**BACKGROUND/APPOINTEE INFORMATION:**

First 5 Riverside County Children and Families Commission (RCCFC) was established by this Board in the adoption of Ordinance 784, enacted on January 22, 1999, and was subsequently reorganized by the Board through adoption of 784.11 enacted on October 1, 2019 to designate membership to align with the Riverside County 2030 Vision and set membership terms in alignment with the appointing Supervisor's term of office.

The Commission implements the provisions of Proposition 10, which provides tobacco tax funds to facilitate the creation and implementation of an integrated, comprehensive, and collaborative system of information and services to enhance optimal early childhood development and to ensure children are ready to learn and embrace lifelong learning.

Dr. Cheryl-Marie Hansberger currently serves as Chief Executive Officer of Family Service Association, a nonprofit providing early education and mental health services throughout Riverside County. She previously served as Chief of Staff for the City of Riverside and as Vice President of Strategic Development at Parsons Engineering. Dr. Hansberger also teaches in the doctoral program at the University of Massachusetts Global. She holds a Doctorate in Organizational Leadership from the University of La Verne, a Master of Education from Azusa Pacific University, and a Bachelor of Arts in Psychology from California State University, San Bernardino. Her expertise in early education, mental health, governance, and community engagement aligns closely with the mission of the Commission.
