

**BACKGROUND:**

Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

1. **Assistance League of Hemacinto** - \$3,000- The funding will support the Operation School Bell program, which provides low-income students with school supplies and school appropriate clothing.
2. **Elevation Church Menifee**- \$5,000- The funding will support the Project Elevation renovation, specifically for the purchase of new carpeting.
3. **Temecula Valley Writers Illustrators Inc.**- \$500- The funding will support the Temecula Valley Writers and Illustrators Community Anthologies Program, which provides a platform for local artists to share their work.
4. **Guided Discoveries Inc.**-\$5,000- The funding will support the 2026 Astro Camp, a weeklong program that offers children hands-on STEM education and ecological learning experiences.
5. **Inland Valley Symphony**- \$1,500- The funding will support the 2025 Holiday Concert with Temecula Ballet, a seasonal concert series featuring performances of Christmas classics such as The Nutcracker.
6. **Thrifting 4 Gifting**-\$3,000- The funding will support the 5 Points Program, which provides food-only gift cards to families of students struggling to afford groceries.
7. **Feeding America Riverside/ San Bernardino Counties**-\$10,000- The funding will be used to provide food assistance to individuals experiencing food insecurity by distributing food boxes to pantries throughout the Third District.
