**BACKGROUND:** Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

1. The donation to the Elsinore Woman’s Club (\$4,000.00) will support the Historical Building Preservation Fund to provide necessary improvements such as paint, flooring, roof and plumbing repairs to the building.
2. The donation to the Freedom Writers Foundation (\$4,000.00) will support their community event at Norco College which equips students and teachers with personal development tools and practical strategies to create classroom environments that engage, enlighten, and empower participants.
3. The donation to Riverside University Health System (RUHS) Foundation (\$12,500.00) will support the 2025 Festival of Trees, which raises vital funds for RUHS Pediatrics. These contributions make it possible to purchase essential medical equipment, expand programs and support services, and increase awareness through education and public outreach. The medical center serves more than 3,000 children each year, ensuring that this support directly benefits families across our community.

4. The donation to SAFE Family Justice Centers (\$2,500.00) will provide critical support for families impacted by violence, including safe shelter, guidance through the criminal justice and civil court systems, access to resource navigation, and assistance with transportation barriers.
5. The donation to 100 Black Men of the Inland Empire, Inc. (\$3,000.00) will fund scholarships for college-bound mentees who face significant financial barriers, helping them access housing, books, technology, and transportation as they pursue higher education.
6. The donation to MilVet (\$2,500.00) will help fund the annual Holidays for Heroes event, which provides essential resources to children of military families, who are navigating challenges such as the loss of a parent, a parent's deployment, or financial hardship.
7. The donation to Support Sisterz (\$5,000.00) will help fund the Combat Cancer Walk, a community event that unites residents for a 3-mile walk to raise resources for cancer survivors throughout the community. Proceeds enable Support Sisterz to provide financial assistance to women in Corona, Norco, Eastvale, and surrounding areas who are battling breast and gynecological cancers.
8. The donation to the Corona Police Community Partnership (\$5,000.00) will enhance programs that strengthen collaboration between the Corona Police Department and the community. These funds will support crime prevention initiatives, provide essential equipment, award scholarships to local high school students, and sustain the department's K-9 team.
