BACKGROUND:

Summary

The City of Eastvale approved the Fourth Amendment to the Law Enforcement Services Agreement for a modification of the level of service for FY25/26. This Fourth Amendment to the Agreement for Law Enforcement Services with the City of Eastvale modifies the level of law enforcement service provided by the Sheriff's Office with the addition of two (2) Deputy Sheriff positions and one (1) Sheriff Sergeant. County Counsel has approved the Fourth Amendment as to form.

The FY25/26 estimated law enforcement cost is \$1,503,000. Sheriff's Office staff has recommended budget adjustments that correspond with the additional contract position. Sheriff's Office staff has estimated this change will result in an estimated increase of \$17,387,000 in Contract Law Enforcement Revenue for FY25/26. The Sheriff's Office is recommending these budget adjustments now as it could not anticipate the additional expenditures to include them in its FY25/26 budget.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

This is a Fourth Amendment between the City of Eastvale and the Sheriff's Office for law enforcement services, which the City of Eastvale approved and executed on behalf of its citizens. All costs for this service will be fully recovered through the Sheriff's Office Board-approved rates.

IT IS MUTUALLY AGREED that the Agreement for Law Enforcement Services between the County of Riverside, a political subdivision of the State of California, on behalf of the Riverside County Sheriff's Office, and the City of Eastvale, a General Law City, approved by the Board of Supervisors on July 20, 2021, in Minute Order 3.33 for services effective July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2026, as amended in that certain First Amendment on March 1, 2022 (Minute Order 3.54), and as amended in that certain Second Amendment on August 1, 2023 (Minute Order 3.56), and as amended in that certain Third Amendment on October 8, 2024 (Minute Order 3.20) (collectively, the "Agreement") is hereby amended in the following respects, and all other terms and conditions of the Agreement remain in full force and effect:

- 1. Attachment A-3 of the Agreement is hereby deleted in its entirety and replaced with Attachment A-4, attached hereto to this Fourth Amendment and incorporated herein by this reference.



LEVEL OF SERVICE

Six (6) Community Service Officer II positions
