

2. The donation to the Norco Area Chamber of Commerce & Visitors Center (\$2,500.00) will support the 10th Annual First Responders event which highlights our local responders with recognition for their heroism throughout our community.
3. The donation to Jurupa Valley Food Fest (\$2,500.00) will support the Rotary Club of Jurupa Valley in advancing their service goals, including providing scholarships that benefit local students.
4. The donation to the Lake Elsinore Valley Chamber of Commerce (\$2,000.00) will support the 2025 State of the City to engage community members with critical

6. The donation to Shoes that Fit (\$2,500.00) will provide 134 new pairs of sneakers for low-income students throughout the Second District at no cost to their families.
7. The donation to Studio 395 Foundation, Inc. (\$2,000.00) will support the Annual Día de los Muertos event in Lake Elsinore, creating opportunities for artists to engage with the community while celebrating and sharing diverse cultural traditions.
8. The donation to the Corona-Norco Settlement House (\$1,500.00) will support programs and services such as the food pantry, school clothes and supplies, financial aid and holiday meals to families in need.
