**BACKGROUND:** Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

1. The Boys & Girls Club of Cathedral City has been serving youth in our community for 45 years and has been a vital resource for young people ages 6 to 18, offering safe, enriching after-school and summer programs focused on academic support, character development, and healthy lifestyles. Recently a major plumbing failure occurred beneath their facility caused by a burst pipe and invasive tree roots, which led to significant and costly infrastructure issues. CID funds will be used to cover the cost of re-plumbing, removal of the tree and re-concreting the damaged outdoor patio area.
2. The Codex Creation Committee will host the 12<sup>th</sup> Annual Run with Los Muertos on November 1, 2025. The event collaborates with dozens of local agencies as well as international artists to provide art, culture, health and educational opportunities that celebrate the day of the dead holiday. CID funds will be used on equipment and supplies for the build out of Run with Los Muertos.
3. The Inland Empire Ronald McDonald House hosts the annual A Few Good Men and Women gala, to support the 'Home Away from Home' for Coachella Valley families of critically ill children undergoing treatment. Families are provided with housing and through this program can create a network of social support for one another. CID funds will be used to support the home away from home program.
4. Lideres Campesinas' mission is to strengthen the leadership of farmworker women and youth so they can be agents of economic, social, and political change to ensure their human rights. Lideres Campesinas hosts a convening for the youth which includes workshops and interactive activities facilitated by guest speakers. In addition, they will tour colleges and universities and attend cultural events. CID funds will be used for the cost of lodging, transportation and meals for 25 youth.
