The public deserves to know that RCDAS is being run by individuals abusing their power, protecting each other through inappropriate sexual relationships, and allowing serious animal welfare failures to go unpunished. Ivan Herrera's ongoing relationship with Dr. Itzel Vizcarra has directly influenced hiring and

promotions—including the questionable appointment of Krystal Angeles—and has led to taxpayer-funded travel being used for personal indulgence, not professional development. While staff like Phillip Arthur are fired immediately for misconduct, Herrera remains protected despite being tied to a fatal incident where a puppy was mauled under his watch, and having a direct role in multiple cases of favoritism, overtime abuse, and cover-ups. Emily Ellison, caught abusing animals more than once, was shielded by leadership, while others were thrown away without the same support—proving that RCDAS values connections over accountability. These unethical actions are not just harming staff—they are directly endangering animals and violating the public’s trust. The community has had enough—we demand a full independent investigation, immediate leadership restructuring, and accountability for those who have turned this public service into a corrupt and dangerous inner circle.
