

**BACKGROUND:** Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

1. The donation to ABC Hopes, Inc. (\$5,000.00) will support program activities that provide fitness, social, educational and life-skill opportunities with arts, crafts, cooking, classroom learning and engagement within the community to better the lives of people with intellectual disabilities through the development of social, physical and life skills programs.
2. The donation to Chrisitan Arts and Theatre of Corona (\$5,000.00) will provide children from Corona, Norco, Eastvale, and Riverside with weekly classes in acting, singing, dancing, and musical theatre, while also expanding arts education opportunities for the community and strengthening partnerships with the Corona-Norco Unified School District.
3. The donation to Amber Waves of Grain (\$4,000.00) will support local non-profit veteran service organizations serving Second District residents who face ongoing challenges including housing insecurity, financial hardship and access to essential services.
4. The donation to the Riverside Area Rape Crisis Center dba NORA (\$2,500.00) will help to raise funds for NORA's mental health services, counseling, crisis intervention, emergency response and community education and prevention programs.
5. The donation to Riverside Meals on Wheels (\$4,000.00) will support the "Together, We Can Deliver" Fresh Meals Program which provides more than 1,000 meals each month to Second District seniors who are homebound, unable to cook, or without access to groceries.
6. The donation to the Corona High School Football Program (\$4,000.00) will provide essential resources ensuring students from low-income households have access to uniforms, safety equipment, training support, and transportation, removing financial barriers so every student can fully participate.
