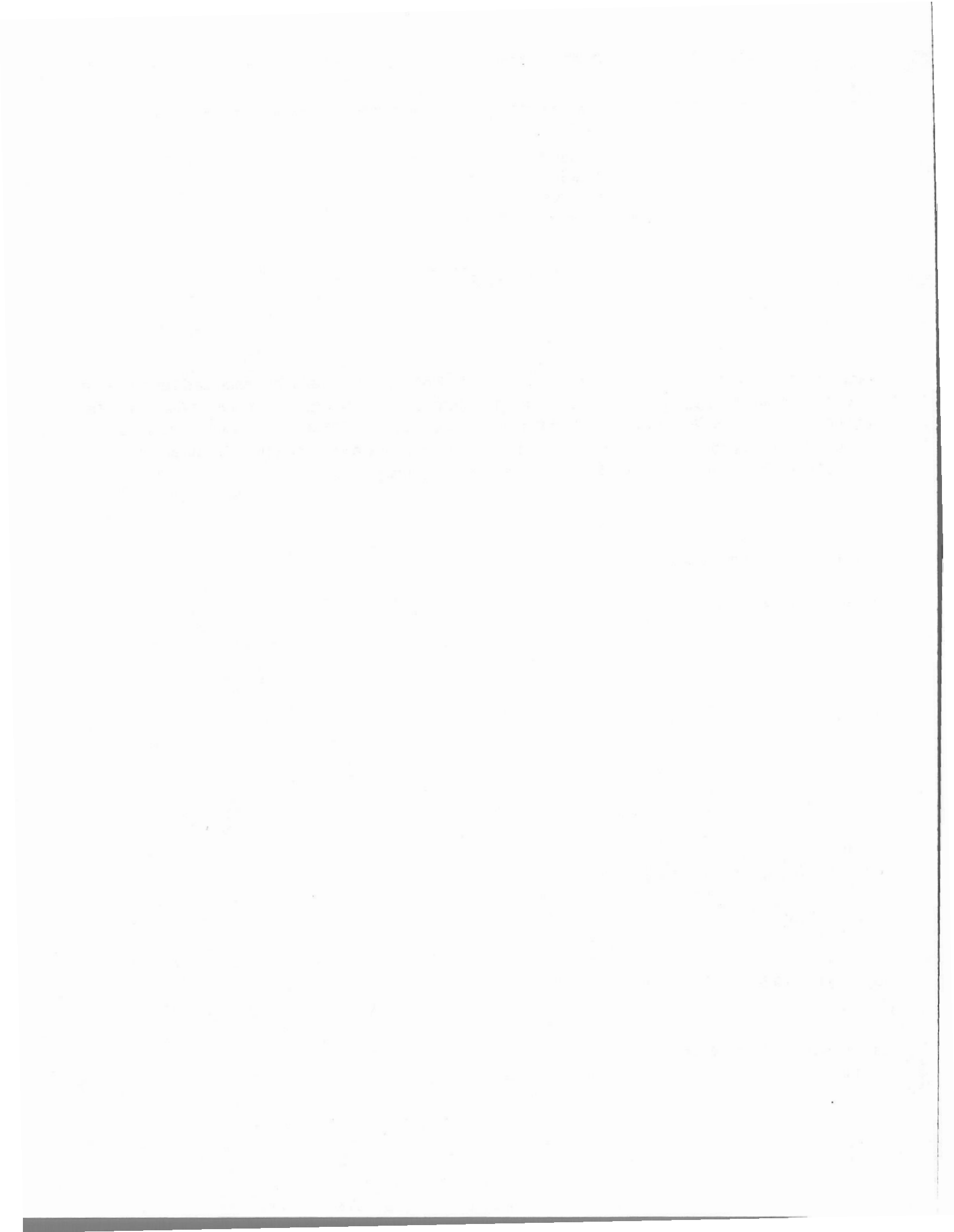

## Voting System Accuracy

- HAVA, 52 U.S.C. section 21083, mandates voting system error rates by reference to Voting System Standards, section 3.2.1, issued by the FEC.
  - Voting System Standards, Performance Standards, Volume I (2002) allowed for one error per 500,000 ballot positions.
  - Experts working at the FEC estimated 500,000 ballot positions equaled 125,000 individual ballots.
  - Thus the error rate of 0.0008% or 1 error per 125,000 ballots is applicable.
  - The county's voting system must comply with federal accuracy standards when a federal candidate is on the ballot.
- 
- In California, the California Voting System Standard, Section 4.1.1 leverages the federal accuracy standard in HAVA. (1 error allowed for every 125,000 ballots counted).

### CVSS 4.1.1 Accuracy Requirements

The following requirements are intended to allow tolerance for unpreventable hardware-related errors that occur rarely and randomly as a result of physical phenomena affecting optical scanning sensors. They are not intended to allow tolerance of software faults that result in systematic miscounting of votes.

a. All systems **shall** achieve a report total error rate of no more than one in 125,000 ( $8 \times 10^{-6}$ ).

The benchmark of one in 125,000 ( $8 \times 10^{-6}$ ) is derived from the "maximum acceptable error rate" used as the lower test benchmark in the 2005 Voluntary Voting System Guidelines Version 1.0.
