**BACKGROUND:**

Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

1. **Women Organizing Women Inc.** - \$10,000- The funds will be used to support (1) The Lydia Project Women’s Workshop Outreach 2025, a free event offering community resources and career training to single mothers, at-risk youth, and adults with disabilities, and (2) The Lydia Project Mobile Kitchen, a program providing food outreach and vocational training.
2. **God’s Fan Club-** \$2,000- The funds will be used to support the Shelter from the Storm Fundraiser, an event that raises money to provide transitional housing for unsheltered individuals.
3. **Jacob’s House Inc.-** \$5,000- The funding will support the “Open A Door For A Family,” a program that provides families with accommodations near their loved ones undergoing traumatic medical treatments.
4. **Western Eagle Foundation-**\$2,000- The funding will be used to purchase food for the pantry, which provides essential provisions to low-income families.
5. **Friends of Valley-Wide Foundation-** \$1,500- The funding will be used to support the 32nd Annual Autumn Elegance event, which raises funds to provide scholarships for low-income children to participate in sports activities.
6. **VNW Circle of Care Inc.-**\$5,000- The funds will be used to purchase food for distribution through the food pantry.
7. **Murrieta-Temecula Area Alumnae Chapter-**\$1,250- The funding will be used to support the 5th Annual September Breakfast, an event that provides youth with educational development and financial literacy resources.
8. **Riverside County Child Support Services-**\$1,500- The funding will be used to support the Temecula Valley Community Connect Resource Fair.
9. **Rolling for a Cause-**\$1,000- The funding will be used to support Bronco in the Vines, an event that raises funds to provide emergency assistance to families in need of help paying for utilities or medical co-payments.
10. **Thessalonika Family Services, Inc.-**\$10,000- The funding will be used to support (1) the Empowerment Village, which provides individuals with transitional housing and meals and (2) food for the Hope Food Pantry, that currently serves over 500 households each week.

11. **SAFE Family Justice Centers**-\$3,000- The funding will be used to support the 2025 SWING for Safe Charity Golf Classic, an event that raises funds to provide advocacy and emergency shelter for victims of domestic violence, human trafficking, elder abuse, and sexual assault.
12. **Boys & Girls Club of Southwest County**-\$5,000- The funding will be used to support the 2025 Our Kids Rock Gala & Auction, an event that raises funds for the program cost of the clubhouses and middle school location that provide educational resources to kids after school.
13. **Rotary Club of Murrieta** -\$5,000- The funding will support RYLA, the Rotary Youth Leadership Awards camp, a program focused on building leadership skills, character, and self-confidence in 11th-grade students.
14. **Knoppelasen**-\$2,000- The funding will support the construction of a demonstration kitchen where the organization can preserve and promote the cultural heritage associated with native plants in the area.
15. **Lead Your Ship Ministries Inc.** -\$1,500- The funding will support the purchase of essential items, such as food and baby formula, for individuals assisted by Alternatives for Domestic Violence.
16. **Riverside County Foundation on Aging, Inc.** -\$5,000- The funding will be used to purchase \$25 grocery store gift cards for seniors in need in District 3.
17. **Michelle's Place Cancer Resource Center**-\$5,000- The funding will support Michelle's Place 25th Gala, an event that raises funds to provide cancer patients and their families with behavioral health resources, transportation to medical appointments, wellness supplies, and support groups.
18. **Family Service Association**-\$4,000- The funds will support Hope for the Holidays, a program that provides children and teenagers in the foster care system with holiday gifts such as toys, books, clothing, and hygiene items.
19. **Cultivating Inclusion Inc.**-\$5,000- The funds will support Cultivating Inclusion Farms program, a program that teaches individuals with special needs how to grow food and care for a garden.
20. **The Unforgettables Foundation.**-\$2,500- The funds will support the Burial Assistance Program, which provides financial assistance to low-income families for burial or cremation expenses.
